

# Notice of Night Work Activity

ATTENTION COMMUTERS, RESIDENTS, AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF THE SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) BETWEEN NATIONAL BLVD. AND SKIRBALL CENTER DRIVE

As part of the pre-construction activities for the I-405 Sepulveda Pass Widening Project, the Contractor will temporarily delineate traffic lanes on the southbound San Diego Freeway (I-405). This night time activity requires full freeway lane and ramp closures.

**What:** Freeway Closure to delineate temporary traffic lanes.

**When:** Night-time work for freeway lane and ramp closures will begin the night of **Wednesday, February 24, 2010 and morning of Thursday, February 25, 2010** for five nights, weather permitting. Ramp closures may start as early as 8:00pm, followed by freeway lane closures at 9:00pm, and full freeway closures from 12:00am to 5:00am. The freeway will begin to re-open to thru traffic at 6:00am

**Where:** San Diego Freeway (I-405) southbound between Sunset Blvd and National Blvd. While these are full freeway closures, the work activities will be segmented. Segments are scheduled as follows:

Full Freeway Closure Segments	Anticipated Day of Full Freeway Closure	Time
Santa Monica Blvd. to National Blvd.	February 24, 25 , 26	Midnight to 5:00 am
Sunset Blvd. to Santa Monica Blvd.	February 27 , March 1	Midnight to 5:00 am

## What to expect:

### Delineation of traffic lanes

- Segmented closure between National Blvd. and Santa Monica Blvd. will require the closure of the I-10 eastbound and westbound connectors to the I-405. For detour information please visit [www.metro.net/405](http://www.metro.net/405)

- There will be the same number of thru traffic lanes as there are currently at the completion of this activity.
