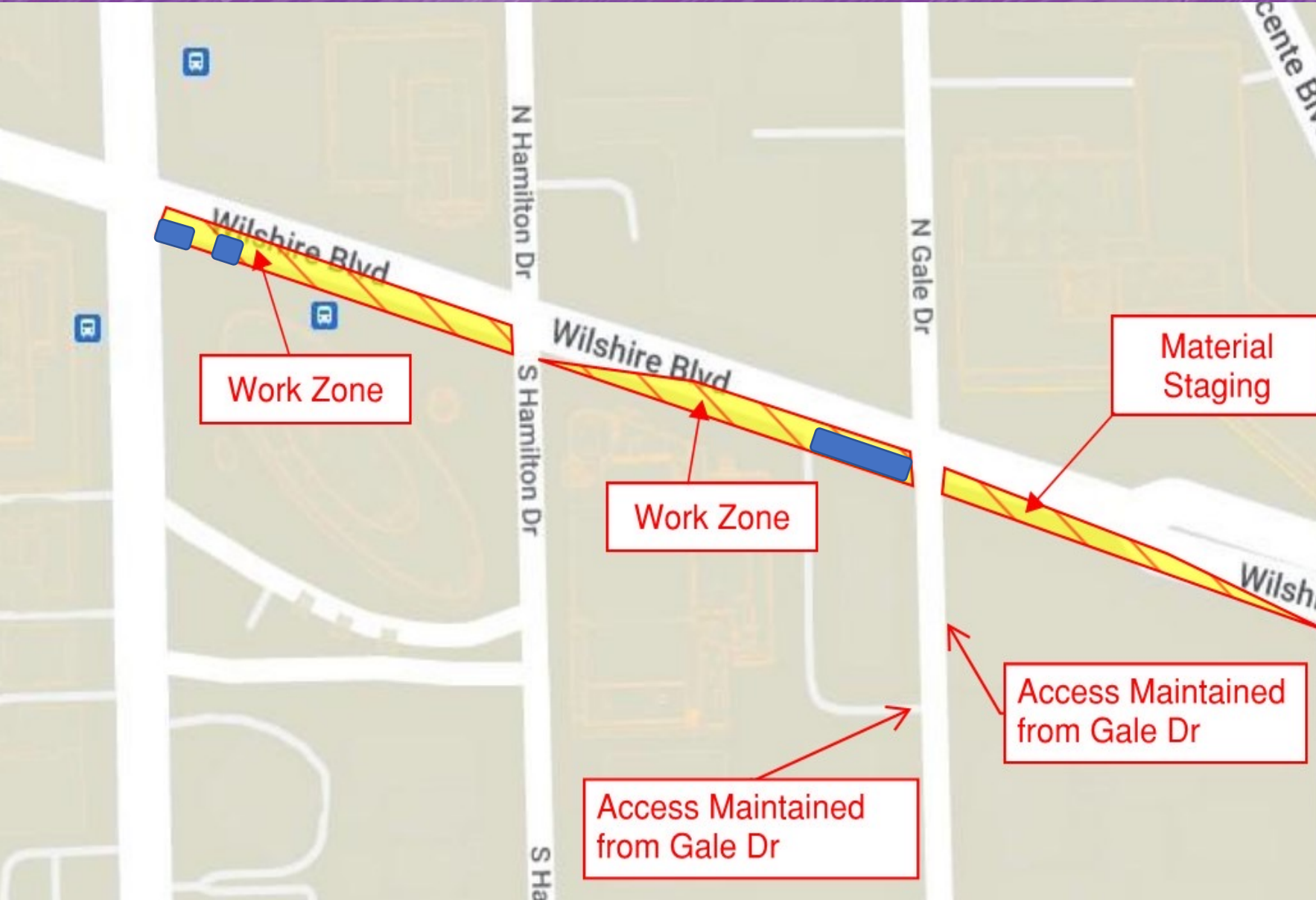

# Wilshire/La Cienega Station Appendage Work

- > **Why:** Multiple appendages will be required for each station on the Purple Line Extension
- > Each appendage structure houses a vital function for the stations:
  - Emergency exits
  - Utility rooms
  - Ventilation rooms
  - Entrance and exit structures
- > **When:** Began in March 2021 through October 2023\*
- > **Where:** Information about specific traffic control and work hours will be available in future community meetings and construction notices
- > Coordination with impacted businesses will be conducted prior to the start of the next phase of appendage work

