About the Project

- > Metro is partnering with the BNSF Railway, the City of Santa Fe Springs, California High-Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA), and Caltrans' Division of Rail and Mass Transportation (DRMT) to construct a bridge to separate the Rosecrans Ave and Marquardt Ave intersection from the existing diagonal at-grade crossing of the BNSF railway.
- > This proposed project will substantially enhance the safety and traffic flow, including truck and vehicular circulation, on the surface streets.
- > Construction is ongoing through Summer of 2025.
- > Contractor: Flatiron Construction

Current Work

- Continue to construct Rosecrans Ave, Marquardt Ave, Anson Ave, and Frontage Rd/Stage Rd.
- Reconstructing driveways and sidewalks.
- Grading, paving, landscaping, fencing, and signage.



Current Work

- BNSF is working on removals on the tracks.



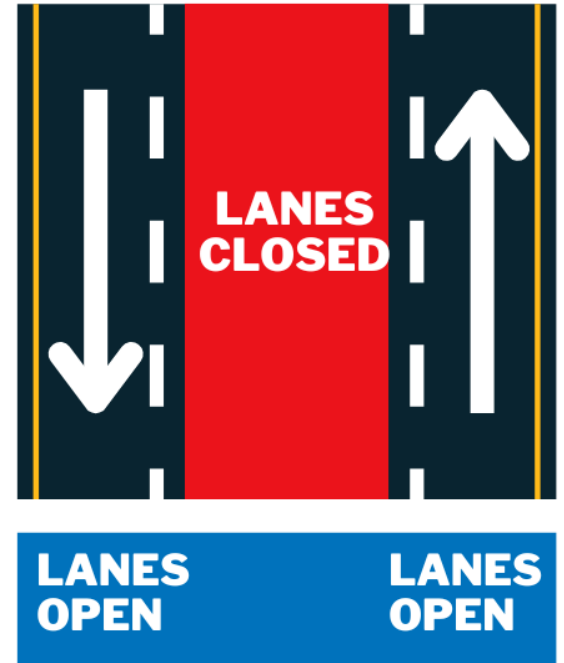
Upcoming Traffic Switch – June 2024

TRAFFIC PATTERN

- Traffic will be switched to the outside lanes on the Rosecrans Ave Bridge.
- Two lanes in each direction will remain open to traffic.

THE WORK

- Construct the remaining raised median on the Westside.
- Install landscape on the bridge.

- One lane in each direction was opened to traffic.

Current Work - Ongoing

- Continue to construct Rosecrans Ave, Marquardt Ave, Anson Ave, and Frontage Rd/Stage Rd.
- Reconstructing driveways and sidewalks.
- Installing new light poles.
- Grading, paving, landscaping, fencing, and signage.

Summer 2025

The project will be completed!

- Open the remaining two lanes in each direction on the Rosecrans Ave Bridge.
- Open the realigned Rosecrans Ave, Marquardt Ave and Frontage Rd.
