

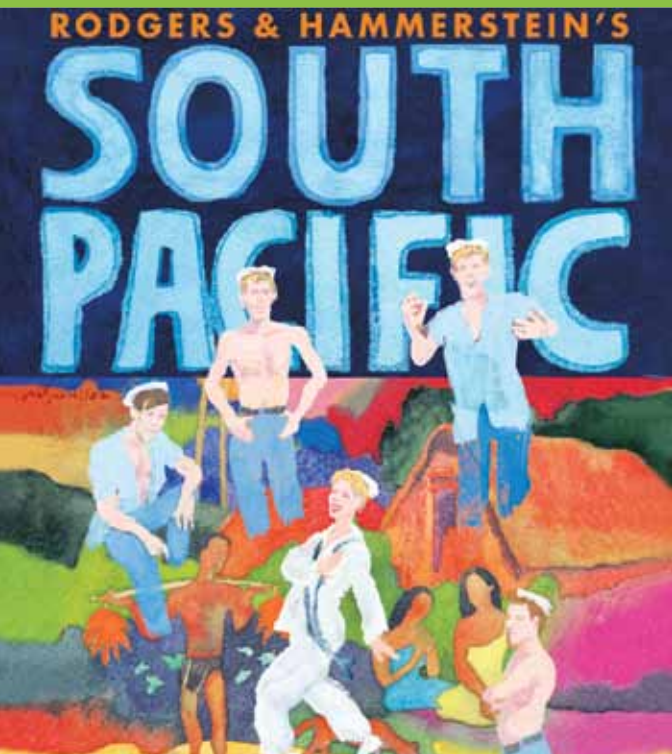

New Metro Fares Go Into Effect July 1

This summer's fare change was approved three years ago as part of a two-step fare restructuring.

The first change took place in July 2007; the second, originally scheduled for July 2009, was delayed one year by the passage of Measure R, a transportation sales tax approved by voters in November 2008.

Less than half of Metro riders (48 percent) will be affected by the current fare change, which is only the third fare adjustment in the past 15 years. Thanks to Measure R, fares for seniors, students, the disabled and Medicare recipients will stay at current levels until 2013. Metro Silver Line fares also will not change.

The new fares are among the lowest charged by any major transit agency in the nation. Even under the new fare structure, riders will only pay 28 percent of the cost of operating Metro buses and trains. The rest is subsidized by other funding sources, primarily local sales tax revenue.

New Venice Metro Rapid Line Debuts June 27

Look for faster service between Downtown LA and Santa Monica as Metro Rapid 733 begins this summer on Venice Boulevard.

Destinations on Line 733 include Mid-City, Culver City, Venice and Santa Monica with connections to seven other Metro Rapid lines, Metro Rail and Metro Silver Line. And since Metro Rapid only stops at major cross streets, there's nothing to slow you down. Buses come weekdays every 10-15 minutes in peak hours. Metro Rapid 733 replaces Metro Local 333. Check at metro.net after June 27 for the timetable.