# Wilshire/La Cienega Station: Appendage Work and K-Rail Placement



- Was implemented over the weekend of December 10 to 11. Anticipated to be in place until October 14, 2023
- The two work zones will support excavation, and then construction, of three separate appendage structures
- The largest of these is on the southwest corner of Wilshire Bl and Gale Dr
- The Material Staging Zone at the southeast corner\* will be in place to support excavation, and then construction, by providing a laydown area for support of excavation (SOE) and construction materials such as rebar and HDPE

\* The Staging Area allows us to keep S Gale Dr open on a more regular basis. Instead of long-term closures to the street, STS will utilize intermittent short-term closures on an as needed basis.

# Wilshire/La Cienega Station Civil Restoration



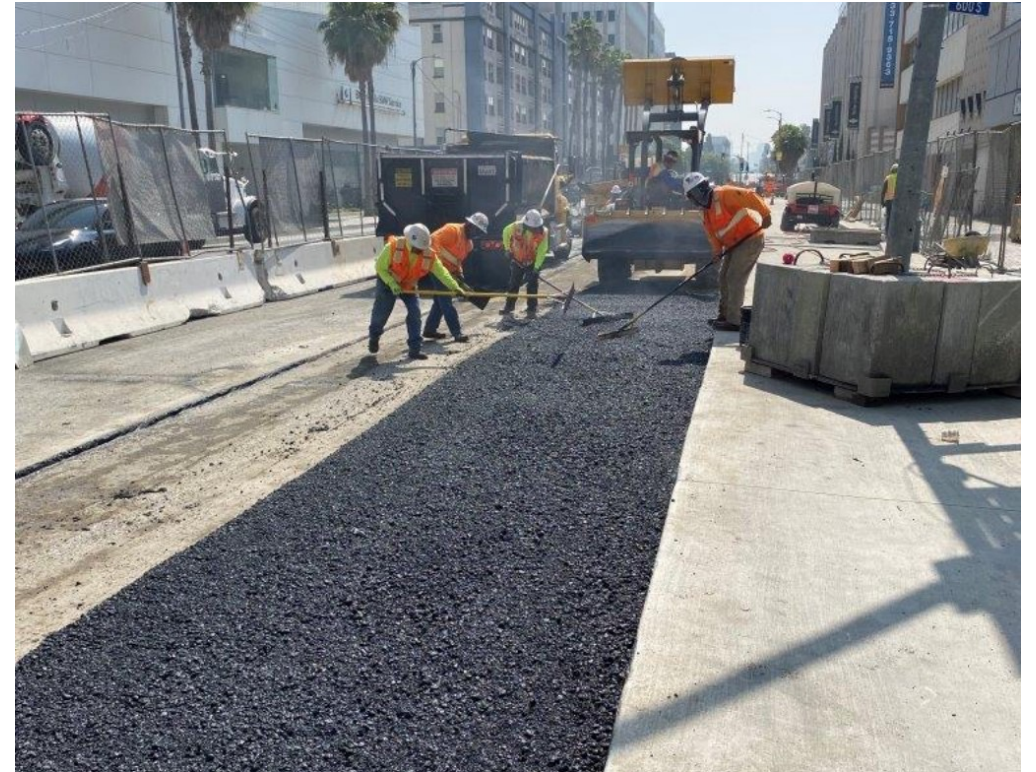
- Following the removal of the Phase 2 Appendage Closure the K-Rail will be shifted to the north side of Wilshire Bl. These work zones will support ongoing plaza and entrance structure construction, and civil restoration work on the curb, sidewalk, gutter, and tree wells along Wilshire Bl and La Cienega Bl.
- Work is anticipated to commence on October 14, 2023, for an estimated duration of 6 months.
- Wilshire will be reduced to two lanes in each direction between San Vicente Bl and La Cienega Bl. Northbound La Cienega Bl will be reduced to two lanes between Gregory Way and north of Wilshire Bl.
  - Intermittent westbound K-Rail bumpouts may be utilized during approved work hours. This will reduce westbound Wilshire Bl to a single lane between San Vicente Bl and La Cienega Bl during off-peak hours
  - Intermittent northbound K-Rail bumpouts may be utilized during approved work hours. This will reduce northbound La Cienega Bl to one lane from Wilshire Bl to north of Wilshire Bl during off-peak hours

