# About the Project

- > Metro is partnering with the BNSF Railway, the City of Santa Fe Springs, California High-Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA), and Caltrans' Division of Rail and Mass Transportation (DRMT) to construct a bridge to separate the Rosecrans Ave and Marquardt Ave intersection from the existing diagonal at-grade crossing of the BNSF railway.
- > This proposed project will substantially enhance the safety and traffic flow, including truck and vehicular circulation, on the surface streets.
- > Construction start in October 2022 through Summer of 2025.
- > Contractor: Flatiron Construction

# Major Milestone Completed Bridge Girders Installation June 1 through June 28

**Coordination:** Metro coordinated with BNSF, SCE, City of Santa Fe Springs and day/night work crews.

**Closures:** Full Eastbound Rosecrans and Full Intersection Closures.

**SAFETY** was our number 1 priority. Safety meetings were conducted before each shift.

# Bridge Girders Installation: June 7

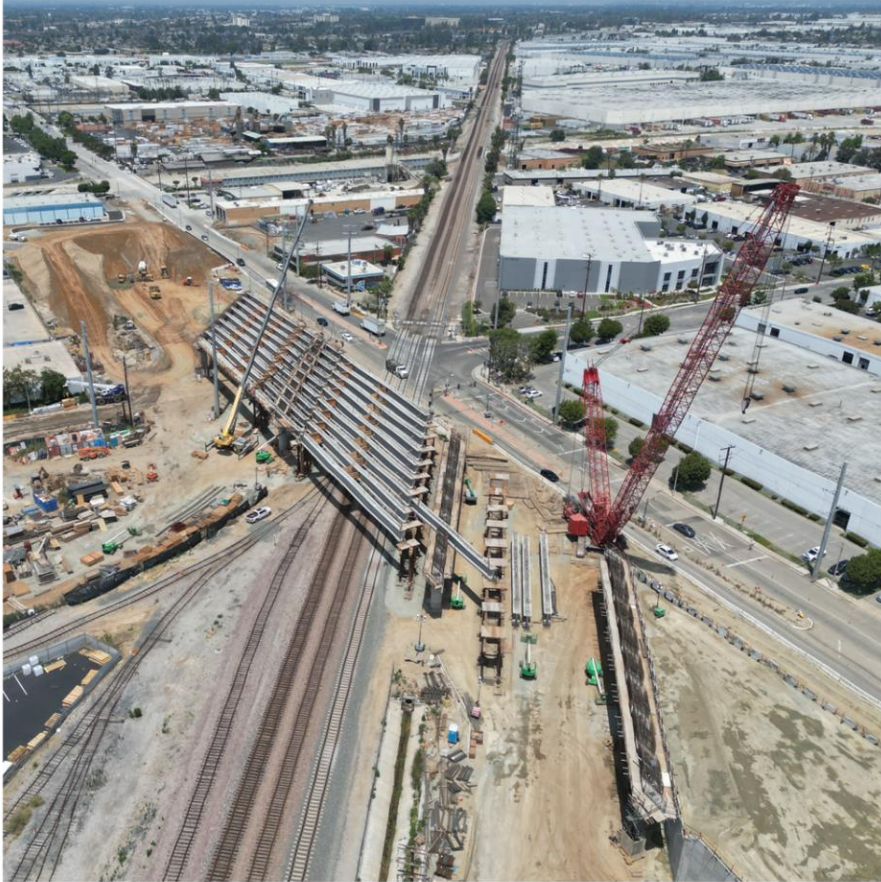


**First half of the bridge girders have been installed.**
