# Discounted Fares/LIFE Program

## Discounted Prices

- **Buy a pass, save half**
  - 1-Day, 7-Day and 30-Day passes at half-price savings that riders can start using on Jan. 10.
  - \$3.50 for a day pass, \$12.50 for a weekly pass and \$50 for a 30-day pass
  - The fares will be available on TAP vending machines, [taptogo.net](https://taptogo.net) and at Metro Customer Centers for purchase beginning December 15, 2021

## Low-Income Fare Is Easy (LIFE) Program

- **Six months of discounted LIFE fares.**
  - **New** LIFE riders will get **90 days of free rides** starting January 10, 2022
  - \$26 for a 30-day pass (regularly \$76)
  - \$6.50 for a 7-day pass (regularly \$19.50).

# Project Overview

Metro and Caltrans District 7 are making operational and safety enhancements along I-5 in the north of Los Angeles County from the SR-14 interchange to south of Parker Rd in Castaic.

Project components includes:

- 14-miles of HOV/carpool lanes in each direction
- Four sound wall segments (12 sound walls)
- Replacement of Weldon Canyon Rd bridge
- Seven bridge widenings
- Extension of truck lanes
- 13.6-miles of median paving
- 43 Retaining walls
- Intelligent Transportation System Improvements



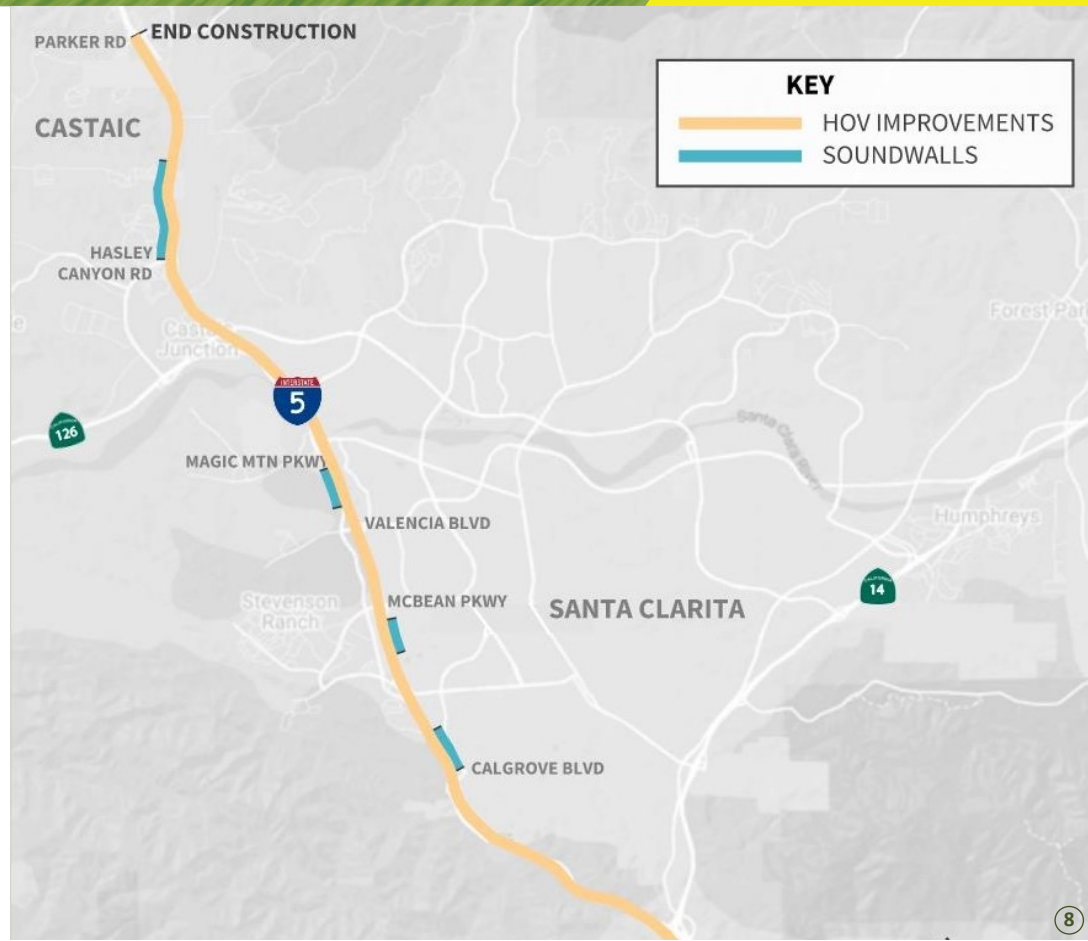
# Sound Walls Segments

- North of Hasley Canyon Rd
- Magic Mountain Pkwy - Valencia Bl

## I-5 Northbound

- South of McBean Pkwy
- North of Calgrove Bl

# Upcoming Construction Activities

**Ongoing:** Installation of temporary construction signage

**Early November:** Anticipated start of construction

**Construction site preparation from SR-14 interchange to Lyons Av / Pico Canyon Rd**

Nightly 8 pm – 6 am in early November

- Northbound and southbound placement of K-rail (temporary barrier), road restriping, and median removal

**Daytime Construction Activities:**

Anticipated in November-December

- Crews working behind k-rail (temporary barriers)
- Installation of drainage systems along median



# Northbound I-5 truck route closure

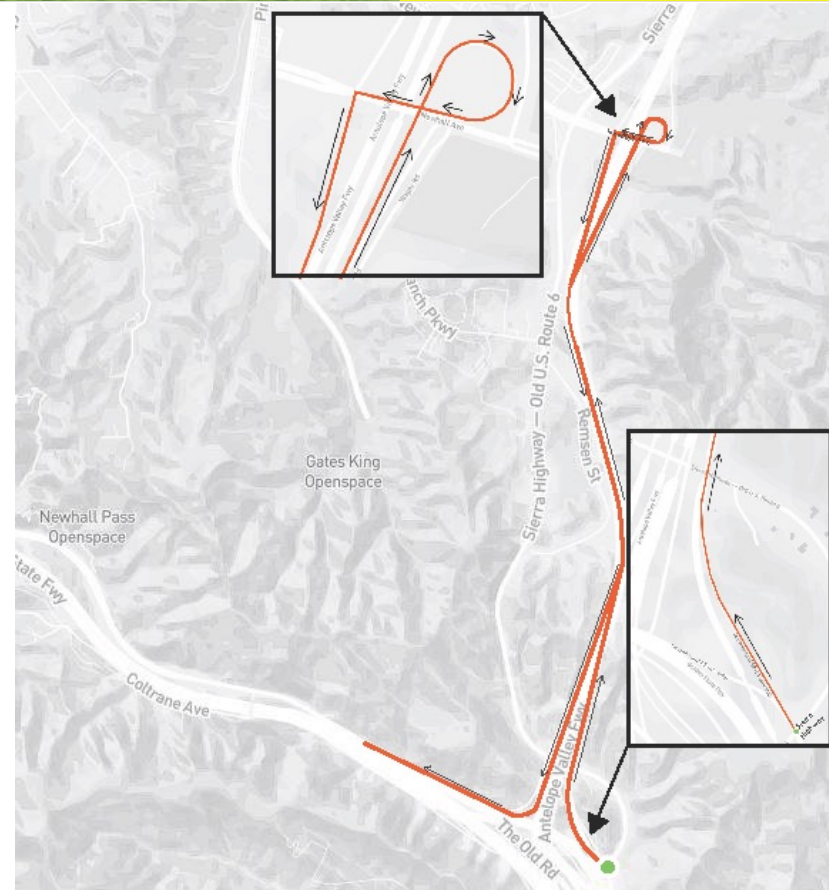
**One Night Closure: 11 pm – 5 am in mid-November**  
From I-210 interchange to Weldon Canyon Rd Bridge

## What to Expect:

- Pavement restriping and K-rail (temporary construction barrier) installation.
- All trucks traveling northbound I-5 and SR-14 to use northbound general-purpose lanes.

