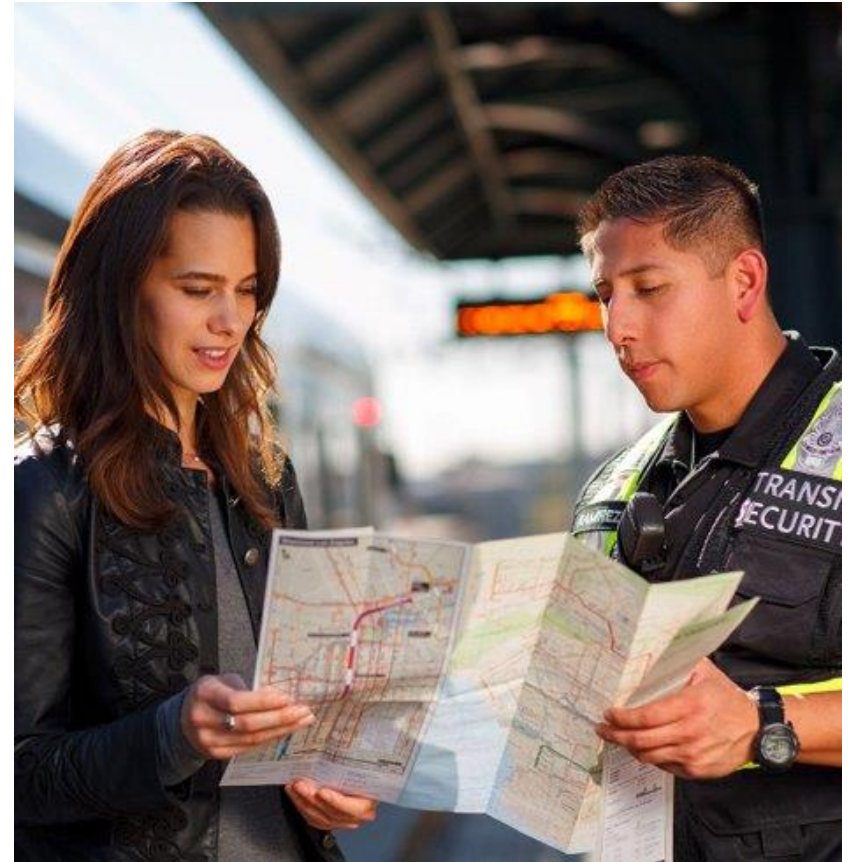

Discounted Prices (Buy a Pass, Save Half)

1-Day, 7-Day and 30-Day passes have been discounted a whopping 50 percent through December 31, 2022.

•Pass fares are:

- \$3.50 for a Day Pass
- \$12.50 for a Weekly Pass
- \$50 for a 30-Day Pass
- Discounted pass fares are now available for purchase at Metro TAP vending machines, Metro Customer Centers, TAP retail vendors throughout L.A. County and on [taptogo.net](https://www.metro.net/tap).

Low Income Fare Is Easy (LIFE) Program

- New LIFE riders will get 90 days of free rides (Promotion runs through December 31, 2022)
- \$26 for a 30-day pass (regular \$76)
- \$6.50 for a 7-day pass (regular \$19.50)

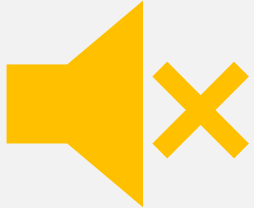

- > Abandoned rail equipment removed
- > Contaminated soils removed east of Main St and Slauson Av
- > Construction Contract Awarded to Griffith Company
- > Clearing work, demolition, and fence installation ongoing
- > Right of Way excavation complete
- > 8th Av Intersection Improvement Work

On the Horizon: 4th Av Intersection Improvement

Contractor will begin the intersection improvement work

- > **When:** TBD
- > **Where:** 4th Av between Southwest Dr and Hyde Park Bl and Hyde Park Bl between 5th Av and 4th Av
- > **Duration:** approximately two months

