

Construction Notice

ATTENTION COMMUTERS, RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF SEPULVEDA BL AND WILSHIRE BL

The contractor will begin relocating a telecommunication line on the property of the General Services Administration (GSA) between Sepulveda and Veteran, starting Tuesday, November 1, 2011 for two months. Work activities will take place during day and night time hours. Day time hours start at 8:00 am until 5:00 pm and will not require lane reductions. Night activities, from 8:00 pm to 5:00 am, will require lane reductions through the GSA driveway from Sepulveda to Veteran for several nights. One lane will remain open for two directions of traffic, with a flagger being used to direct traffic. Some sections of GSA parking will be restricted during this time.

What: Relocation of a telecommunication line.

When: Work is anticipated to start on Tuesday, November 1, 2011 for two months. Day and night time work activities will take place. Day time hours are from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm and night time hours are from 8:00 pm until 5:00 am.

Where: General Services Administration property, from Sepulveda to Veteran.

What to Expect:

- Over several nights, one lane will accommodate two directions of traffic through the GSA property. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers. This configuration is only anticipated to last eight nights.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Work is weather permitting and subject to change.
