Caltrans and Metro are evaluating alternatives to convert existing high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lanes to dynamically priced, high-occupancy toll (HOT) lanes, also called ExpressLanes, or add a second HOV lane in both directions on Interstate 10 (I-10) from the current ExpressLanes end point at I-605 to the Los Angeles/San Bernardino County line. The study area includes the Cities of El Monte, Industry, Baldwin Park, Covina, West Covina, San Dimas, Walnut, Pomona, Claremont, Montclair as well as unincorporated Los Angeles County.

The Notice of Preparation and other project materials are available for public review on the project website. The project team will be initiating the scoping period for public comment between April 25, 2022 and June 10, 2022, in conformance with CEQA and NEPA. Comments may be submitted during the public scoping period via mail, email, the project website comment form, or the project hotline.