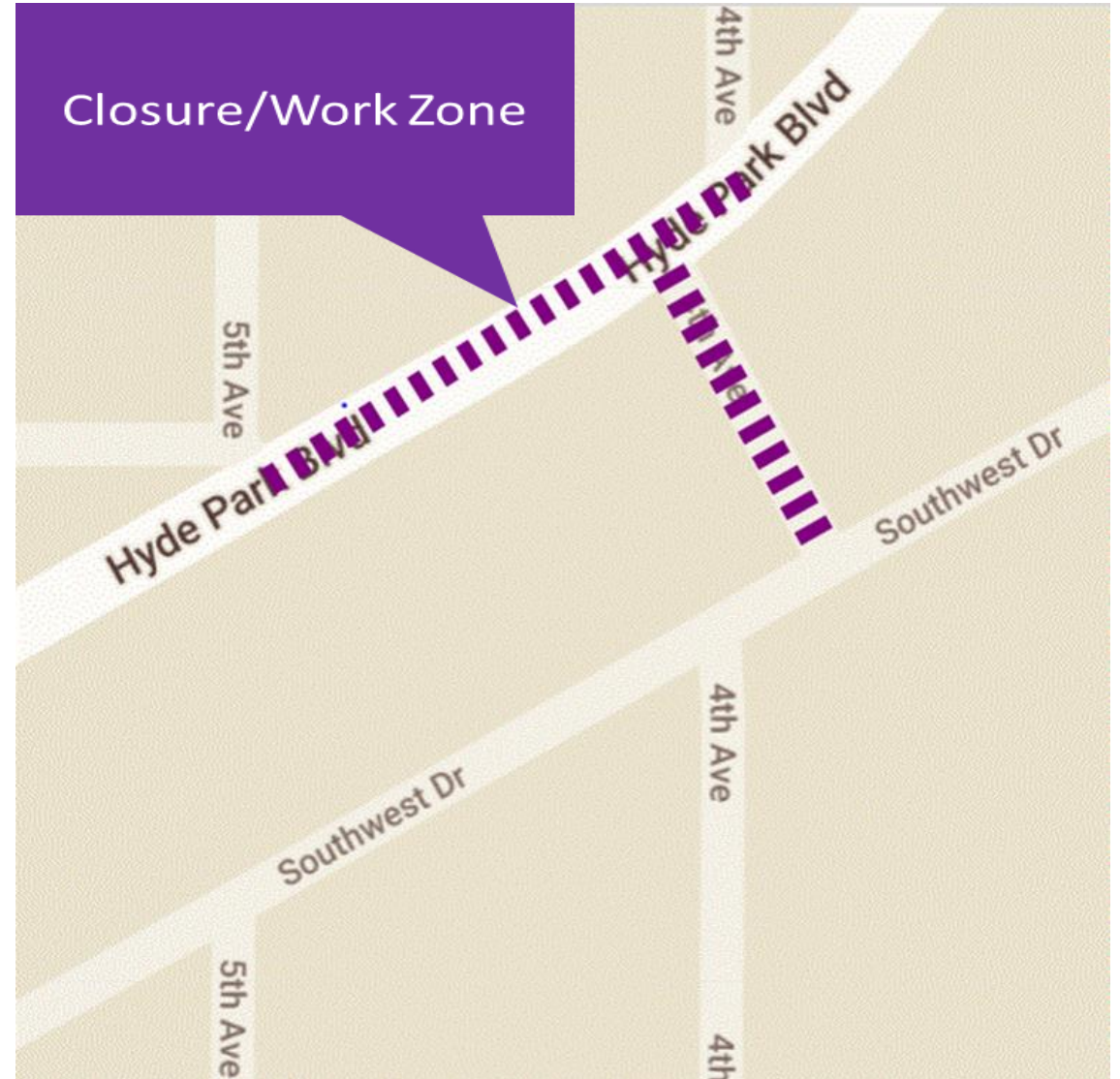
What to Expect

Stage 1 closure of northbound 4th Av between Southwest Dr and Hyde Park Bl and eastbound Hyde Park Bl.

Stage 2 closure of eastbound Hyde Park Bl from 5th Av to 4th Av, and southbound 4th Av between Hyde Park Bl and Southwest Dr.

