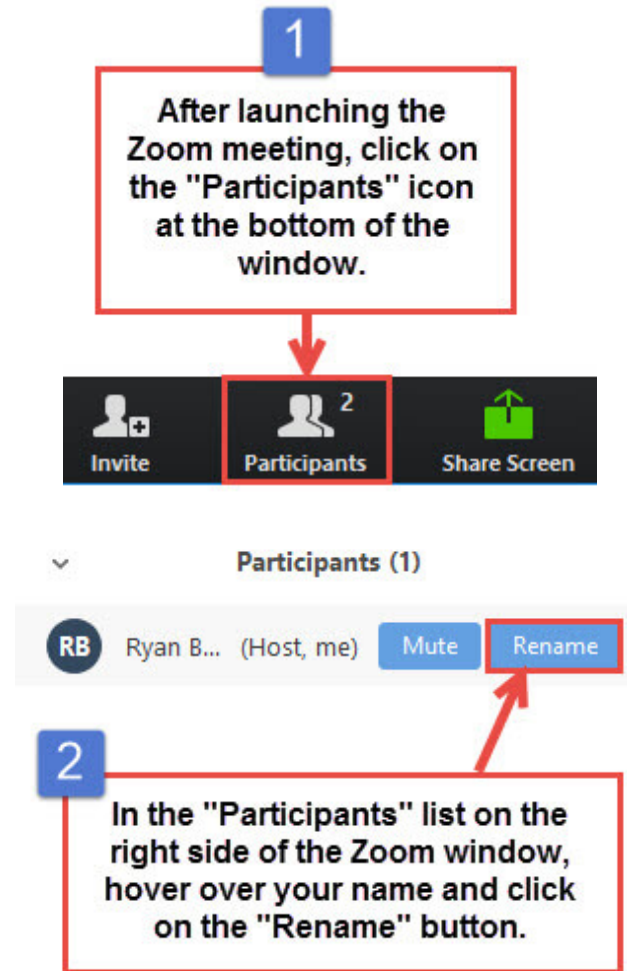

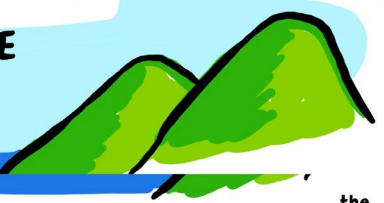

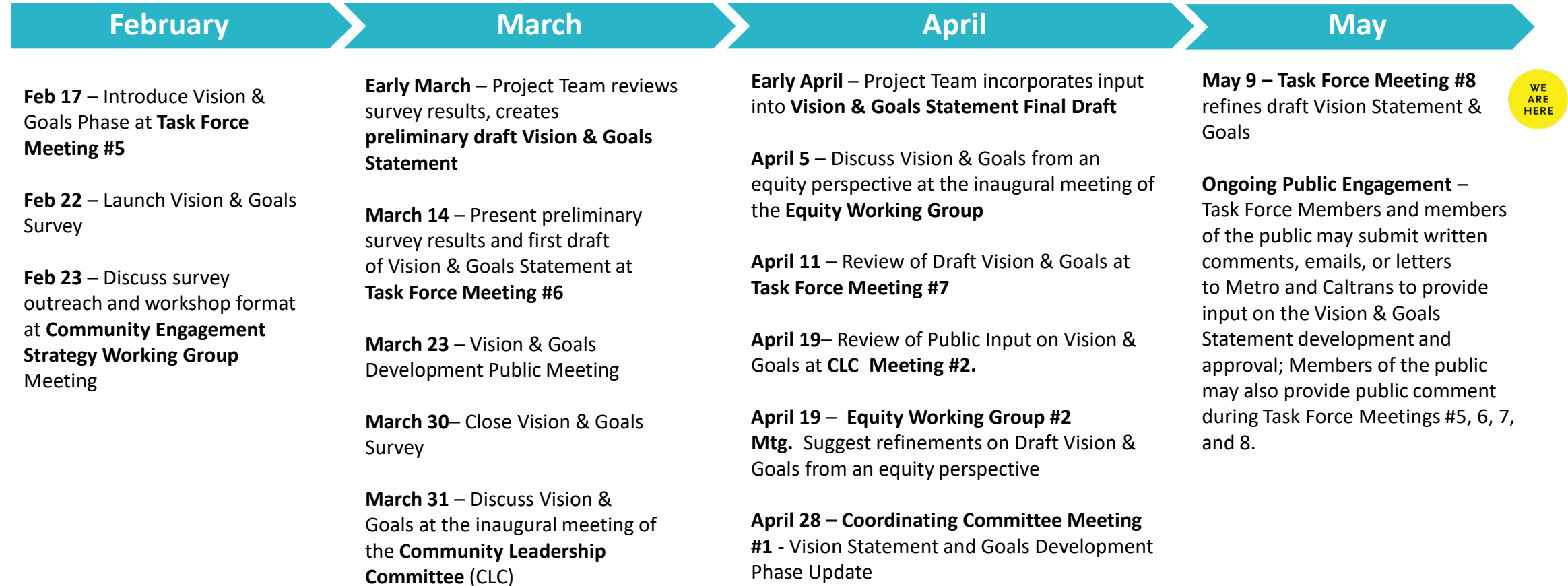

Vision, Goals & Objectives Approach

Vision

A concise statement that captures the collective aspirations, desires, and outcomes of the project

Vision:

DRAFT Vision Statement (April 11, 2022):

An equitable multimodal shared-use transportation system that supports clean air, healthy and sustainable communities, economic resilience and quality jobs; and provides safe, quality mobility options for all residents and users of the I-710 South Corridor.

Draft Vision Statement – Community Leadership Committee Input

- > Make sure all language is easy to understand. Simplify terms and make it more community friendly
- > Include public health as a priority
- > Make sure the statement puts the "community" first
- > Address noise impacts
- > Make the guiding principle more specific and less generic, by specifically referring to the 710 residents
- > Spanish and English statements might need to be a little different to capture the same terms and concepts

Draft Vision Statement – Community Leadership Committee Input

(Work in progress – to be discussed further during May CLC meeting)

An equitable multi-modal (walking, taking public transportation, riding a bike, driving, etc.) shared transportation system for the community and residents which ~~promotes~~ fosters clean air, healthy and sustainable communities, economic ~~resilience~~ empowerment; and provides safe, quality mobility options for all residents and users of the I-710 South Corridor.

Draft Vision Statement – Equity Working Group Input

- > Proposed to Task Force that “Equity” and “Sustainability” Goals be replaced with guiding principles
- > Proposed Task Force consideration of Equity Guiding Principle
- > Proposed Task Force consideration of a refined Vision Statement

