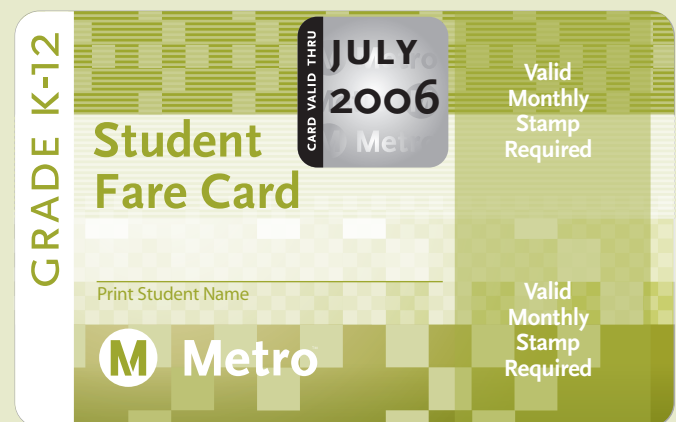


# Introducing the new Photo-less Metro Student Fare Card

- > No more applications
- > No more photos
- > No more fees
- > No wait time



Effective immediately, students no longer need to submit a special application to get a Metro Student ID card.

Here's the new process:

- 1 Request a Student card at one of the Metro Customer centers listed below or from selected LAUSD schools (check with your School Administrator).
- 2 Print student name on the front of the card.
- 3 Student signature is required on the back of the card (acknowledging the acceptance of the conditions for the use of the card).
- 4 Show your card when you purchase your Metro Student Monthly stamp and affix the stamp to your card.

## It's that easy! Please note:

- > Students must be in grades K – 12 to participate
- > For grades 9 – 12, a photo ID or School ID may be required for stamp purchase

**Metro student fare cards will be available starting Monday, March 21st.**