# Wilshire/La Cienega Station Civil Restoration (cont.)



- Hamilton Dr and Gale Dr may be intermittently closed at Wilshire Bl during the north side civil restoration. North and South Hamilton will not be closed concurrently. North and South Gale will not be closed concurrently.
- Left turns will be maintained at the Wilshire/La Cienega intersection.
  - All turn movements in the Wilshire/La Cienega intersection are anticipated to remain in operation. Intermittent closures may be utilized depending on planned work.
- A 5ft walkway will be maintained along the north side of Wilshire Bl. Intermittent closures to the full sidewalk may be utilized
  - A signed pedestrian detour will be implemented during intermittent sidewalk closures.
- Additional details will be available in a future monthly meeting and construction notices

# Concrete and Material Deliveries

- > **Traffic Control:**
  - Continuing in 2023, westbound Wilshire Bl will be intermittently reduced to one lane between San Vicente Bl and La Cienega Bl, this will support material delivery to the appendage work zones
  - Daily closures will be utilized in support of ongoing work activities in the staging yard at Gale Dr
  
- > **Intermittent Lane Reductions: Hamilton Dr & Gale Dr (9am to 4pm and 8pm to 7am, weekdays; 7am to 6pm, Saturdays)**
  - Continuing through 2023, lane closures may be implemented within the Wilshire/Hamilton intersection and Wilshire/Gale intersection.
  - Wilshire will be reduced to a single lane in each direction between Tower Dr and Stanley Dr
  - Left turns from Wilshire to Hamilton will be restricted. Through traffic on Hamilton will be restricted at Wilshire.
  
- > **Noise Mitigations:** will remain in place
  - Sound blankets around noisy equipment
  - Trucks equipped with low-impact backup alarms
  - Nylon straps used to lift material

# Instrumentation Work

- > **When:** Ongoing in 2023
- > **Traffic Controls:**
  - Intermittent lane reductions on Wilshire Bl, La Cienega Bl, and side streets during off-peak hours may be in place to support the maintenance of geotechnical instruments in the Wilshire Bl and La Cienega Bl area
  - Intermittent lane reductions may be in place on Wilshire Bl, west of La Cienega Bl, to support coring survey work under Wilshire Bl
- > Additional details on this work will be available in future construction notices

