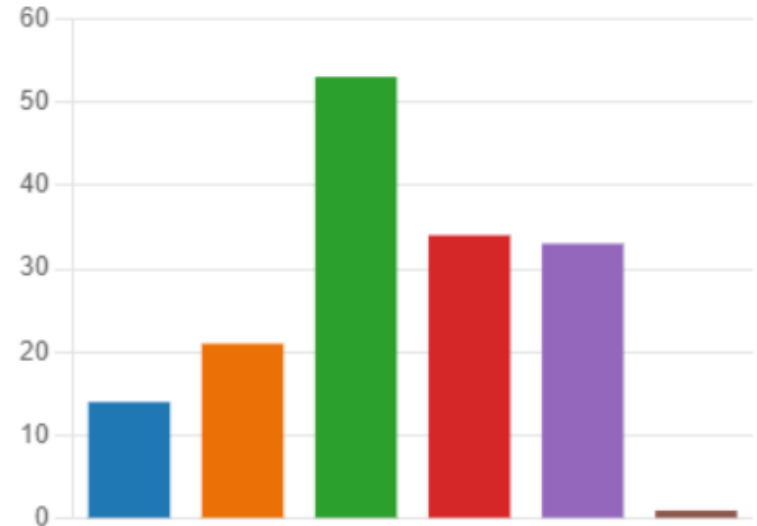

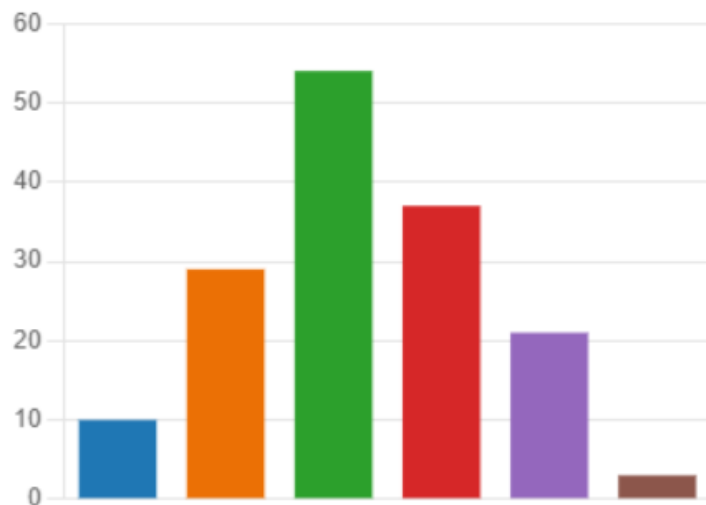
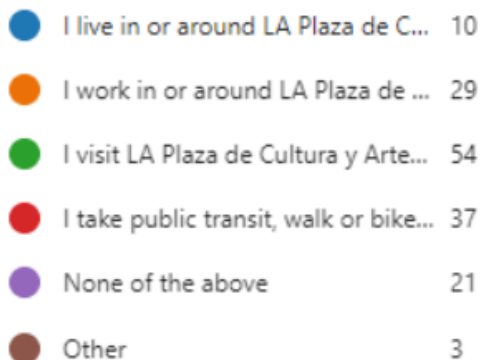

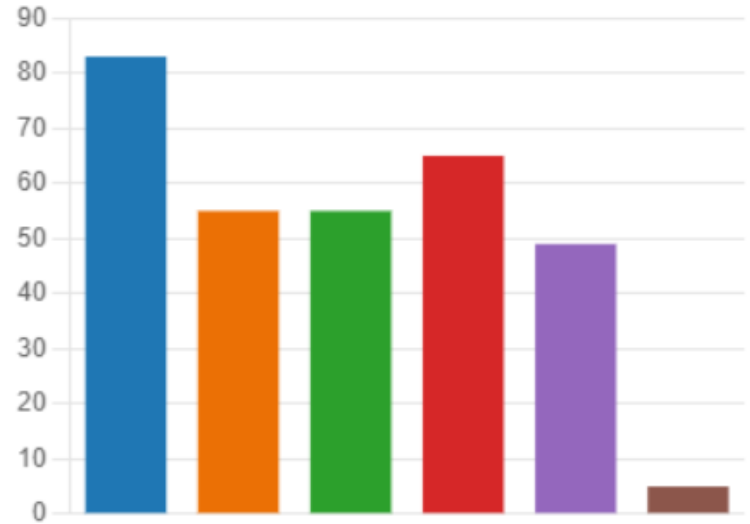
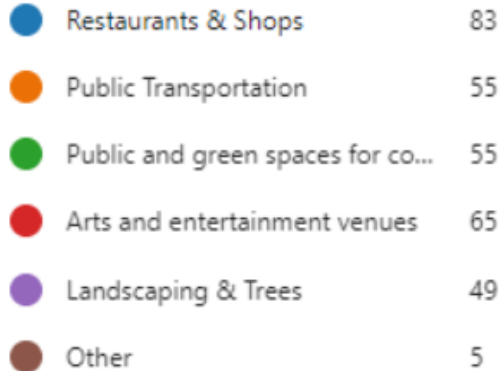

3. What do you currently like about the project area? Check all that apply.

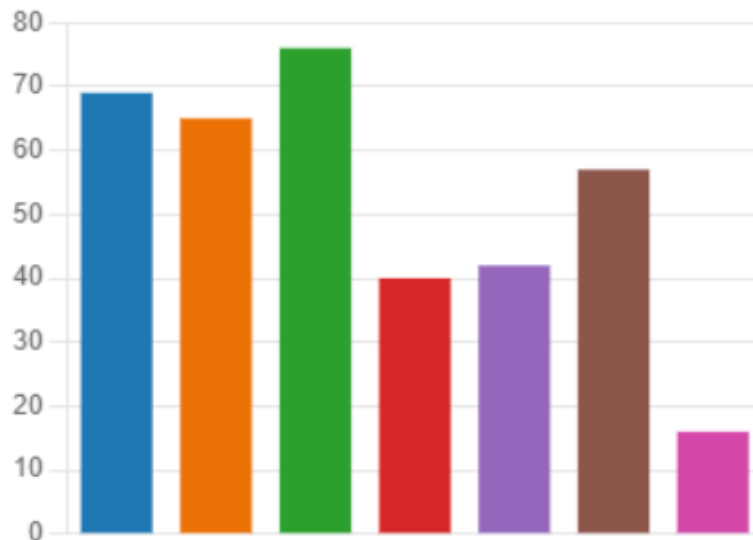
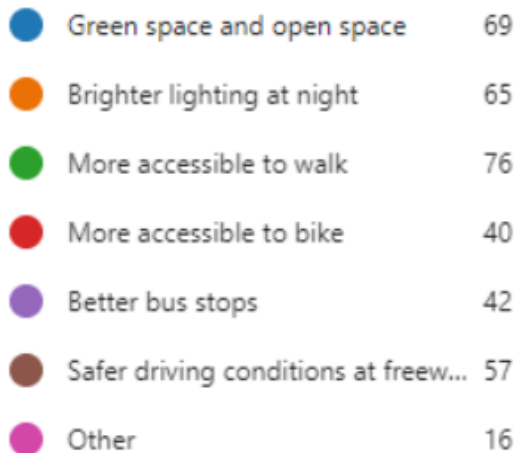