## Sierra Hwy on-ramp at Foothill Blvd Detour:

- Traffic at Sierra Hwy on-ramp at Foothill Bl to use SR-14.
- Use Newhall Ave exit and turn left to southbound SR-14 to merge onto northbound I-5.



# Southbound Lyons Ave / Pico Canyon Rd on-ramp and off-ramp closure

**Two Night Closure: 7 pm – 6 am in mid-November**

Closure of southbound Lyons Ave / Pico Canyon Rd on-ramp and off-ramp

## What to Expect:

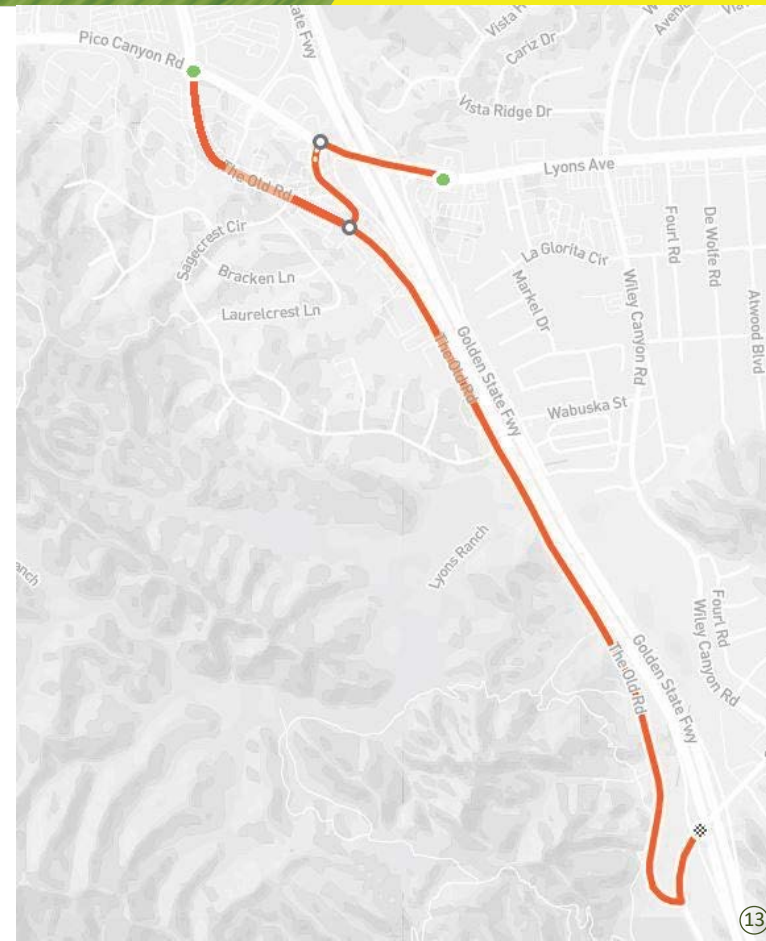
- Striping and k-rail (temporary barrier) installation

## Lyons Ave / Pico Canyon Rd On-Ramp Detour:

- Southbound on Chiquella Ln
- Southbound on The Old Rd
- Eastbound on Calgrove Blvd
- Enter on Calgrove Blvd on-ramp to southbound I-5

## Lyons Ave / Pico Canyon Rd Off-Ramp Detour:

- Alternative 1: Exit on McBean Pkwy off-ramp
- Alternative 2: Exit on Calgrove Blvd off-ramp