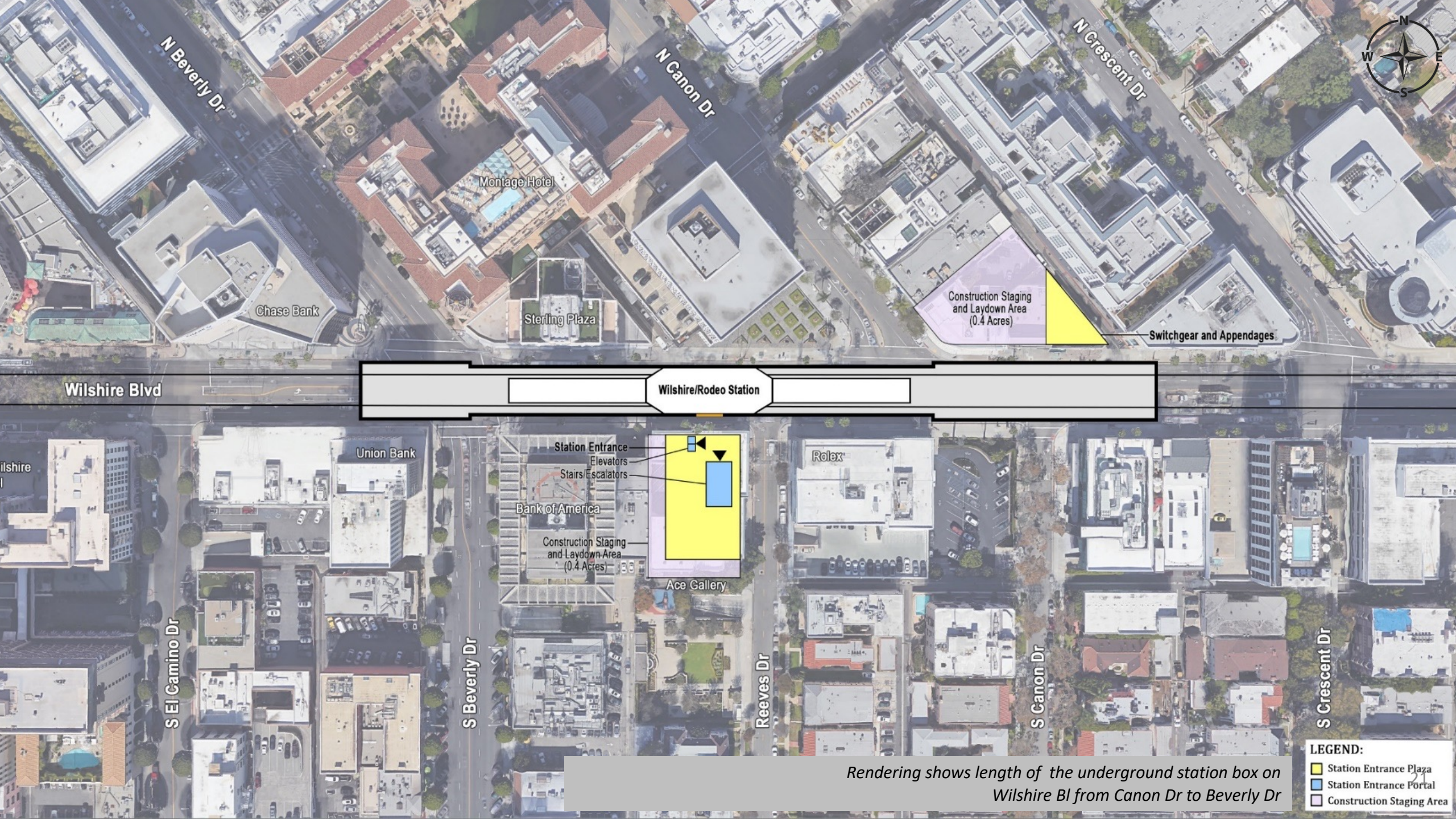

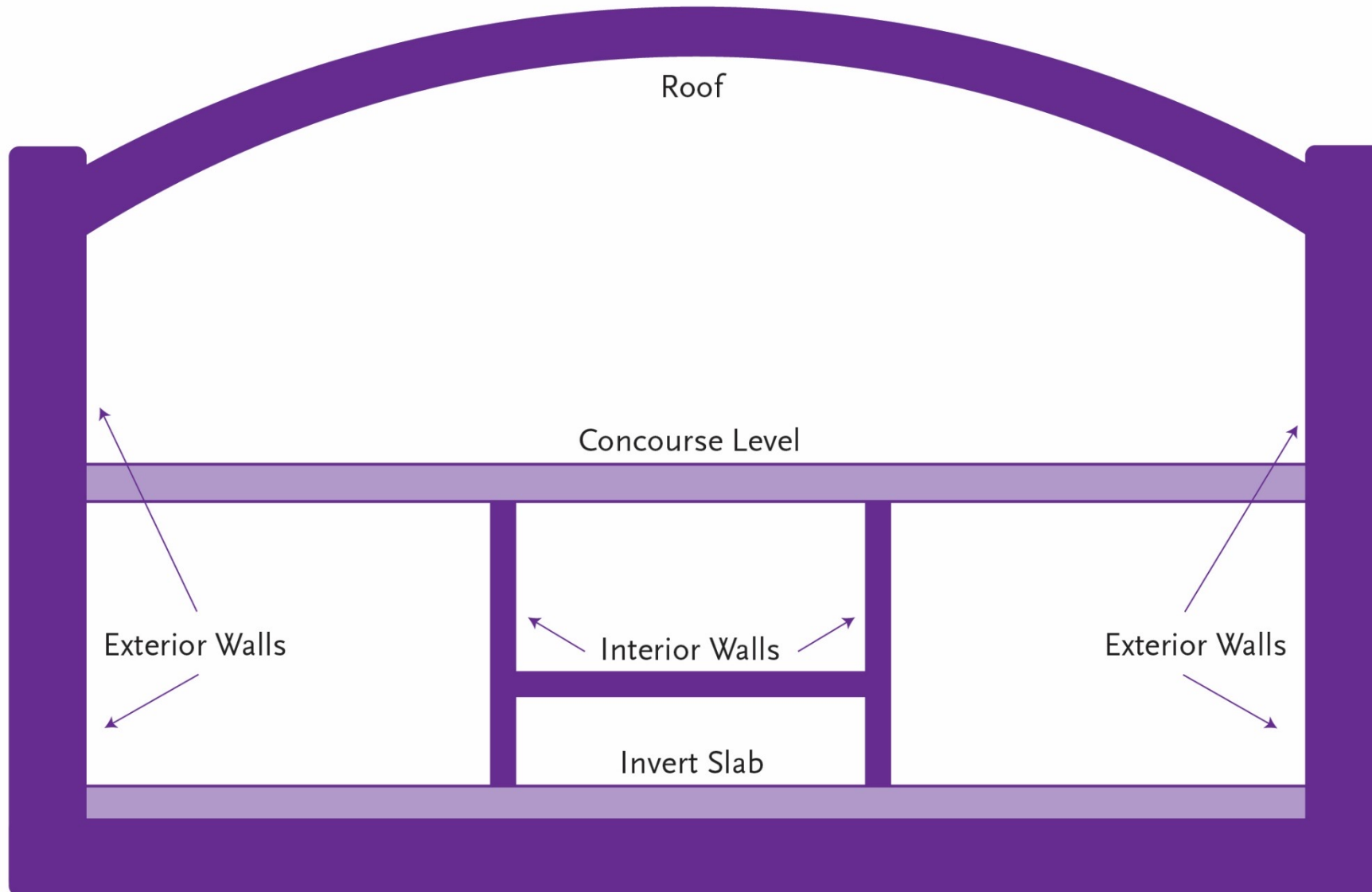

## Wilshire/Rodeo Station: Permitted Work Hours and Traffic Control

- Work hours underneath the deck are 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Deliveries of material, equipment, and concrete will be ongoing daily from Wilshire Bl. A breakdown of daily work hours on street level:
  - **From 7am to 9am and 4pm to 8:15pm**, Wilshire Blvd. will remain open with three lanes in each direction between El Camino Dr. and Crescent Dr.
  - **From 9am to 4pm**, Wilshire Blvd. may be reduced to two lanes in each direction between El Camino Dr. and Crescent Dr.
  - **From 8:15pm to 7am**, Wilshire Blvd. may be reduced to one lane in each direction between El Camino Dr. and Crescent Dr.
- Traffic control may also be implemented on Beverly Dr. At least one through traffic lane will be maintained in both directions between 9am to 4pm and 8pm to 7am.
- From 9am to 4pm, S. Reeves Dr. may be reduced to one lane northbound. A flagger will be on site to assist motorists with two-way traffic.

