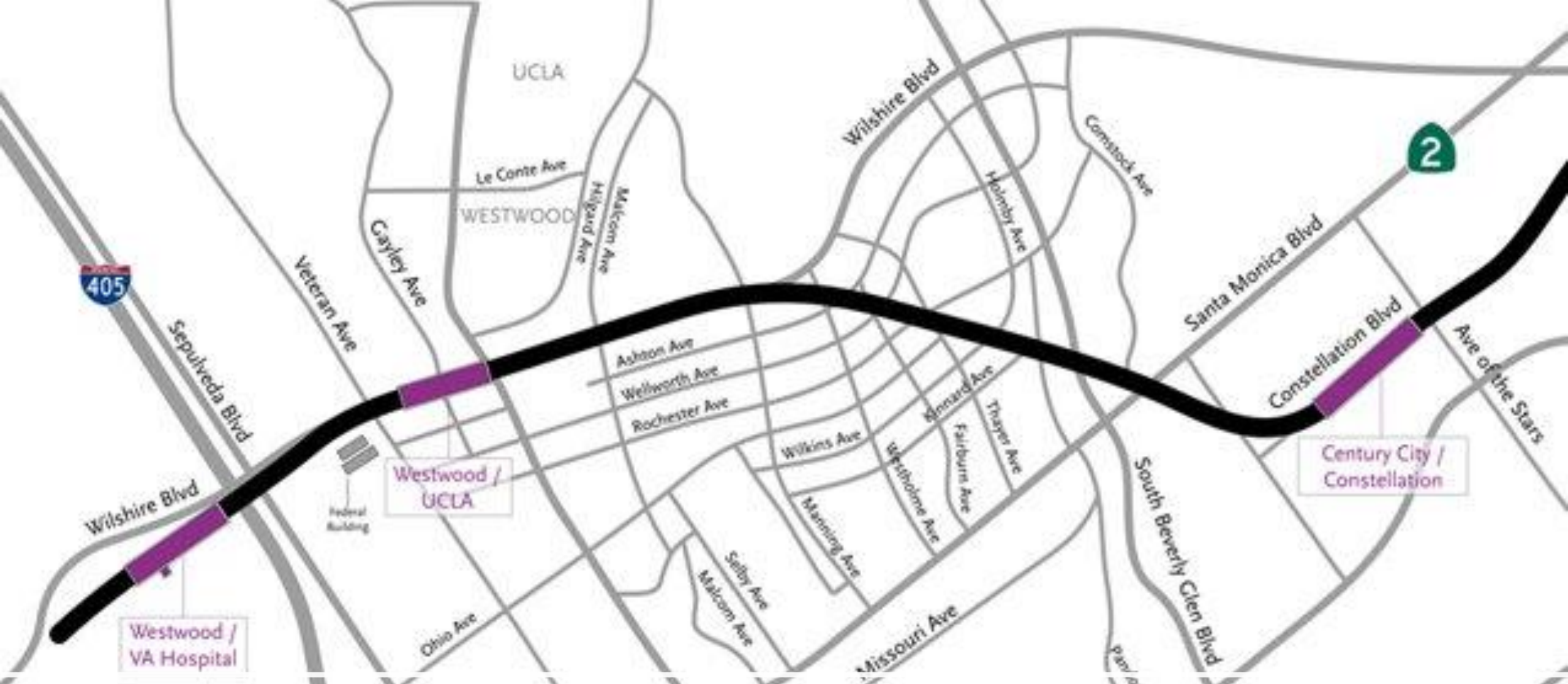

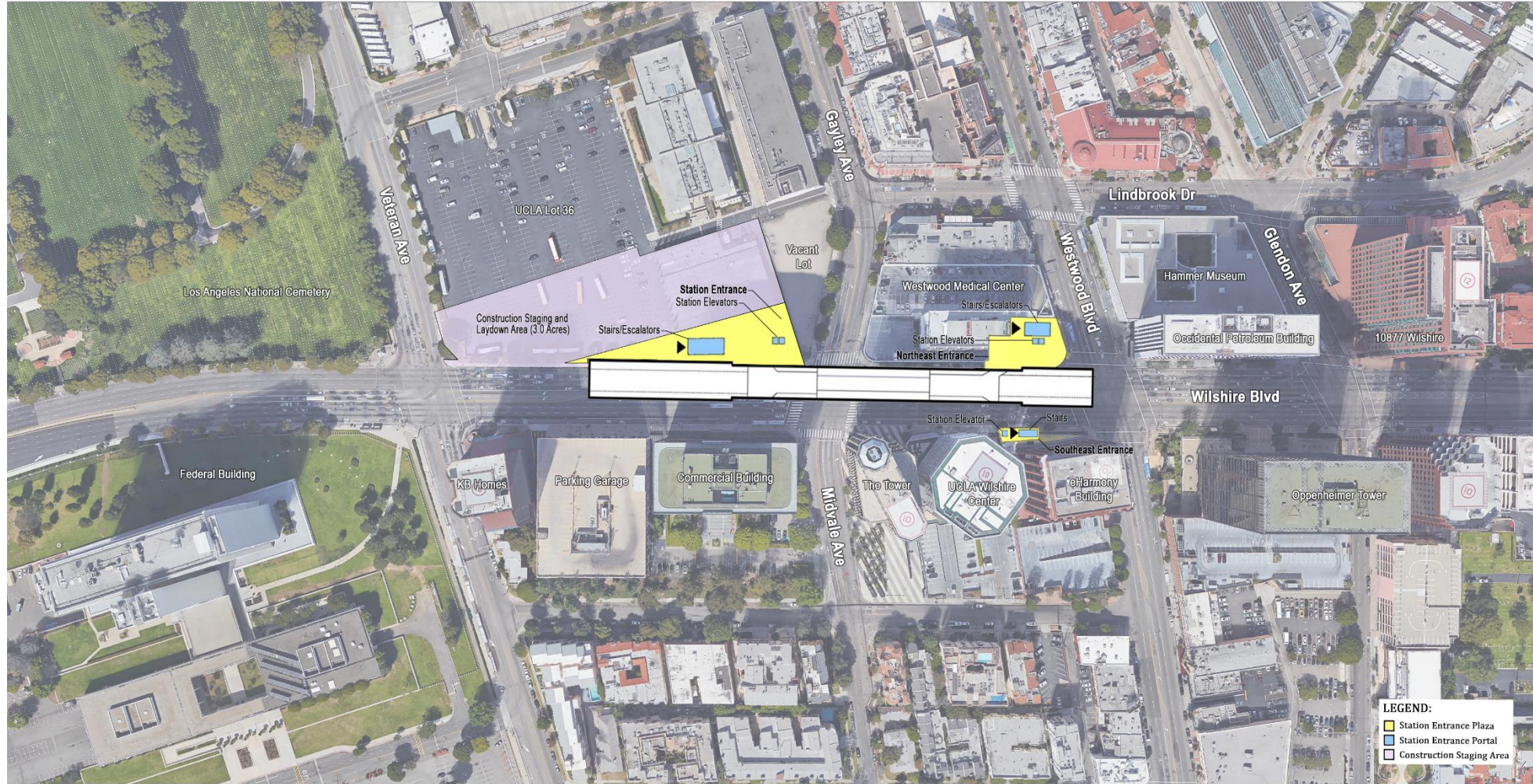

Rendering shows length of the underground station box on Wilshire Bl between Westwood Bl and Veteran Av

