Safe Routes to School (SR2S) – Cycle 10

- **Funding:**
 - \$487,500 (10% local match)
- **Project Description:**
 - Outreach, traffic safety education, design, and construction
 - 2 elementary schools and 1 middle school
 - Curb ramps, bulb-outs, high-visibility crosswalks, 15 mph school speed zone signs, pedestrian signage, and all-way stop signs
- **Challenges:**
 - Scope Change
 - Cooperative Work Agreement (CWA)
 - Public distrust from previous project efforts
- **Solutions:**
 - Documentation
 - Outreach with community, specifically with Parent Teachers Associations (PTAs)

Citywide Complete Streets Plan

- **Funding:**
 - Caltrans Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program
 - \$586,500 (11.47% local match)
- **Project Website:**
 - <https://www.completeourstreets.com/>
- **Challenges:**
 - First multi-modal long-range transportation plan in the City
 - Traffic and congestion impacts
 - Feasibility of projects after adoption
- **Solutions:**
 - Outreach in the streets
 - Message of safety
 - Data analysis
 - Internal staff Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) meetings
