24. Other transportation needs in Los Angeles County that need to be addressed

Faith based

All People's Christian Church, (Disciples Of Christ) Pacific S.W. Region (2286)	We only have one client enrolled in the food program that does use Access Transportation twice a week from Torrance to the center. We do not have taxi vouchers and some elderly miss their pick up because of lack of transportation.
Community Place Of United Ministry At USC (3318)	Much more senior shopping/health services transportation is required.

Private, for profit

ABC Therapy Center (2137)	It would be most beneficial if Access Services had additional language abilities, especially in Chinese. Then many seniors who do not speak English would be able to follow up and further utilize Access and other such services.
AltaMed Health Services Corp. (161)	Need all size vehicles that can handle tight turns in hill neighborhoods. Also need some non-agency drivers to be trained in providing door-to-door service.
American Transportation Systems (7015)	Bus parking/storage - we have been looking for a lot to park buses.
Dynasty Limousine Inc (6258)	This city needs public transportation (mass transit) more than everything (subways) and from subway stations comprehensive bus terminals. We should have along every existing freeway and every planned one, either subway or elevated mass transportation system. Public transportation should be promoted to first way of reading metro are Los Angeles. If you compare the total street miles to existing Metro Red, Blue, Gold... Lines it is almost 0. This will help solve congestions, saving fuels and add to the income of families. Raise the sales tax and plan for a un planted beautiful Los Angeles. We will help the city reach its goals.
Magic Carpet Shuttle (6803)	Information on grants, increase in possibility for more vehicles for some enrichment activities/camp.
Western Women's Medical Center (2576)	Many of our patients are elderly and low-income who need transportation.

Private, non-profit

African Community Resource Center (7131)	Our agency would like to serve our client to be self sustaining but in Los Angeles County without housing and transportation it is very challenging to us and to our customer. We are looking to have not one kind of transportation a multiple kind, if we spend money for this program in the end will save a good amount of money and most of all the customer satisfaction. Good will be accomplished.
Braille Institute (256)	* Drivers having adequate training regarding all disabilities especially sighted guide techniques for blind people. * The call center (complaints) to be responsive. Specifically, even if the complaint has no resolution (traffic, accident, etc) still respond to the person on the phone with a smile in your voice. That alone will decrease hostility from consumers towards Access. *Be practical and reasonable about routine of share rides. Cluster them more, giving the driver flexibility. This way older consumers and consumers with medical issues will get home within an hour, instead of 2-3 hours later. For e.g., diabetics need food, medicine, others may need a restroom.
CALACT (7135)	Survey looks great let me know if you would like CALACT to participate in some manner.
Community Assistance Program for Seniors (637)	More accessible transportation need, our members on access find it difficult to get the time to be picked up that they need more availability for the same day pick up
East Valley Multipurpose Senior Center (5219)	Seniors often need rides outside our working hours.
Easter Seals (6587)	Traffic congestion.
ITNSantaMonica (7140)	Trips across jurisdictional boundaries. Driver assistance to and from vehicle, and with packages. Door to door and door through door transportation. Transportation at hours not covered by most transportation services (evenings and extended weekend hours).
Kaiser Foundation Hospital (938)	When a patient has Access Services and lives in Santa Clarita or Palmdale, there is no coordination of transportation services past boundaries into the San Fernando Valley where our hospital clinics are located. 2. Access bus/van services in the San Fernando Valley often tell the discharge planner or the patient they cannot do "same day". However when a supervisor at Access is called, they will pick up a hospital discharge patient. 3. Is there any funding for hospital discharge patients who cannot pay for wheelchair or escort van? 4. Medi-Cal sometimes will pay for a trip to a nursing facility or for a hospital discharge. However in our area (east of San Fernando Valley) no vendors will accept Medi-cal.
Long Beach Brethren Manor, Inc. (1089)	We need more senior vans. They often wait or no-show for return trip through Access.

Los Angeles Caregiver Resource Center (6049)

1. door to door to help client out of home and into home 2. shorter rides to limit time person has to be driven around before reaching their destination 3. offer more morning hours 4. provide more coordination with agencies that need periodic service (2X or less a year).

MERCI (Mentally & Educationally Retarded Citizens Inc.) (6348)

Appropriate wheelchair vans/lifts. Transportation agencies with an understanding of persons they are servicing. Accommodations for same day pick-ups.