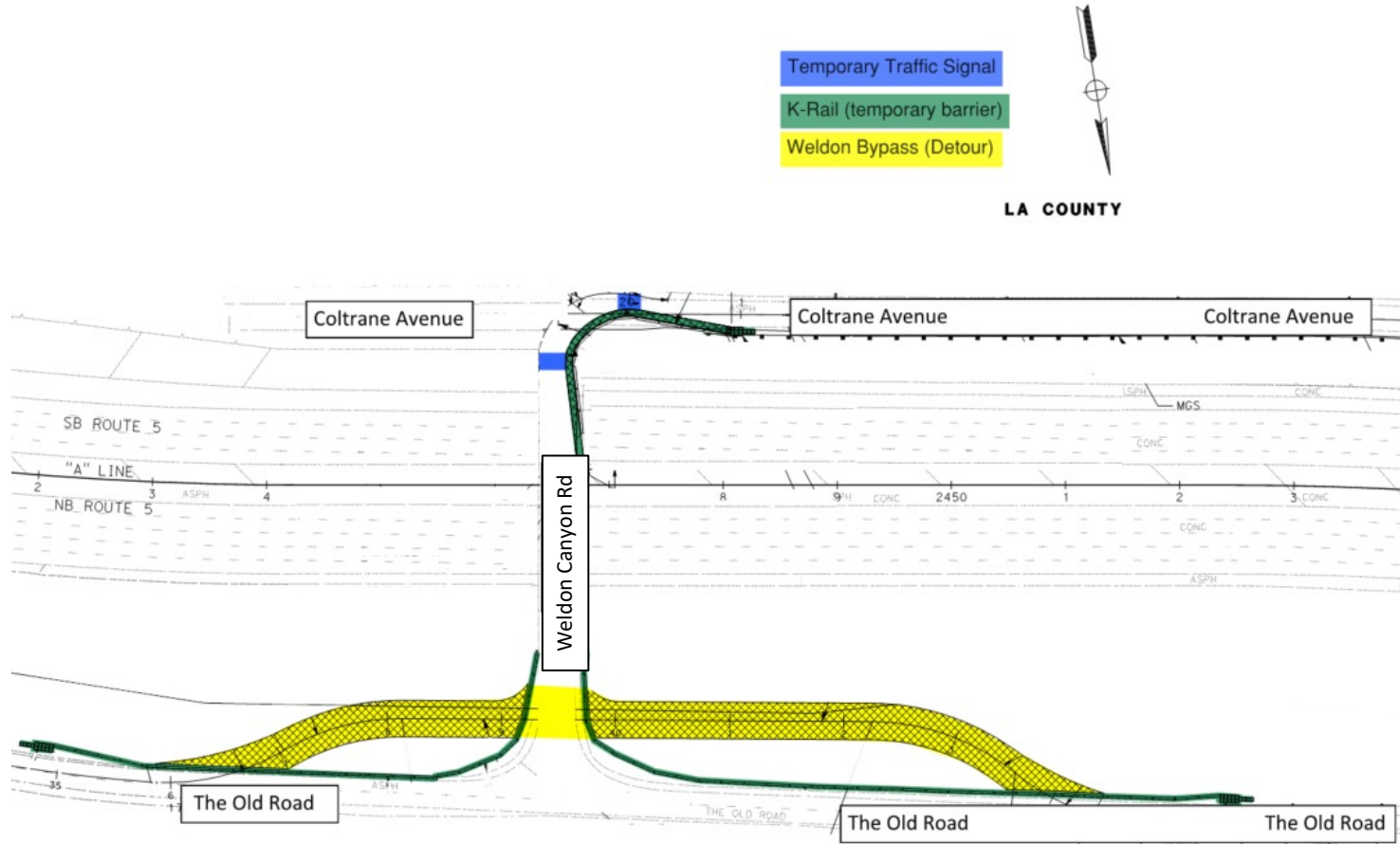
# Weldon Canyon Rd Bridge

## Mid-November:

Paving of The Old Rd detour and installation of traffic light on the west side.

## Early December:

Beginning construction of footings/foundation for a new bridge at Weldon Canyon Rd.
