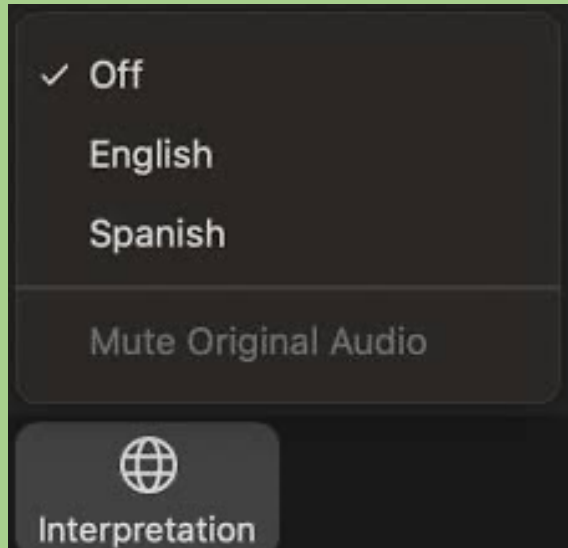

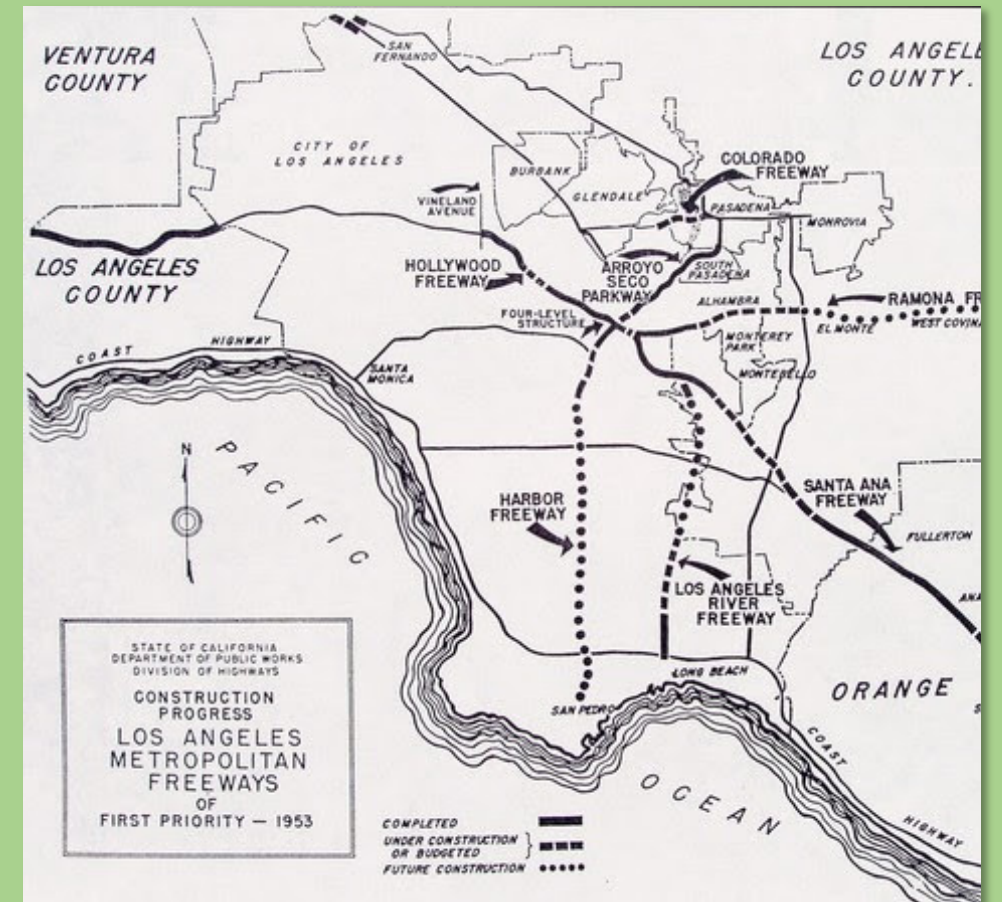

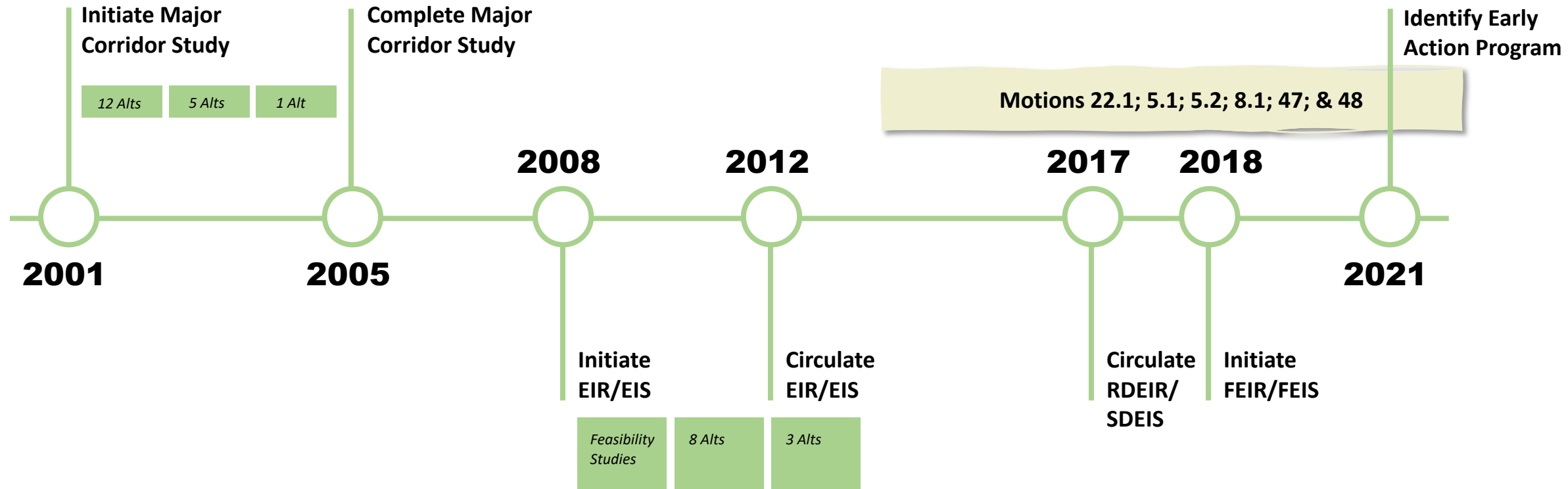
How we got here today

Corridor History

- Communities living along the corridor before the freeway was constructed.
- We must understand the past & its impacts still felt today.
- Nearly a century of racial segregation enforced by public policy has impacted the I-710 S Corridor on which people & goods are moved today.
- Public policies resulted in limited access to financing, open space, food, safety, & transportation for communities of color.
- These policies have created severe, enduring effects on communities – which continue to widen today.
- Many negative impacts from goods movement that harm LA's residents are tied to their proximity to the 710 Corridor.
- Redlining policies created segregated patterns of development, financial investment, infrastructure & social dynamics in LA County communities.