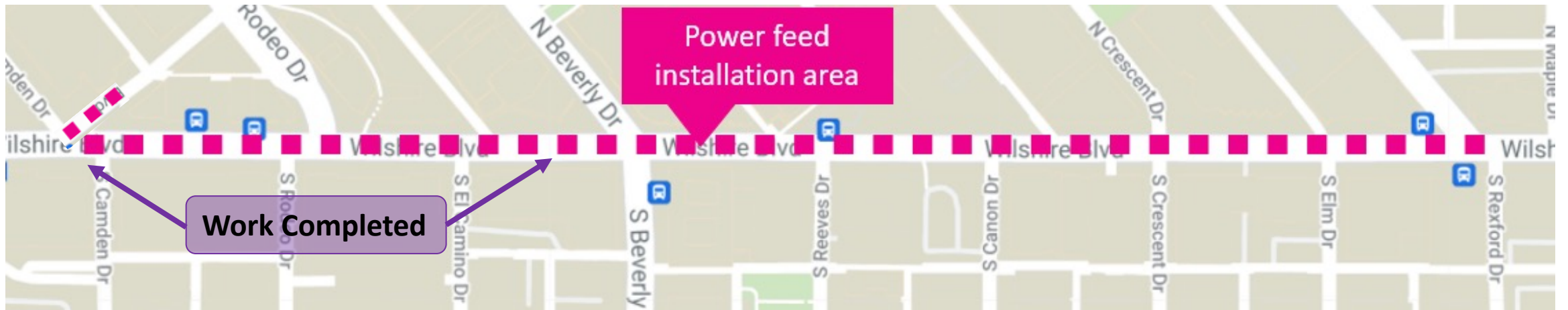

# Continuing Work: SCE Installation

Contractor is progressing with installation of SCE Permanent Power Feeds to the station.

- **Where:** Wilshire Bl between Dayton Way and Rexford Dr.
  - Work is currently between S Canon Dr and Rexford Dr
- **Duration:** Work started in Sep. 2022
  - Completion 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2023
- **Work Hours:** Weekends, 8am to 8pm and Weekdays 8:15pm to 7am
- **Traffic Control:**
  - Wilshire Bl may be reduced to one lane in each direction overnight and on weekends



# Cross Passage Work: Sidewalk Enclosures

Sidewalk enclosures have been placed at each cross-passage location throughout the City to house equipment.

- Each enclosure remains up until the completion of cross passage construction below ground.



# Completed Work – Appendage Piling & Decking – S. Beverly Dr.

Contractor has completed piling & decking activity in preparation for the construction of appendage structures.

- **Where:** S. Beverly Dr near Wilshire Bl
  - › Required various lane, street, and sidewalk closures
- **Duration:** Work began Friday, July 28
  - › Included 5 consecutive weekends of 59 hour full closure
  - › 8pm on Friday to 7am Monday

# Current Work: Appendage Excavation on S Beverly Dr

Contractor is progressing with excavation activity in preparation for the construction of appendage structures

- **Where:** S Beverly Dr near Wilshire Bl
  - › Will require various lane, street, and sidewalk closures to both sides of S Beverly Dr
- **Duration:** Work began in mid-September
  - Approximately 2 months to complete
- **Work Hours:**
  - Overnight from 8:15pm to 7am
- **Traffic Control:**
  - S Beverly Dr may be reduced to one lane each direction at Wilshire Bl
  - Wilshire Bl reduced to one lane in each direction



# Current Work – Appendage Potholing at S. Canon

Contractor is finalizing potholing activity in preparation for the construction of appendage structures.

- **Where:** S. Canon Dr @ Wilshire Bl
  - › Requires lane and sidewalk closures
- **Work Hours:** Weekdays, 9am to 4pm & 8:15pm to 7am | Weekends, 8am to 7pm
- **Duration:** Approximately 2 month to complete
  - Work began mid-July
  - To be completed by October 6
- **Traffic Control:**
  - Lane & sidewalk closures will be implemented on S. Canon Dr
  - Minimum of 1 through lane maintained north and southbound
  - Full closure of S Canon Dr overnight



