

Notice of Sunset Bridge Demolition

The contractor will begin demolition and reconstruction of the northern half of the Sunset Bl Bridge. The demolition will take place during twelve nights, followed by a twelve-month reconstruction period.

What: Demolition of the northern half of Sunset Bl Bridge

When: Bridge demolition started on Monday, October 31, 2011, with demolition occurring between 11pm and 5am. Demolition over Sepulveda Bl is anticipated to start on Wednesday, November 9, 2011 for three nights followed by abutment demolition on the eastside of the bridge starting on Thursday, November 17 through November 22. Activities are weather permitting and subject to change.

Where: Sunset Bl Bridge at the I-405 freeway

What to expect:

SB Sepulveda Bl traffic will be detoured to SB Church Ln. to EB Sunset Bl to SB Veteran Av, to WB Montana Av, back to Sepulveda Bl. Sunset Bl will remain open with one lane in each direction. |

- *Closure of Sepulveda Bl will NOT be simultaneous with freeway closures.*
- Freeway lane closures may start as early as 10pm.
- Ramp closures on the Sunset Bridge will be coordinated with Caltrans, ramp closures may start as early as 7:00 PM,
- Street closures will be in place from 9pm to 6am.
- Pedestrians will be rerouted to an area outside the construction zone.
- Traffic control officers will be on site to direct traffic.
- Emergency access will be maintained on the bridge at all times.
