Notice of Night-Time Work Activity

The I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project will add a 10-mile northbound carpool lane on the San Diego Freeway (I-405) from the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) to the Ventura Freeway (US 101), and will realign selected ramps, improve bridge structures, and erect sound walls. Anticipated project completion is Spring 2013. In preparation for construction, the contractor will temporarily delineate traffic lanes.

- What:** Full Freeway Closure to delineate temporary traffic lanes.
- When:** Night-time work for full freeway closures on the northbound I-405 is anticipated to resume the night of Wednesday, January 27, 2010 for approximately three days, weather permitting. Ramp closures may start as early as 8:00pm, followed by freeway lane closures at 9:00pm and full freeway closures from 12:00am to 5:00am for the delineation of traffic lanes, with the freeway open to thru traffic by 5:00am.
- Where:** San Diego Freeway (I-405) between the Santa Monica Freeway (I-10) and the Ventura Freeway (US 101). While these are full freeway closures, the work activities will be segmented. Segments are scheduled as follows:

Full Freeway Closure Segments	Anticipated Day of Full Freeway Closure	Time
NB I-405 from Santa Monica Fwy. (I-10) to Santa Monica Blvd.	January 28	Midnight to 5:00 am
NB I-405 from Santa Monica Blvd. to Wilshire Blvd.	January 29 and 30	Midnight to 5:00 am

What to expect:

Delineation of traffic lanes

- Segmented closure between the I-10 Freeway and Santa Monica Blvd. will require the closure of the I-10 eastbound and westbound connectors to the I-405. Ramp closures will begin around 8:00pm. For detour information please visit www.metro.net/I-405
- Segment schedule and corresponding detour maps will be available at www.metro.net/I-405 prior to the related work activities.
- There will be the same number of thru traffic lanes as there are currently at the completion of this activity.