# Upcoming Work: Appendage Piling – S. Canon Dr.

**\*Full Closure:** Contractor will begin piling activity in preparation for the construction of appendage structures.

- **Where:** S. Canon Dr near Wilshire Bl
  - › Requires various lane, street, and sidewalk closures
- **Duration:** Anticipated to start on Friday, October 6
  - 3 consecutive weekends
- **Work Hours:**
  - 59-hour **full closure** beginning at 8pm on Friday night to 7am Monday morning
  - Piling activity takes place from 7am-8pm on Saturday and Sunday
- **Traffic Control:**
  - Full street closure of S Canon Dr
  - Intermittent lane closures to eastbound Wilshire
  - Driveway access at 9420 & 9378 Wilshire Bl will be maintained



# Upcoming Work: Appendage Decking & Excavation – S. Canon Dr.

**\*Following piling activity, decking & excavation will take place in preparation for the construction of appendage structures.**

- **Where:** S. Canon Dr at Wilshire Bl
- **Duration:** Following Piling activity
  - Anticipated to begin January 2024
  - Approximately 3 months until end of Q1 2024
- **Hours:**
  - Noisy activity: 8am to 8pm
  - Breakdown & clean up: 8pm to 11pm
- **Traffic Control:**
  - Full street closure of S. Canon Dr
  - Driveway access maintained
  - Pedestrian access maintained

# Wilshire/Rodeo Station: Geotechnical Instrumentation

- **Where:** Instruments installation has been completed along the tunnel alignment. Instruments monitor ground movement, settlement and other geological conditions
  - Maintenance work will be ongoing
- **Duration:** Ongoing
- **Work Hours On Wilshire Bl:**
  - Weekdays, 7am to 4pm and 8pm to 7am
- **Work Hours Off Wilshire Bl:**
  - Weekdays, 8am to 6pm and 8pm to 7am

