Study Overview


Metro is exploring ways to make public transit better in and around the City of Pico Rivera. The Pico Rivera Rail Station Feasibility Study will evaluate the opportunity to add a new passenger station to the commuter rail and intercity rail system between the existing Norwalk/Santa Fe Springs Metrolink Station in Norwalk and the Commerce Metrolink Station in Commerce. The study involves working closely with several groups, including Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA, operator of Metrolink); Los Angeles – San Diego – San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN); California High Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA); Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) and the City of Pico Rivera. The goal is to determine whether adding this new station would benefit the community and the regional transit system.

Objectives

The purpose of this study is to:

1. Position the City of Pico Rivera as a regional destination that includes a multimodal, transit-rich community.
2. Encourage more people to use trains for their daily trips.
3. Ensure the new station benefits everyone in the community and supports fair development.
4. Take full advantage of current and upcoming transportation projects in the City of Pico Rivera.
5. Enhance the city's ability to meet environmental goals.
6. Support long-term economic growth for the community and the region.
7. Explore ways to connect the new station with other local and regional transit projects, like the Eastside Transit Corridor Phase 2 project.
