

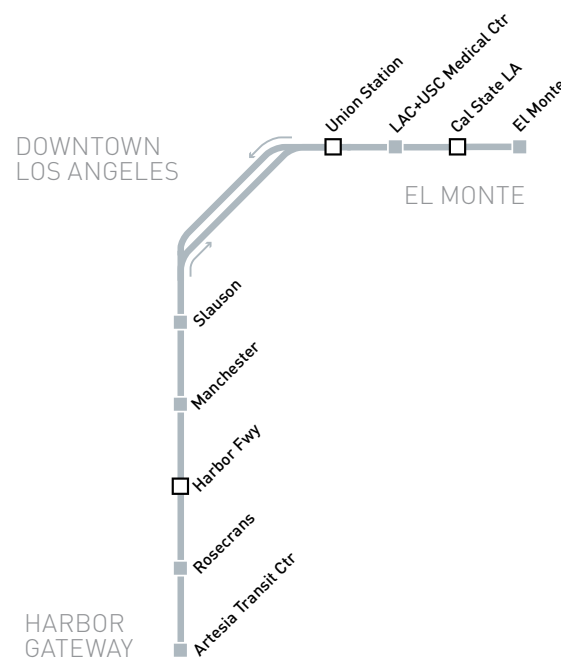
Metro Silver Line Fares

El Monte – Los Angeles – Artesia Transit Center

Metro Silver Line connects the South Bay and San Gabriel Valley to Downtown LA. With service every 5-15 minutes during weekday rush hours, you can skip the traffic and save time during your commute. The Silver Line also provides direct connections to Downtown LA shopping, dining and entertainment seven days a week.

Silver Line Fares

Because the Silver Line runs primarily on freeways, special fares apply. Cash fares use the existing zone charge structure. If you have a pass, additional fare is required, as shown below.
