North-South Transit Corridor Improvement

> **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The North-South San Fernando Valley Corridor Bus Transit Project is conceived as a 12-mile corridor linking Ventura Boulevard with the City of San Fernando. The state's Traffic Congestion Relief Program (TCRP) earmarked \$100 million to build a North-South Corridor Bus Transit Project that interfaces with the San Fernando Valley East-West Metro Rapid Transitway and with the Ventura Boulevard Metro Rapid Bus Project. The study area is roughly bounded by the City of San Fernando/Sylmar/118 Freeway to the north, Vineland Avenue on the east, Ventura Boulevard to the south and Topanga Canyon Boulevard on the west.

> **STATUS:**

The project team is in the process of refining and modeling the preliminary alternatives based on community input and technical factors.

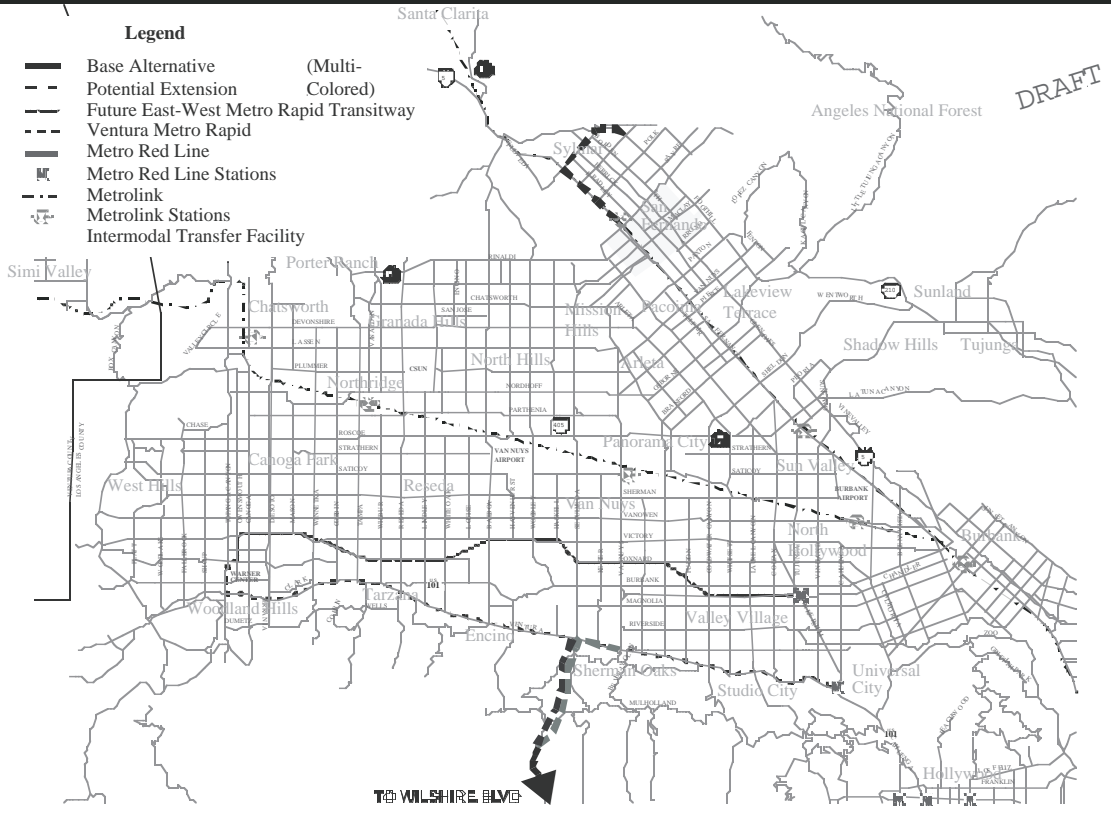
