Metro Summer Service Changes

On June 27, several route and service adjustments were made to Metro bus lines during peak hours, late night and weekends, plus a new Metro Rapid line debuted on Venice Boulevard.

Among some of the changes were:

- > Eastern terminal Line 30/31 relocated to Indiana Station. Line 31 service from Gold Line Indiana Station to East LA College was replaced by Line 287.
- > Replaced limited service on Line 333 with new Metro Rapid 733. Line 733 operates from Patsaouras Transit Plaza to Santa Monica between 5am and 11pm. Local 33 now runs from Main/Sunset to Maple Lot between 5am and 11pm, continuing to Patsaouras Transit Plaza and Santa Monica during late night/owl periods.
- > Converted all service on Limited Line 366 to Line 66. Discontinued route segment west of Western Avenue. Most service, including weekends, ends at Wilshire/Western.
- > Route of Line 202 extended from Avalon Boulevard and Anaheim Street providing east/west service in Wilmington previously served by Line 246/247.
- > Established short-line service on Line 217 at Hollywood/Vine Station on weekdays and Sunday.

- > Minor route change northbound only on Line 222 between San Fernando Road and layover zone at Cantara Street.
- > Route changed for all service on Line 246/247 from Avalon Boulevard and Anaheim Street. Weekend service only extended from the Artesia Transit Center to the Harbor Freeway Green Line Station.
- > New layover has been added on Line 268 to the northbound direction on Woodbury Road at Lincoln Avenue.
- > Route of Line 287 now serves cancelled portion of Line 31 on 1st Street.
- > Line 442 will be eliminated this fall when a new bus stop is constructed at Manchester Harbor Transitway Station as part of the ExpressLanes project.
- > New short-line terminal established for Metro Rapid 720 at Central Avenue and 6th Street.

In addition, minor changes have been made to several other lines. Please check the timetables on metro.net, or on buses, for schedule or route changes.



Celebrating 20 Years – The Metro Blue Line opening on July 14, 1990 brought the new era of rail transit back to LA after a 27-year absence. The return of rail brought out more than 32,000 riders on the first day. In the 20 years since, Metro Rail has expanded to a five-line system serving more than 300,000 passengers daily.