Work hours

- > Workdays from Monday to Saturday
- > The closures will be in place for the duration of activity



On the Horizon: Western Av Intersection Improvement

Contractor will begin the intersection improvement work

- > **When:** TBD
- > **Where:** Western Av between Slauson Av and 62nd St.
- > **Duration:** approximately 2 months

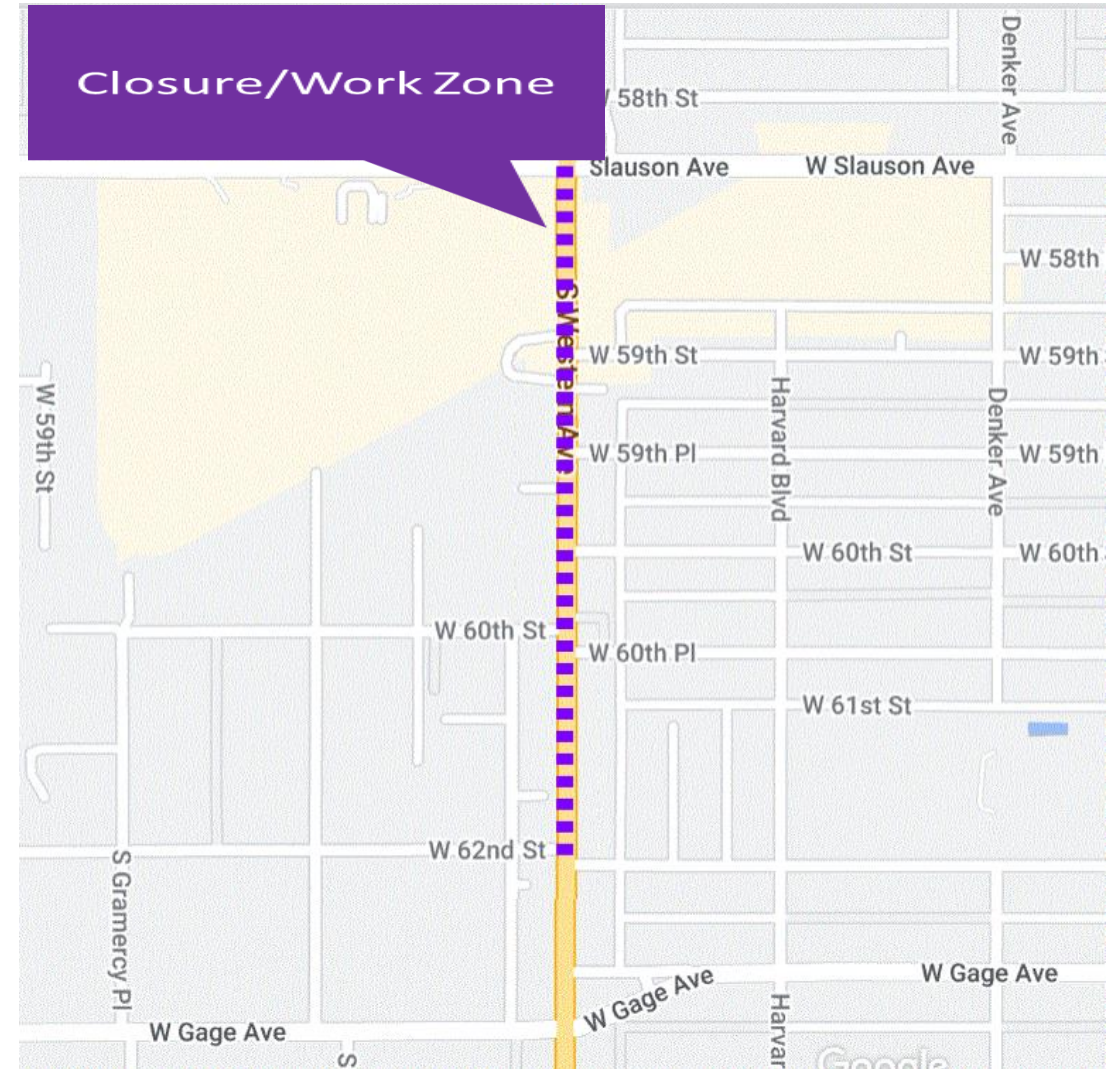
What to Expect
