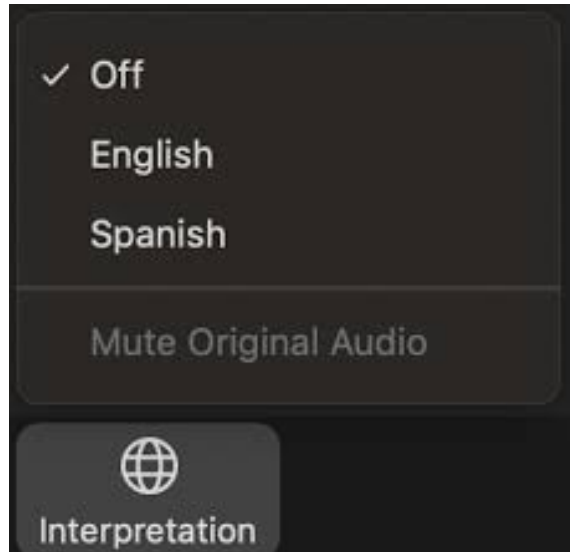

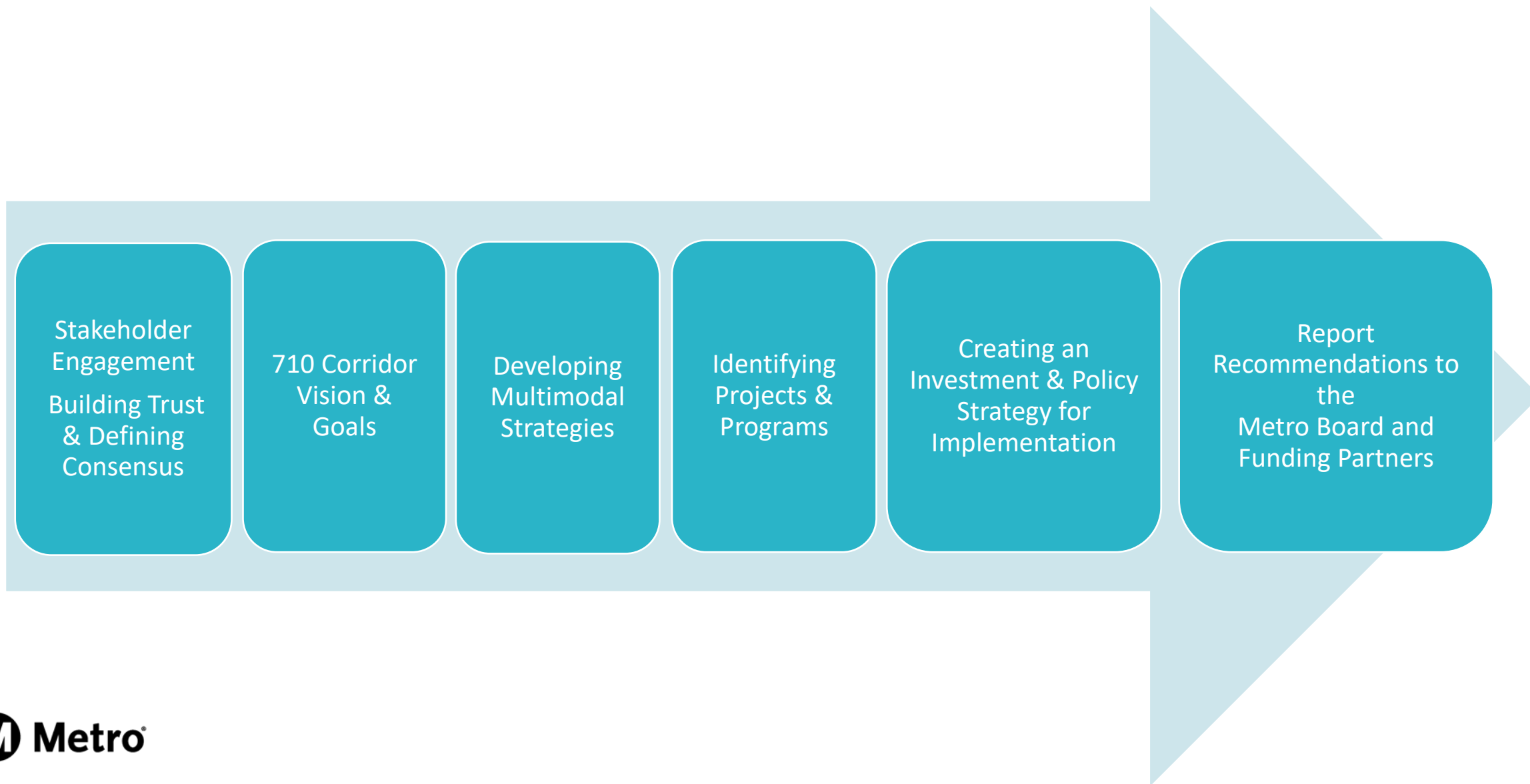

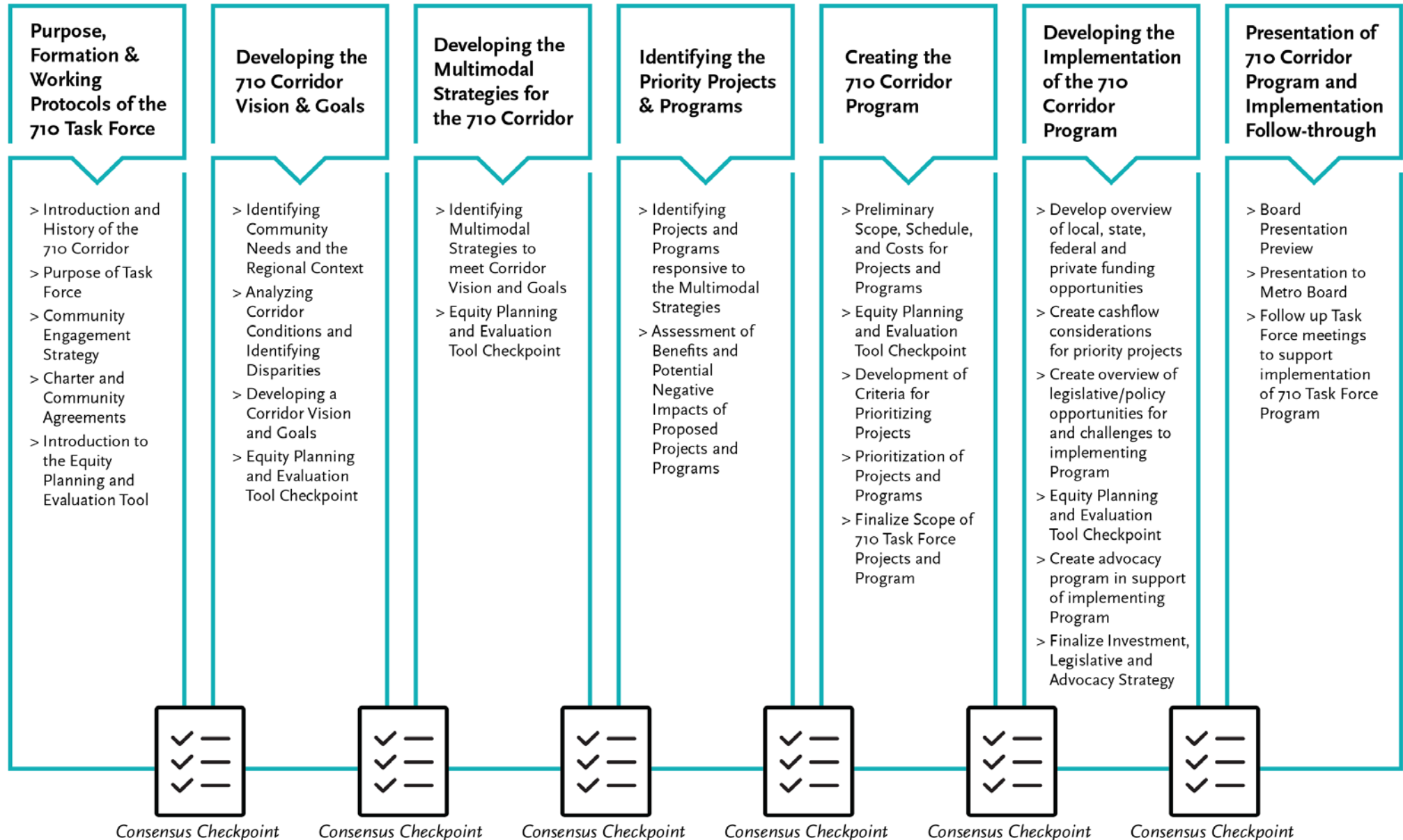

# Metro Board Clean Truck Motion

# Metro Board Motion – Directors Hahn and Dutra

## > 710 South Clean Truck Program

- Recommit \$50 million from Measure R I-710 South Corridor Project funds as "seed funding" for a 710 South Clean Truck Program,
- Collaborate with the I-710 Task Force, local and regional stakeholders, cities, the Ports, the I-710 South Task Force, and the Gateway Cities COG to develop a 710 South Clean Truck Program that seeks to deploy Zero Emissions trucks in the I-710 Corridor as soon as possible,
- Conduct aggressive Federal and State advocacy to secure funding for a 710 South Clean Truck Program, including as many as possible of the 1,000 Zero Emissions trucks included in the FY22 California State budget,
- Report back to the Board in February 2022 and May 2022 with updates on stakeholder engagement and Program development and implementation, including areas for possible further study, consideration and development to achieve Zero Emissions goods movement objectives along the I-710 South Corridor.

# Executive Order N-19-21

- > The Governor has issued an executive order to ease supply chain backlogs at California's ports.
- > State agencies have been asked to find sites that can be used for the short-term storage of cargo, and to identify priority freight routes that could get temporary exemptions on weight restrictions.
- > Priority could be given to freight related projects considered in discretionary grant programs administered by CALSTA, Caltrans and other state agencies; request to do the same made to the California Transportation Commission, which oversees the Senate Bill 1 grant programs.
- > This EO highlights the significant demand and unique scale of the goods movement in LA County and the Southern California region and the need for greater transportation investment to strengthen the resiliency of our system.