Oldtimers Foundation (528)

Better accessibility to roads and highways for more precise on-time performance. Increase in Metro lines within cities with heavy traffic congestion to facilitate transportation within that are aside from vehicle transportation. Increasing or implementing bicycle lanes. Also a way to increase Dial-A-Ride service for clients' personal needs, such that as family visits and running errands.

Tierra del sol Foundation (1407)

Unreliability of access services.

United Community Action Network, Inc. (6849)

There is inadequate bus service in the Antelope Valley, and little private services for ADA and seniors. Another (CBO) "murrels" did supply limited transportation, funded by "Asian youth" in L.A. "murrels" is no longer in business. Low income families in a 1640 square mile community, have a real problem. We have qualified bus drivers, but lack the funding to implement the program. We are somewhat interested in the coordination, however we need more detailed information. Thank You

Villa Esperanza (4933)

Would like to see more funding available for maintenance of vehicles. Maintenance is very costly especially for modified vans. Also would like more resources on mechanics in the area who are familiar with modified vans.

Watts Labor Community Action Committee (5609)

Transportation for daily necessities.
Expand service to ages 50-60.
Evening and weekend services.
Increase vehicle fleet.
Increase wheelchair vehicles.
Increase services to seniors housing facilities.
Increase funding.

Public

Antelope Valley Mental Health Center (3716)

Better/More frequent routes incorporating the outlying areas of the Antelope Valley (Littlerock, Lake, Los Angeles etc.)

Arcadia Mental Health (3717)

Routine clinic visit transportation so clients can keep formal appointments for medication.

City of Agoura Hills (5153)

Timing or service pickup and drop off. Seniors are told a general time of a few hours to be available. Times are not always accurate.

City Of Alhambra - Community Services (4037)

Not always eligible for Access Services and Access Services is difficult to obtain, and the process for registration is long, and once eligible it is difficult to schedule, and the rides are not dependable. That said - access to other cities is very difficult for seniors and disabled. Some sort of safety net service would be a great asset.

City of El Monte/Senior Services Division (410)

Door to door transportation services, more outreach to involve more seniors in driver safety programs, increase transportation options, coordinated efforts with medical related associations to transport specialty clients with chronic conditions.

City of Norwalk - Norwalk Transit (31)

Some of the special needs would be providing door to door or door thru door transportation and carrying packages for passengers who cannot handle them. These services are seen as potential liability issues, not to mention the cost of the services. Also there are certain requirements such as waiting outdoors for the drivers, since drivers are not allowed to honk (in some neighborhoods) or go inside to get them. There are certain emergency needs (not 911 calls) such as running out of prescriptions that would require same day reservations that may not be easily accommodated. Drivers are also not trained to handle certain disabled passengers if they travel alone without an attendant.

City of Pasadena - Adaptive Recreation at Jackie Robinson Center (7144)

1. Current riders are being reviewed for "eligibility" for use of the service. Staff feels that many of these riders "do" need the service, or they would not ask for it.
2. Within Pasadena/Altadena we can utilize Dial-A-Ride, but outside of the area, consumers need access to get to our programs. We've had numerous problems with Access as stated in this survey question # 8. 3. Many participants can take the bus, but would it be a good idea for these participants to take two or three buses to get to our program and then go home at night on their own.

City of West Hollywood - Transportation (614)

Human/social service agencies must be more proactive in funding their own transportation services. Door to door assistance is difficult to provide, but needed. Provision and coordination of volunteers for local systems.

City of Whittier (5)

Improve on-time performance of Access Service for local residents. More local funding for capital improvements to replace buses, install real time GPS software and assist with operational costs.

LADOT-Citiride (5509)

Transportation services are plentiful but the public must be informed on where and how to access the information to be part of a specific program that would meet their needs.

Subsidies and paratransit services should be limited to the low-income or should be process substantially higher for those who can afford other services.

The public should be limited so they do not abuse programs by amassing more service for themselves while others receive a smaller share of the services available.

Los Angeles County Department of Public Social Services - GAIN program (2602)

Greater density of bus stops. Service for remote areas, and 24 hour service at a greater number of bus stops in low income areas.
Free public transportation for public assistance recipients through EBT.

Palos Verdes Peninsula Transit Authority (4085)

Continued operation of our dial-a-ride service is dependent on Board approval of annual budgets.

Rancho/ USC Alzheimer Research Center of California (2093)

Access does not recognize and is unable to accurately assess or meet needs of cognitively impaired which are mentally different from physically impaired.