Draft Vision Statement – Equity Working Group

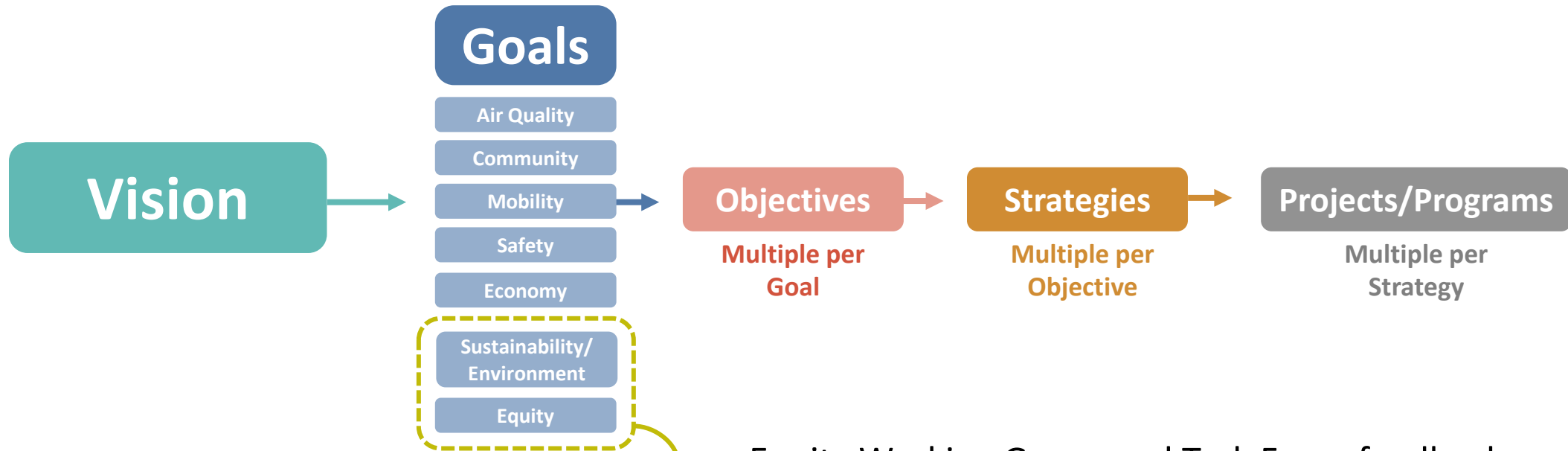

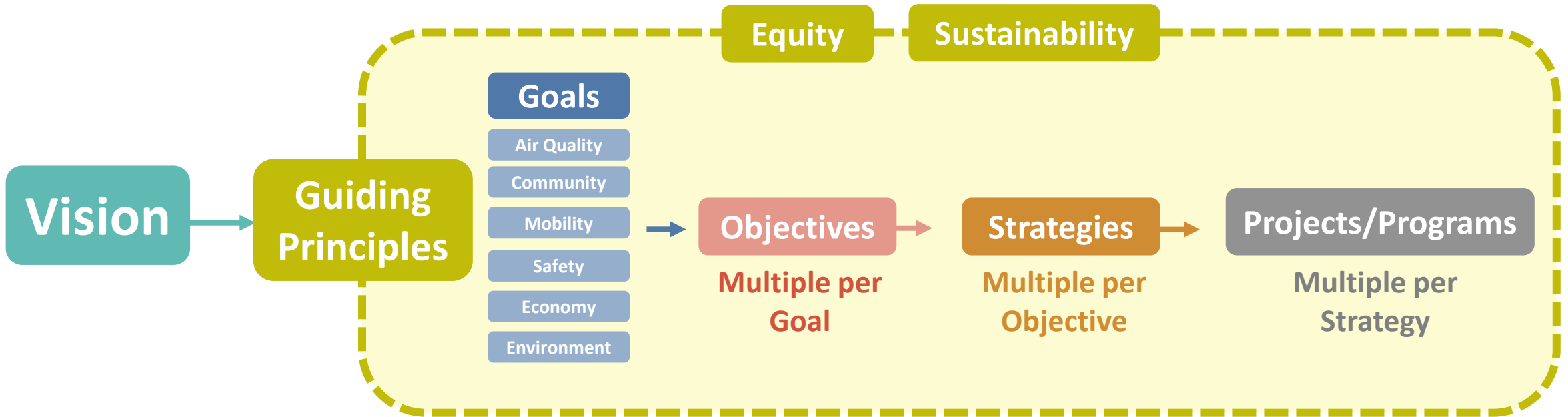

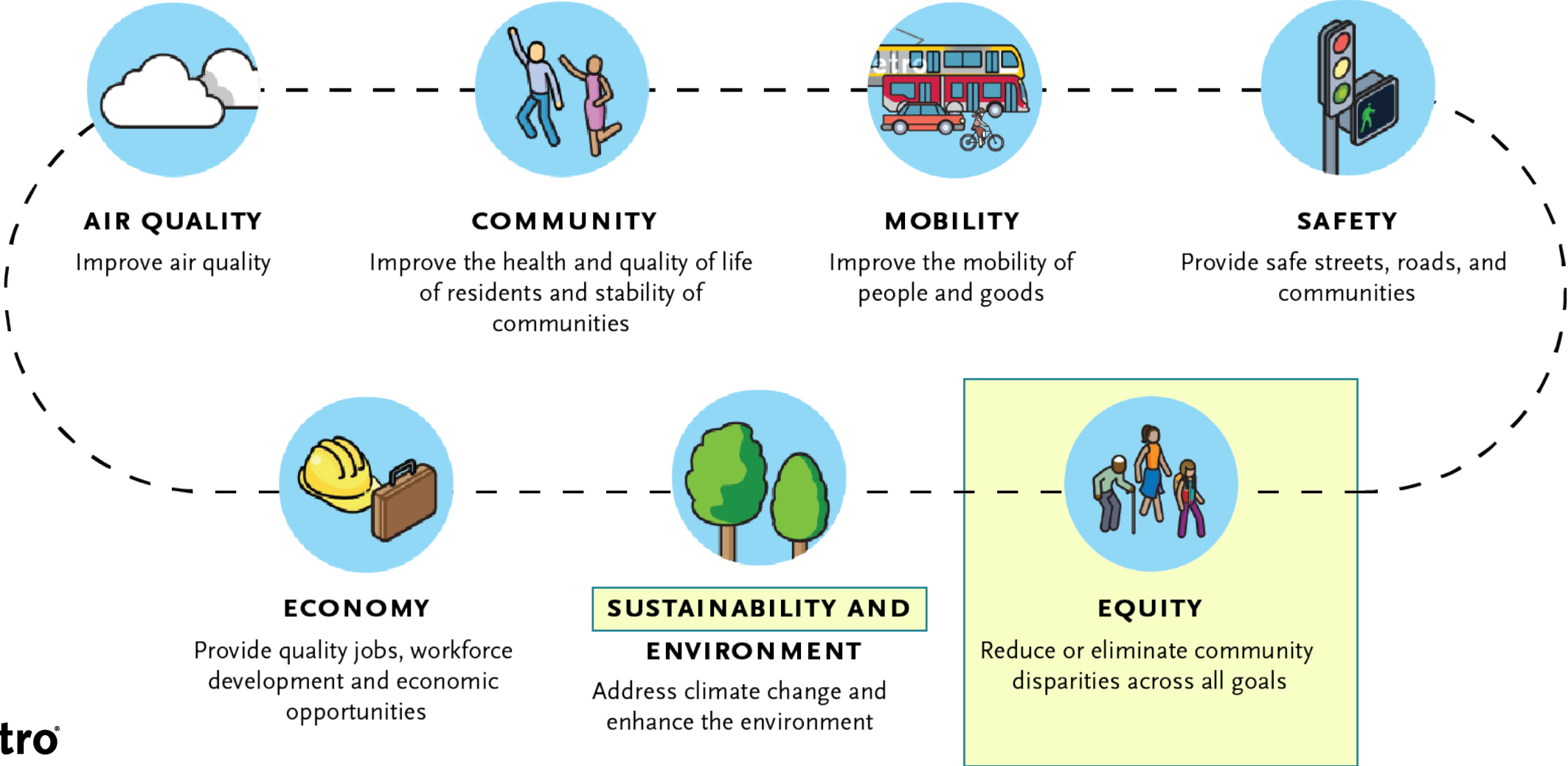

Why Introduce Equity and Sustainability as Guiding Principles?

Equity & Sustainability apply to all aspects of the 710 South Corridor Investment Plan and Task Force.

- > Precedent: 2021 LA County Goods Movement Strategic Plan

Helps to further define Equity and Sustainability to achieve common understanding

- > Opportunity to clarify multilayered components of Equity and Justice, and how they tie into the planning process: **Procedural + Distributive + Restorative + Structural Equity**
- > Provides a definition of Sustainability that encompasses its broad meaning and how it applies to the planning process

A guiding principle would:

- > Inform processes and initiatives at every stage of the project
- > Help to focus discussions and identify priorities
- > Tie independent components of project work into a cohesive and intentional framework
- > Reduce redundancies within objectives and strategies

EWG's Proposed Guiding Principle of Equity Statement

The I-710 South Corridor Investment Plan is founded on the Guiding Principle of Equity – a commitment to: (1) strive to rectify past harms; (2) provide fair and just access to opportunities; and 3) eliminate disparities in project processes, outcomes, and community results.

The plan seeks to elevate and engrain the principle of Equity across all goals, objectives, strategies, and actions through a framework of Procedural, Distributive, Structural, and Restorative Equity, and by prioritizing an accessible and representative participation process for communities most impacted by the I-710.

