Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) Work

Summary

Metro will perform non-invasive Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) work to detect, mark and confirm any underground structures related to the East San Fernando Valley Light Rail Transit.

Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) work will occur along Van Nuys Bl at the intersections of Aetna St and Parthenia St. Due to this activity:

- Van Nuys Bl will be reduced to one lane in each direction at certain intersections. Bike lane will be shared with vehicular lane.
- Left turn lanes will be prohibited at certain intersections north bound and south bound on Van Nuys Bl.
- Westbound right turn lane will be prohibited on Parthenia St
- Cross streets will be closed and open only to residents (refer to schedule).
- Parking will be limited on Van Nuys Bl. between intersections.

Noteworthy

Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) work consists of marking underground utility locations on the pavement with non-permanent paint and will not have loud noises during the night time hours of operation.