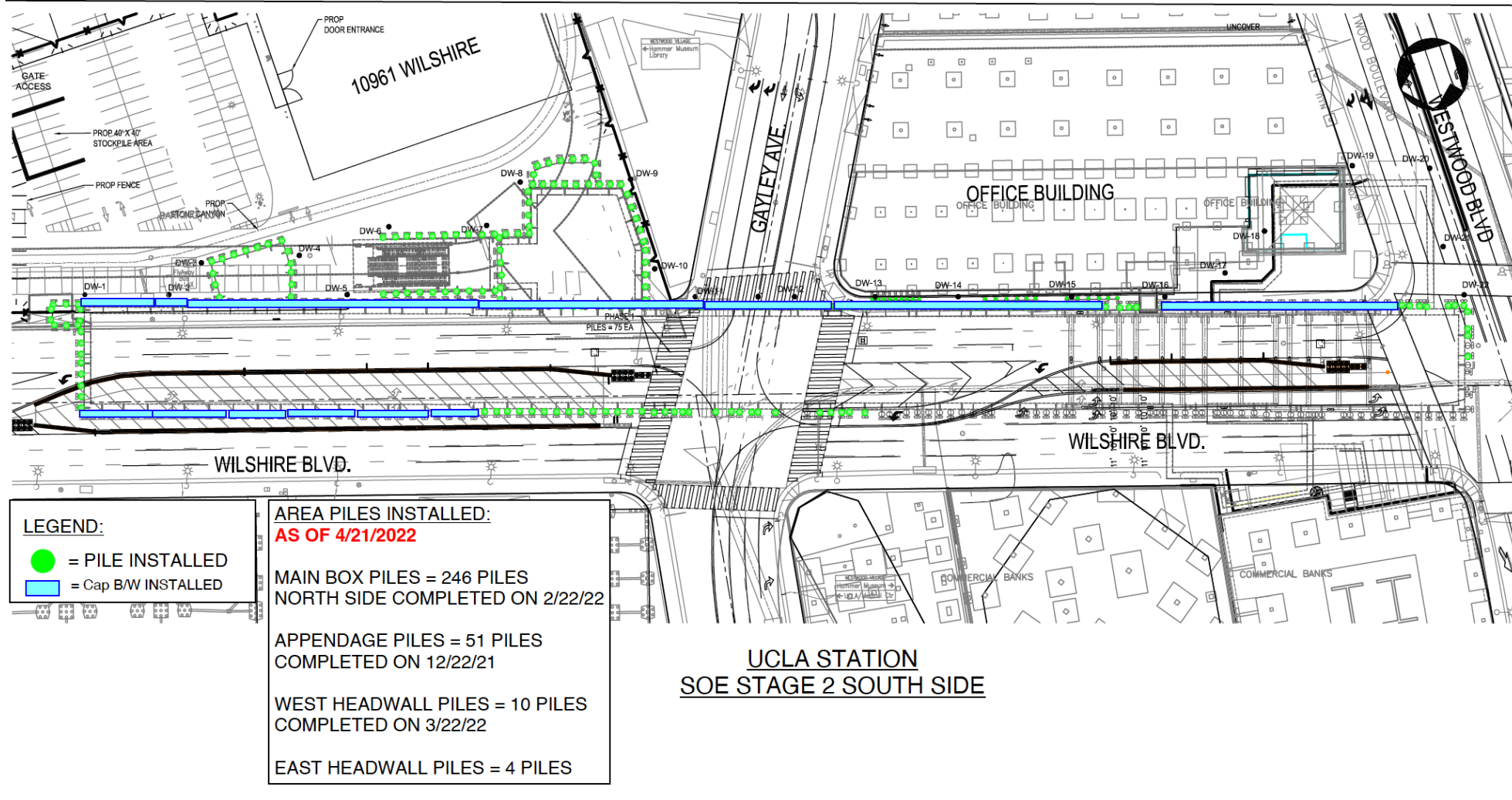

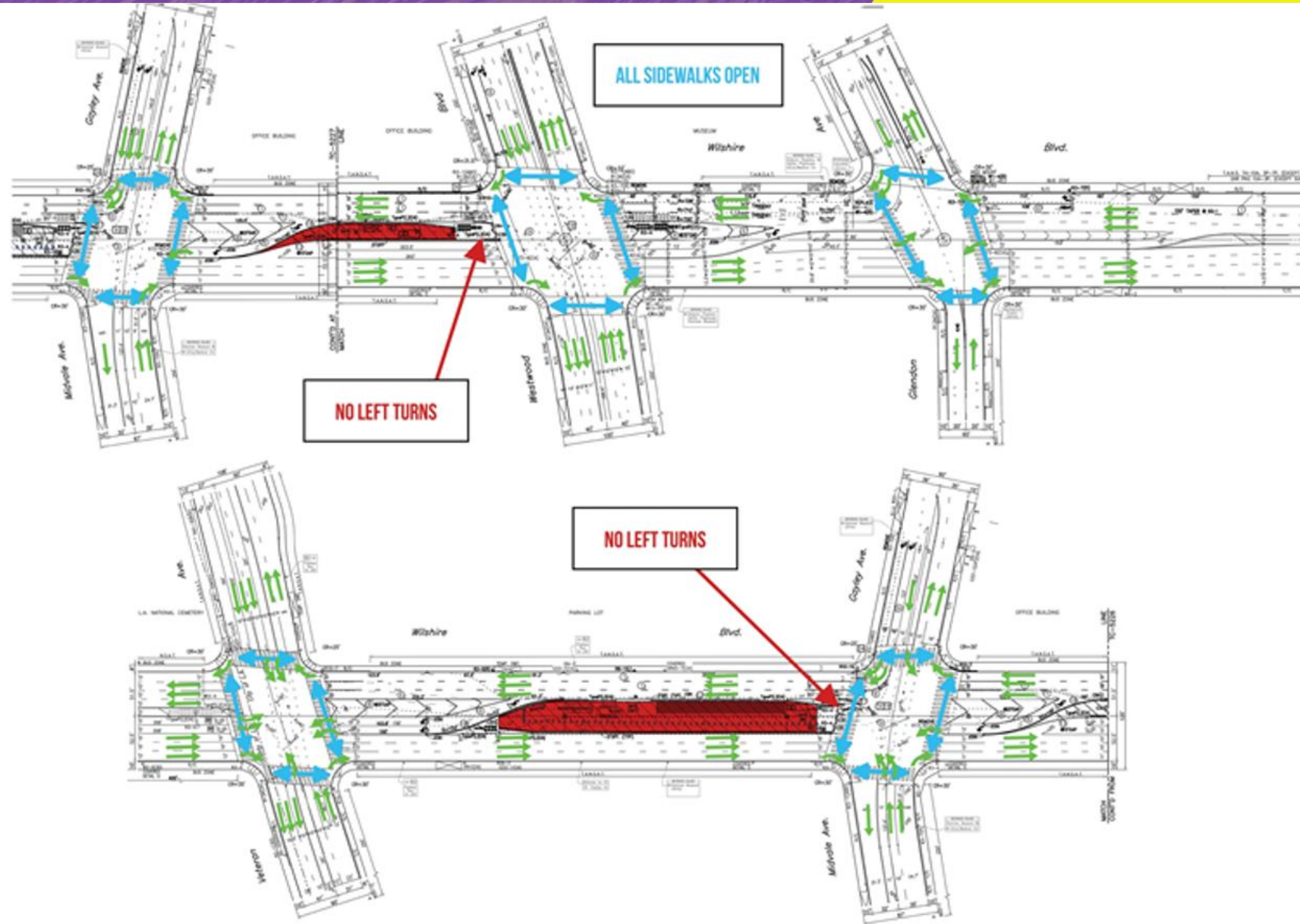

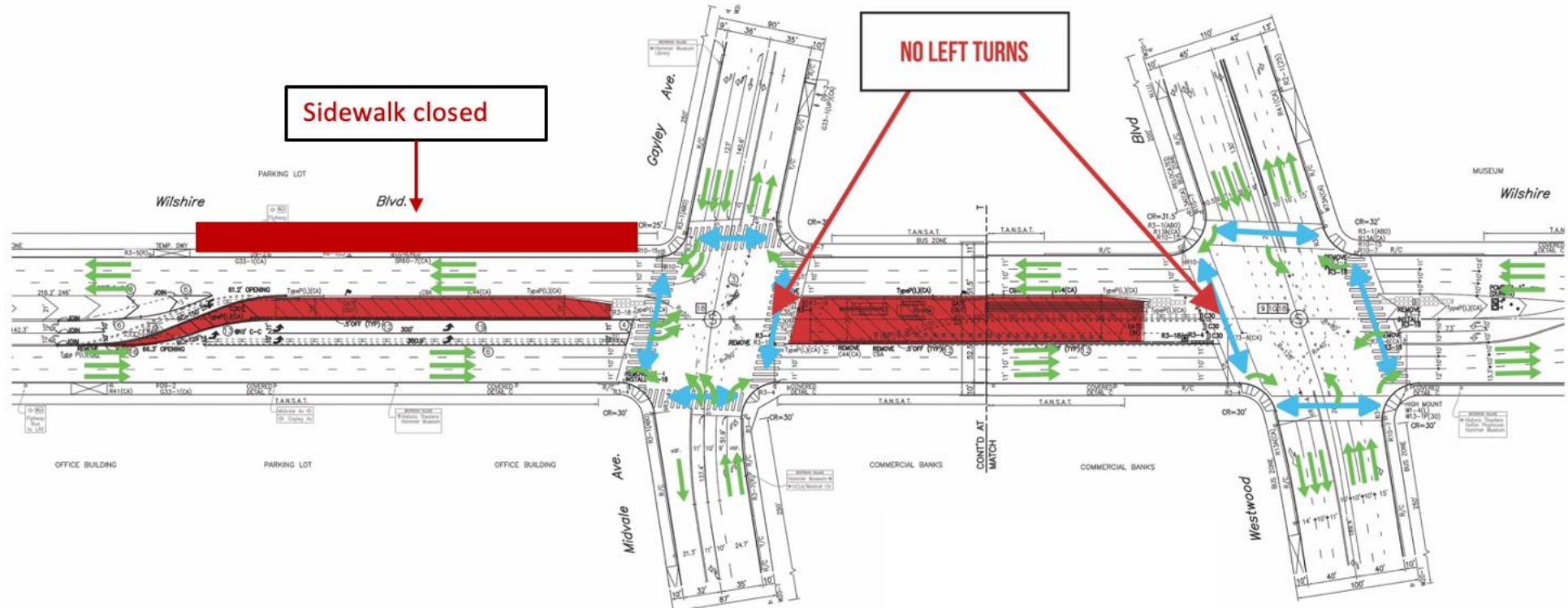

Decking for the Westwood/UCLA Station



Anticipated Summer 2022*



Deck installation will be on Wilshire Bl between Westwood Bl and Veteran Av.



Construction of a concrete deck, curb to curb, approximately 12 ft deep.