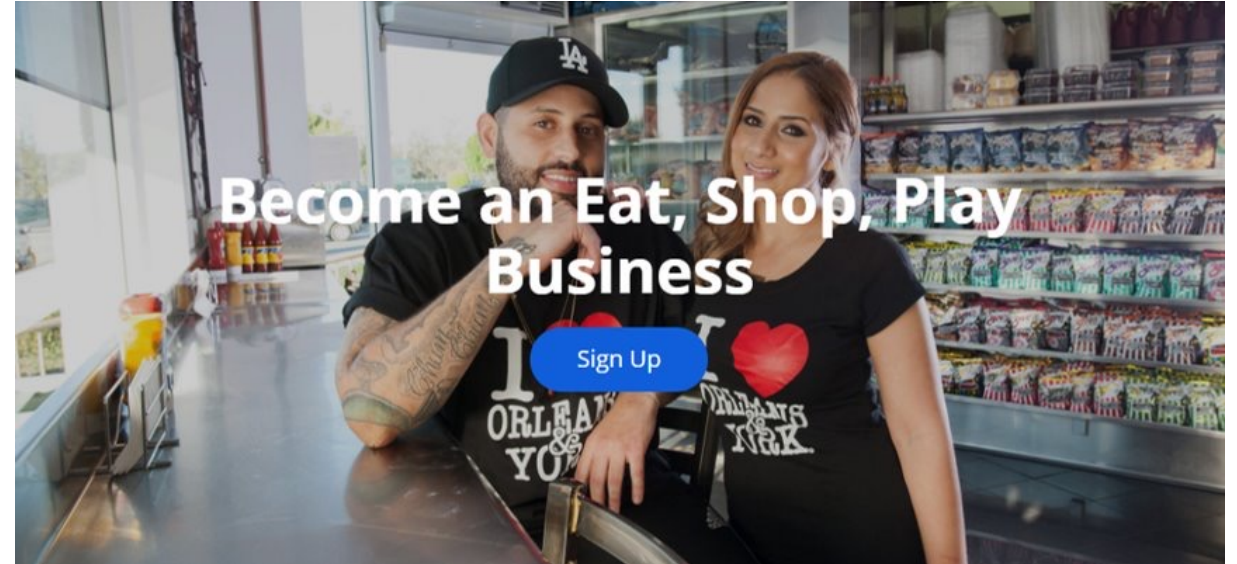

# Business Interruption Fund (BIF)



# Metro's Business Interruption Fund

- > Financial assistance to small “mom & pop” businesses with 25 or fewer full-time employees directly impacted by Metro Rail construction along four project areas:
  - > Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project
  - > Purple Line Extension, Sections 1, 2 & 3
  - > Regional Connector Project, Little Tokyo area & 2nd/Broadway Segment\*
  - > East San Fernando Valley Light Rail Transit Project
- > Businesses must be located immediately adjacent to the rail corridor and meet other eligibility requirements
- > Grant amounts are determined by business revenue loss directly related to period of Metro construction disruption
- > Businesses may receive up to \$50,000 per impact year

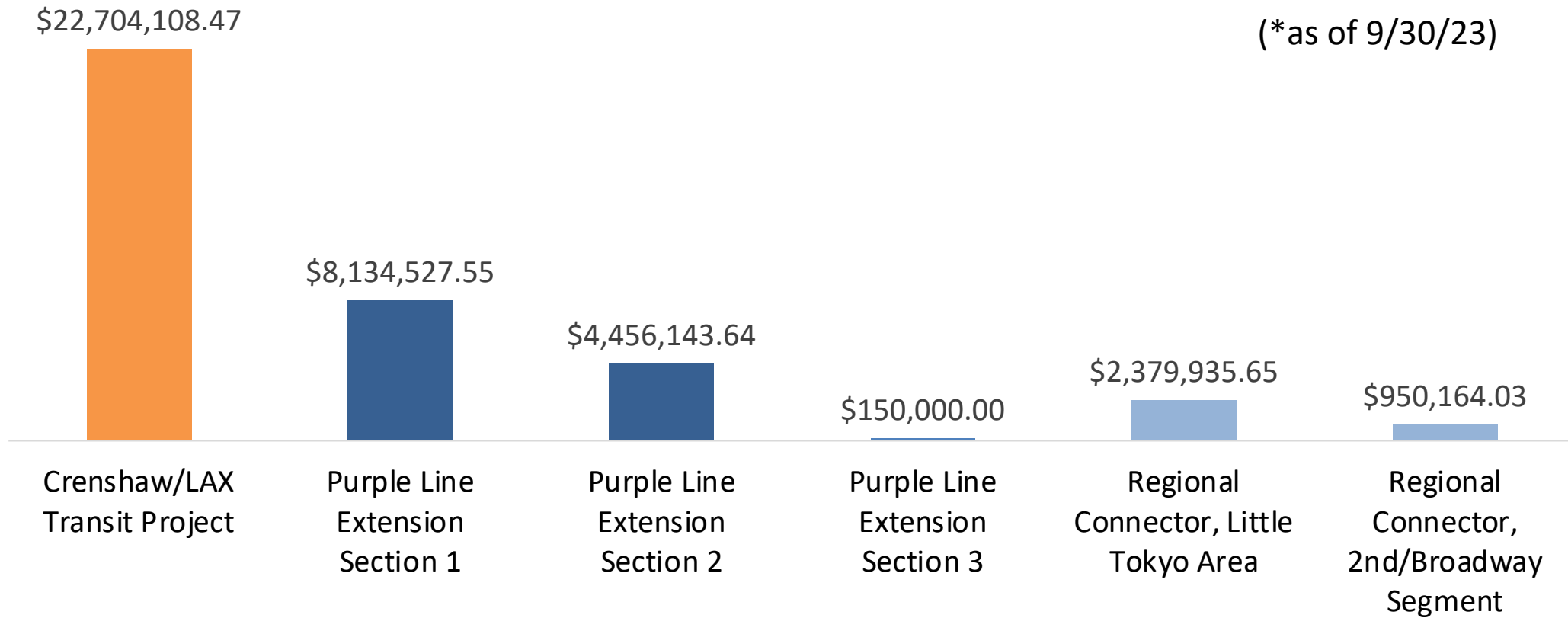