Procedural Equity

- > Proactive and accessible community engagement that bridges linguistic, technology, and ability gaps to meet communities where they are and enable participatory and representative decision-making processes
- > Ongoing systems of accountability and communication to build and maintain trust

Distributive Equity

- > Allocation of benefits and amenities proportionate to levels of need and historic investment and based on self-identified community priorities rather than 'one-size-fits-all' solutions
- > Policies and resource management to ensure benefits reach intended recipients

Restorative Equity

- > Acknowledgement of, and atonement for historic and ongoing systemic harms resulting from planning practice and policy
- > Commensurate actions, resources, and investments dedicated to remediation and prevention of further systemic harms

Structural Equity

- > Evolution of decision-making bodies to reflect the communities they serve
- > Restructuring of organizational systems and hierarchies to empower historically marginalized groups

Proposed Guiding Principle of Sustainability Statement for Discussion

- > The I-710 South Corridor Investment Plan is founded on the Guiding Principle of Sustainability: *"Development that meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs"*
- > *"A commitment to sustainability is the satisfaction of basic social and economic needs, both present and future, and the responsible use of natural resources, all while maintaining or improving the well-being of the environment on which life depends."*

Economic Sustainability

- > Focuses on practices that support long-term economic growth without negatively impacting social, environmental, and cultural aspects of the community.

Social Sustainability

- > Focuses on the basic social needs of humans including health and well-being, education, dignity, equality, peace and justice.

Environmental Sustainability

- > Is the responsibility to conserve natural resources and protect global ecosystems to support health and wellbeing, now and in the future.

