

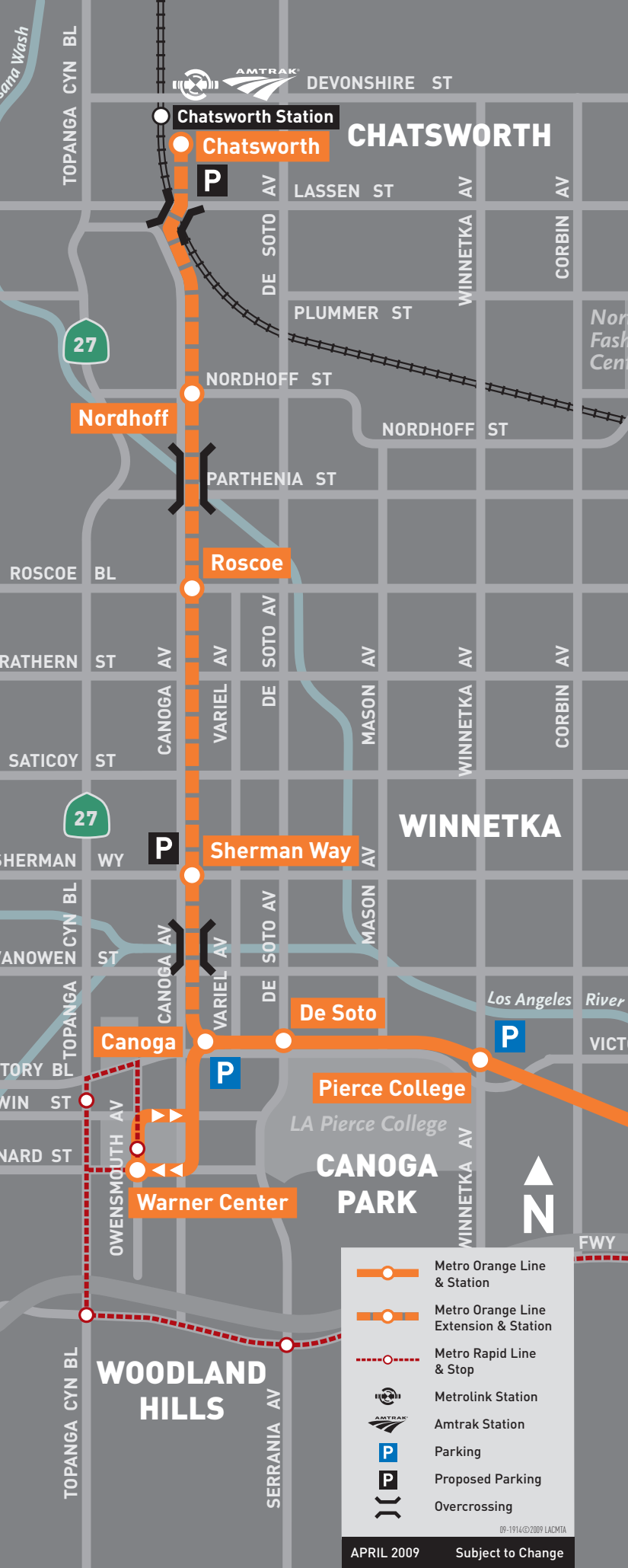
Metro Orange Line Extension

Overview

The Metro Orange Line Extension will extend four miles north from Metro Orange Line Canoga Station to the Metrolink Chatsworth Station. This dedicated busway will offer improvements to north-south mobility in the western San Fernando Valley by connecting activity centers along the corridor and connecting the Metro Orange Line with Metrolink. The construction of the Metro Orange Line Extension will offer faster travel times, improved bus connections, and provide better access to destinations throughout Los Angeles County.

Project At a Glance

- > A four-mile northern extension of the Metro Orange Line, extending from the Metro Orange Line Canoga Station to the Metrolink Chatsworth Station
- > Four new stations at Sherman Wy, Roscoe Bl, Nordhoff St and Chatsworth Train Depot
- > New platforms at Canoga Station
- > New bikeway and pedestrian path will run parallel to the dedicated Busway
- > Landscaping similar to that on the existing Metro Orange Line
- > New park/ride lot at Sherman Way Station
- > Additional parking at Chatsworth Station
- > Overcrossing of Lassen St and the railroad tracks on an elevated bridge
- > Forecasted to open summer 2012
