

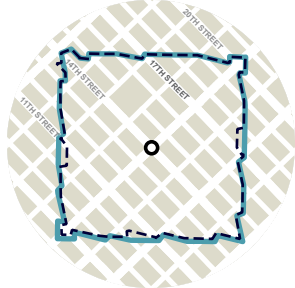

Shows the area within a half-mile of the street network

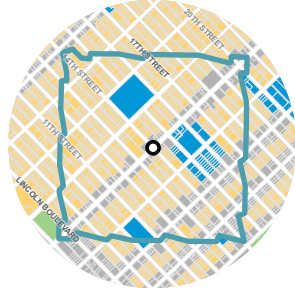

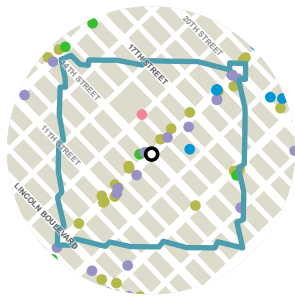

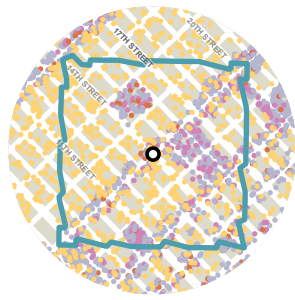

Commercial and residential dot density



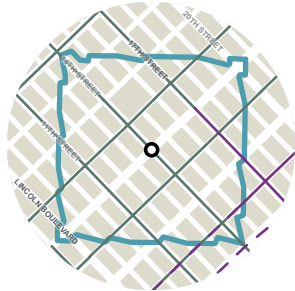

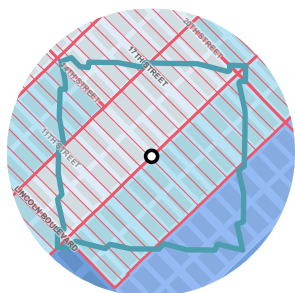

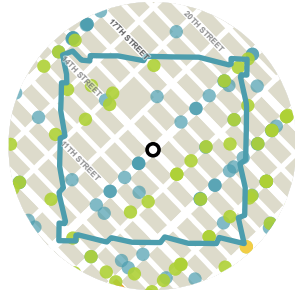

Collisions shown by mode

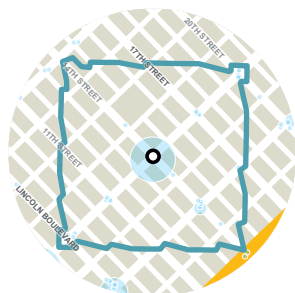

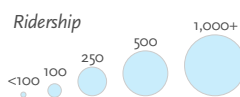