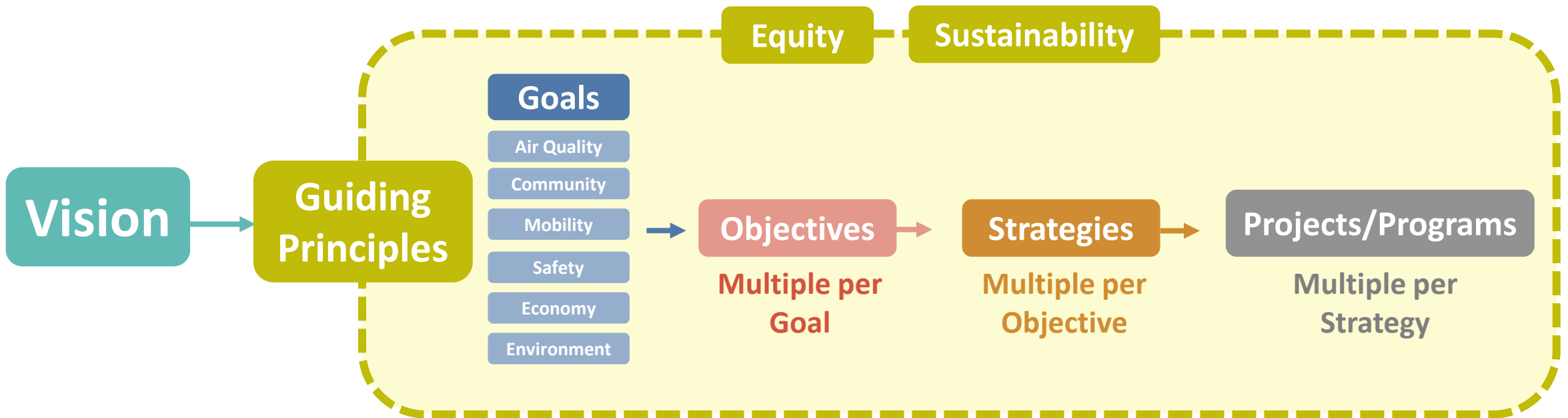
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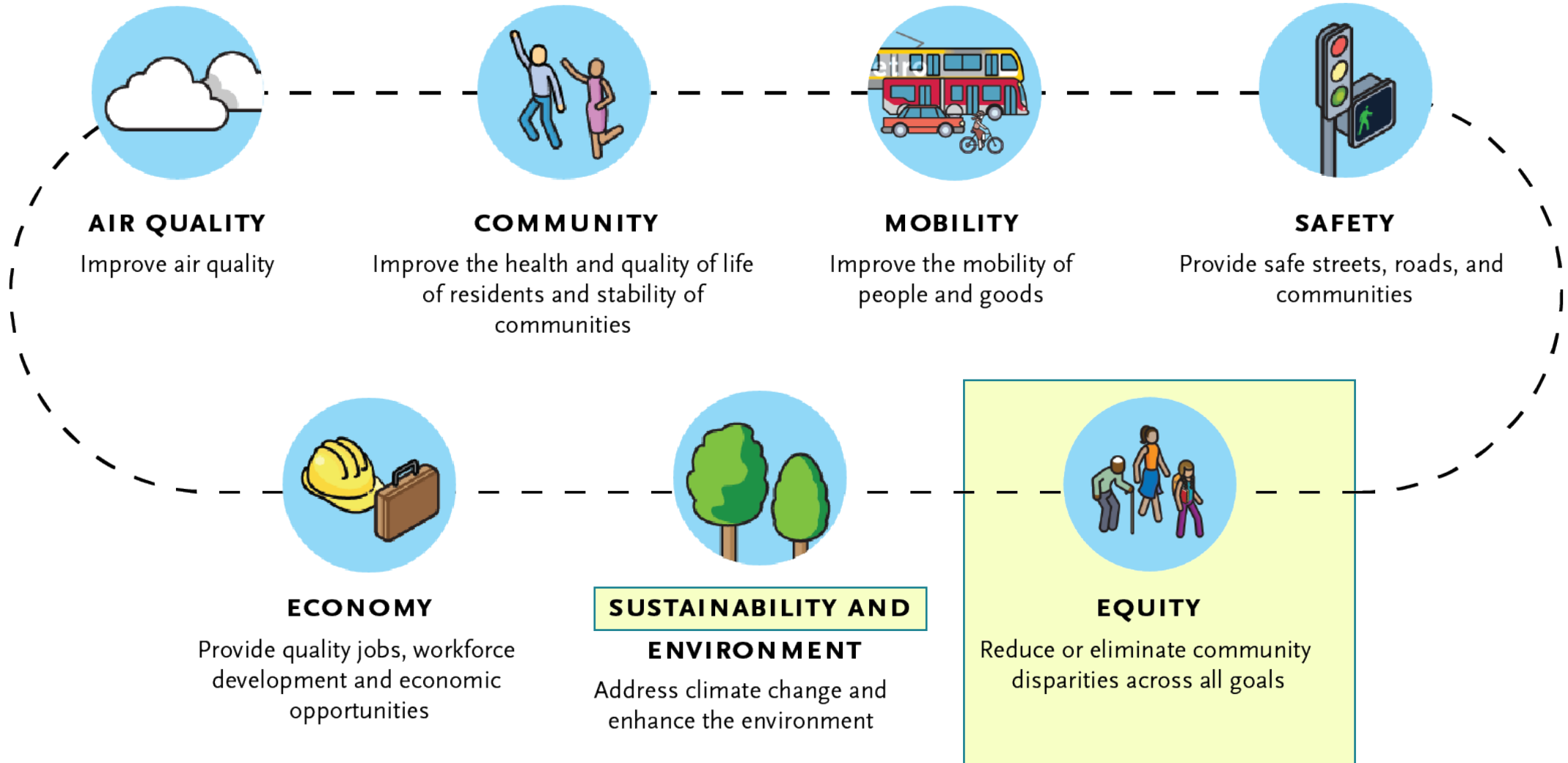

Goals: Example of Task Force Input (Objectives)

- > **Goal: Improve the Mobility of People and Goods**

- > Objectives: (Task Force provided as a suggested goal)
 - Increase multimodal transportation options
 - Implement Innovative solutions
 - Prioritize bicycle use and public transportation
 - Increase shared mobility opportunities
 - Implement infrastructure for easy, accessible, equitable access
 - Increase the importance of residential streets + arterial highway network and local roads

Goals: Example of Task Force Input (Strategies)

> Goal: Improve the Mobility of People and Goods

> Strategies: (Task Force provided as a suggested goal):

- Increase use of Alameda Corridor
- Develop wide sidewalks across the 710 freeway
- Deploy latest and emerging tech advances for communications between motorists and traffic control systems
- Provide a faster regional rail route (express, with few stops) in the corridor to connect Los Angeles Union Station and downtown Long Beach
- Implement a zero-emissions national priority goods movement corridor
- Invest in alternative transportation - walkable, bikeable, and free public transportation
- Expand bus rapid transit
- Implement strategies for reducing vehicle miles traveled, work with government and employers to encourage fewer trips, more telecommuting, flexible hours.
