

Construction Notice

ATTENTION COMMUTERS, RESIDENTS, AND BUSINESSES IN THE VICINITY OF THE SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) AND SKIRBALL CENTER DRIVE

On Monday, August 23, 2010, the contractor is anticipated to begin constructing a temporary sidewalk along the south side of the Skirball Bridge in order to maintain pedestrian access throughout the upcoming demolition and reconstruction of the north side of the Skirball Bridge. The right hand lane in the eastbound direction along the Skirball Bridge will be closed for approximately four weeks in order to conduct this work. K-rail (concrete barriers) will be placed along the bridge to separate traffic from the work zone. The temporary sidewalk construction is part of early preparation work activities to support the Skirball Bridge demolition and reconstruction activity.

What: Construction of a temporary sidewalk along the south side of the Skirball Bridge.

When: Night-time work is anticipated to begin on Monday, August 23, 2010, and last for approximately four weeks, weather permitting.

Where: Skirball Bridge

What to Expect:

- This work activity will entail a full freeway closure in one direction every night for two weeks. These directional full freeway closures are anticipated to begin on Monday, August 30, 2010.
- The southbound Skirball Center Drive on- and off-ramps and the northbound off-ramp may be closed on some nights during construction.
- Local access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained during the day.
- Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.
- Please note that the work is weather permitting and subject to change.