Decking will serve as temporary street surface.

Decking for the Westwood/UCLA Station



Traffic will travel on the deck panels while the station is constructed underground.



Temporary partial street closures will be implemented on Wilshire Bl. Traffic will be detoured around the construction work.



Station Box is 894 ft long, 75 ft wide, 65 ft deep.



Over 700 panels will be installed during decking.

Decking for the Westwood/UCLA Station

Duration:

- > There are 4 stages for decking with varying traffic patterns.
- > Anticipated for 14 weekends to complete

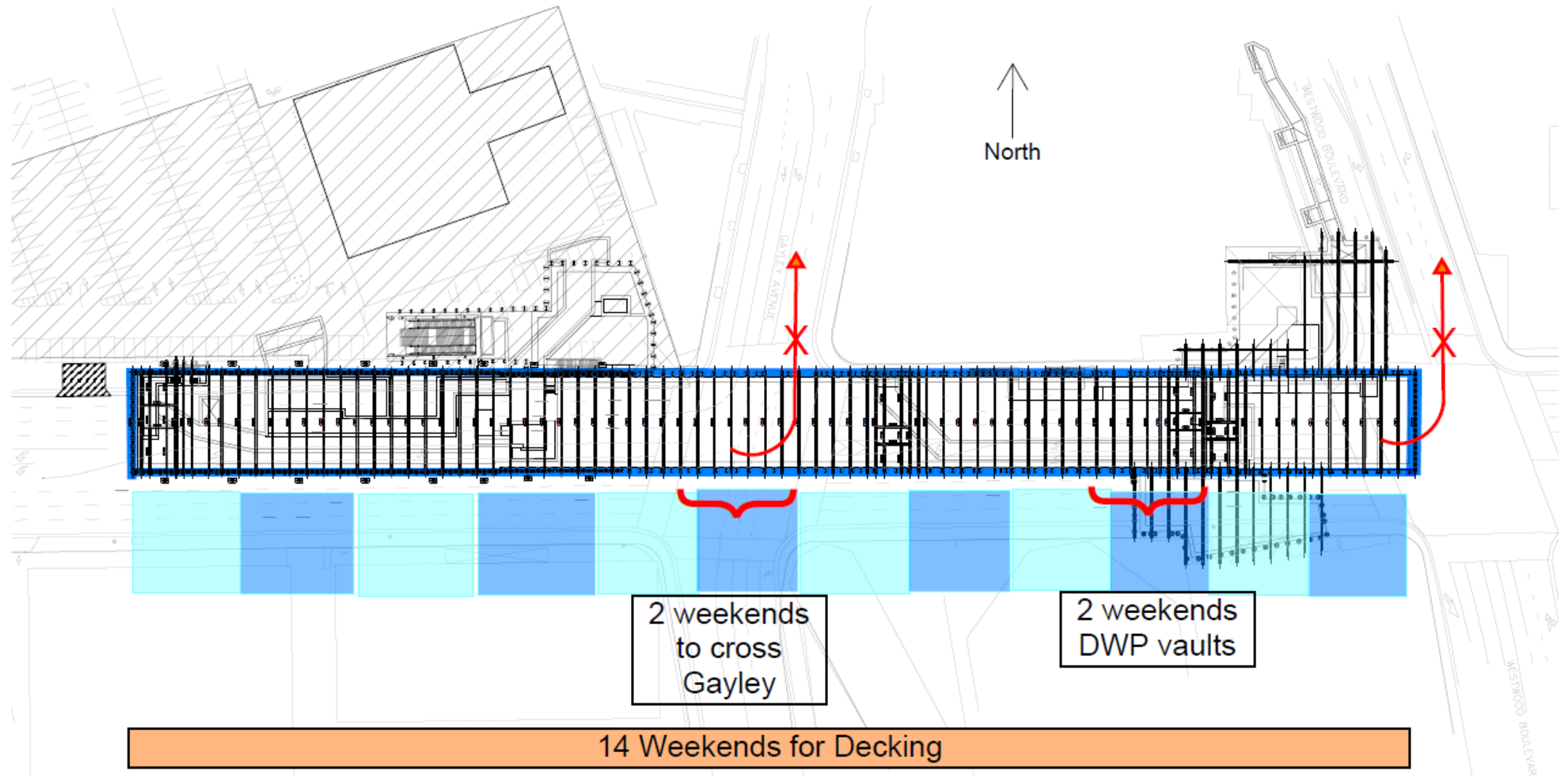
Typical Work Schedule:

- > Work will be completed on weekend, Friday to Monday, 11 pm to 6am

Work Activities:

- > Excavation to uncover cap beam and piles
- > Install deck beam supporting the deck panels
- > Restriping the deck panels for future community use

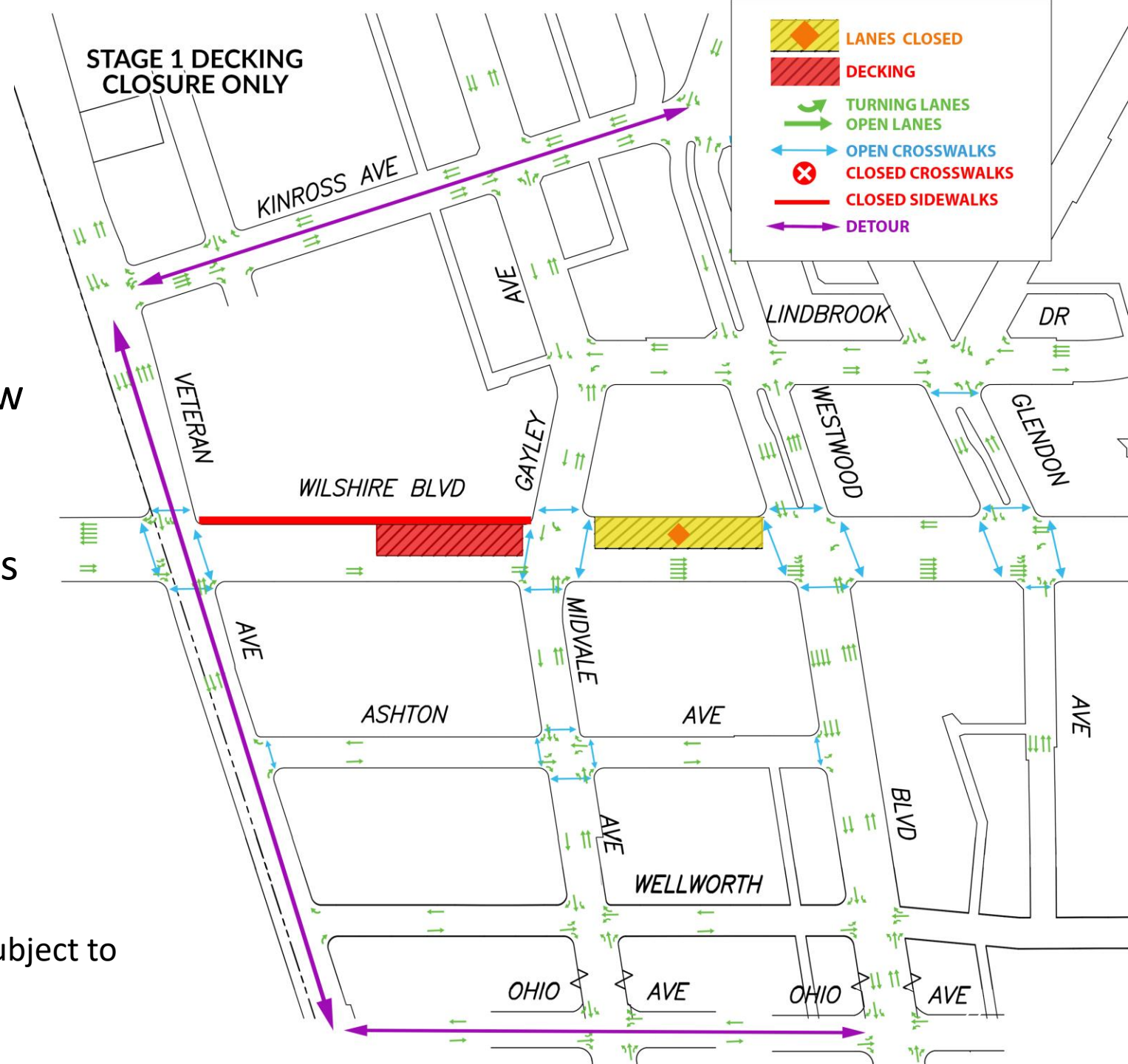

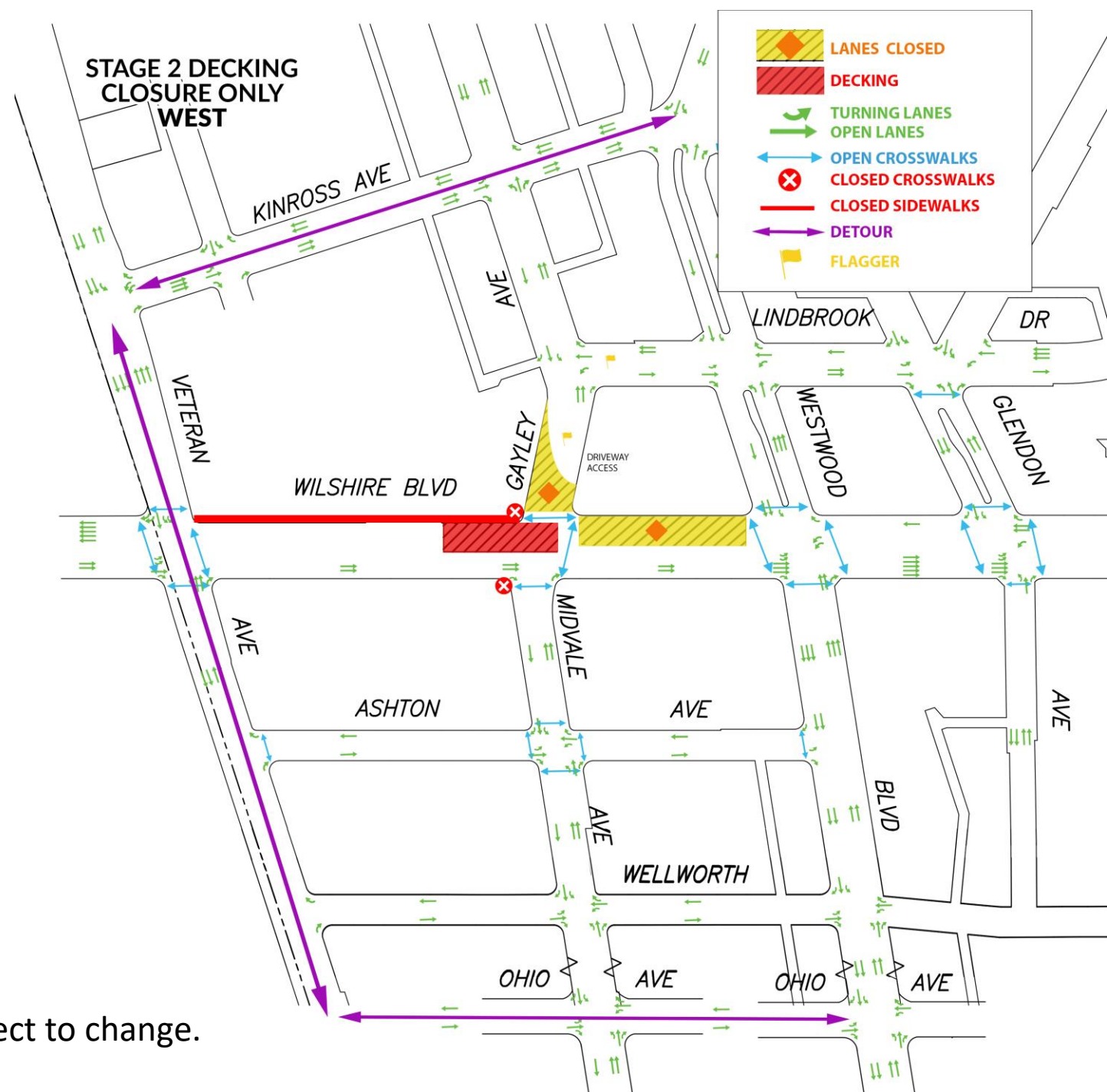

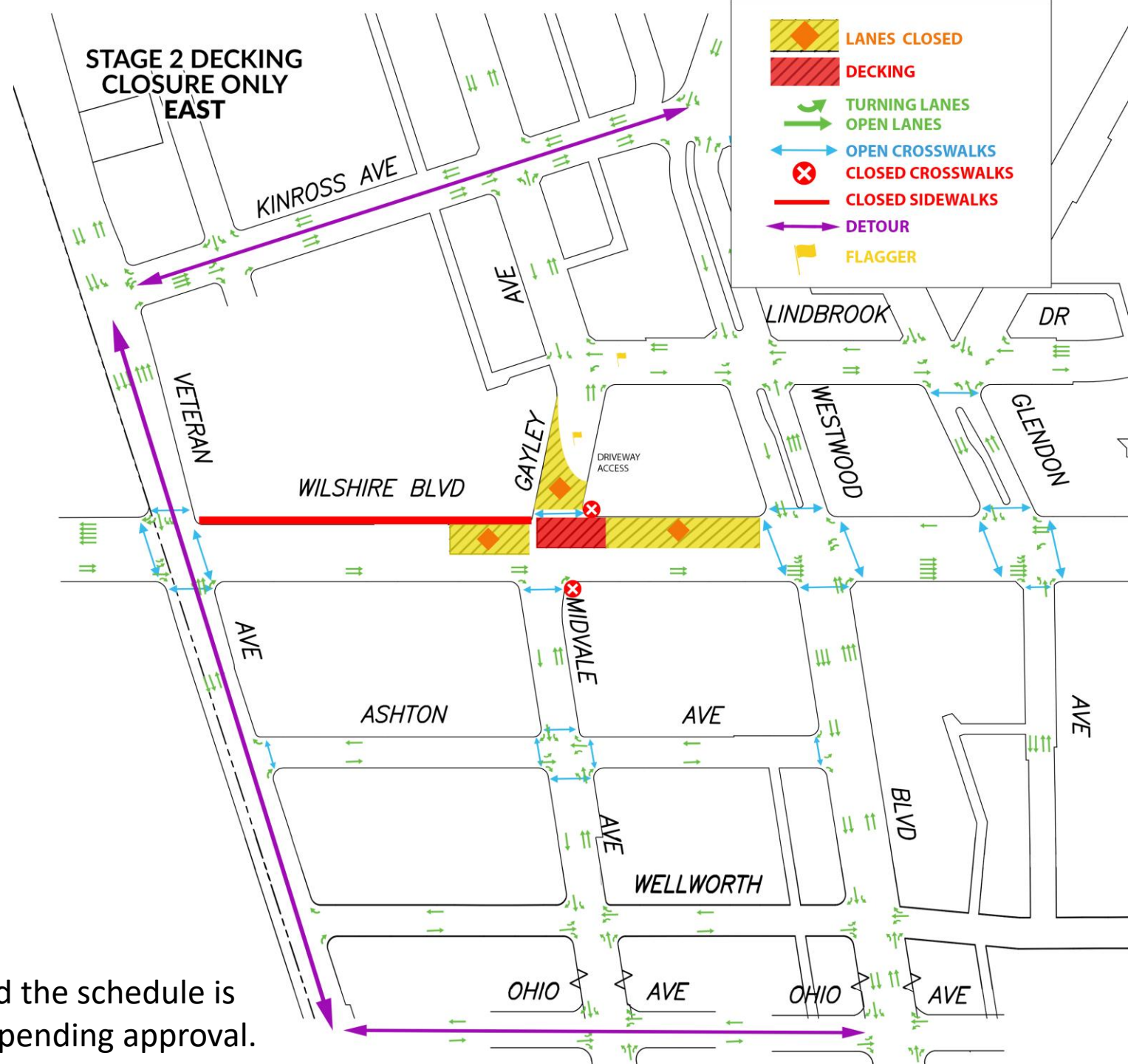

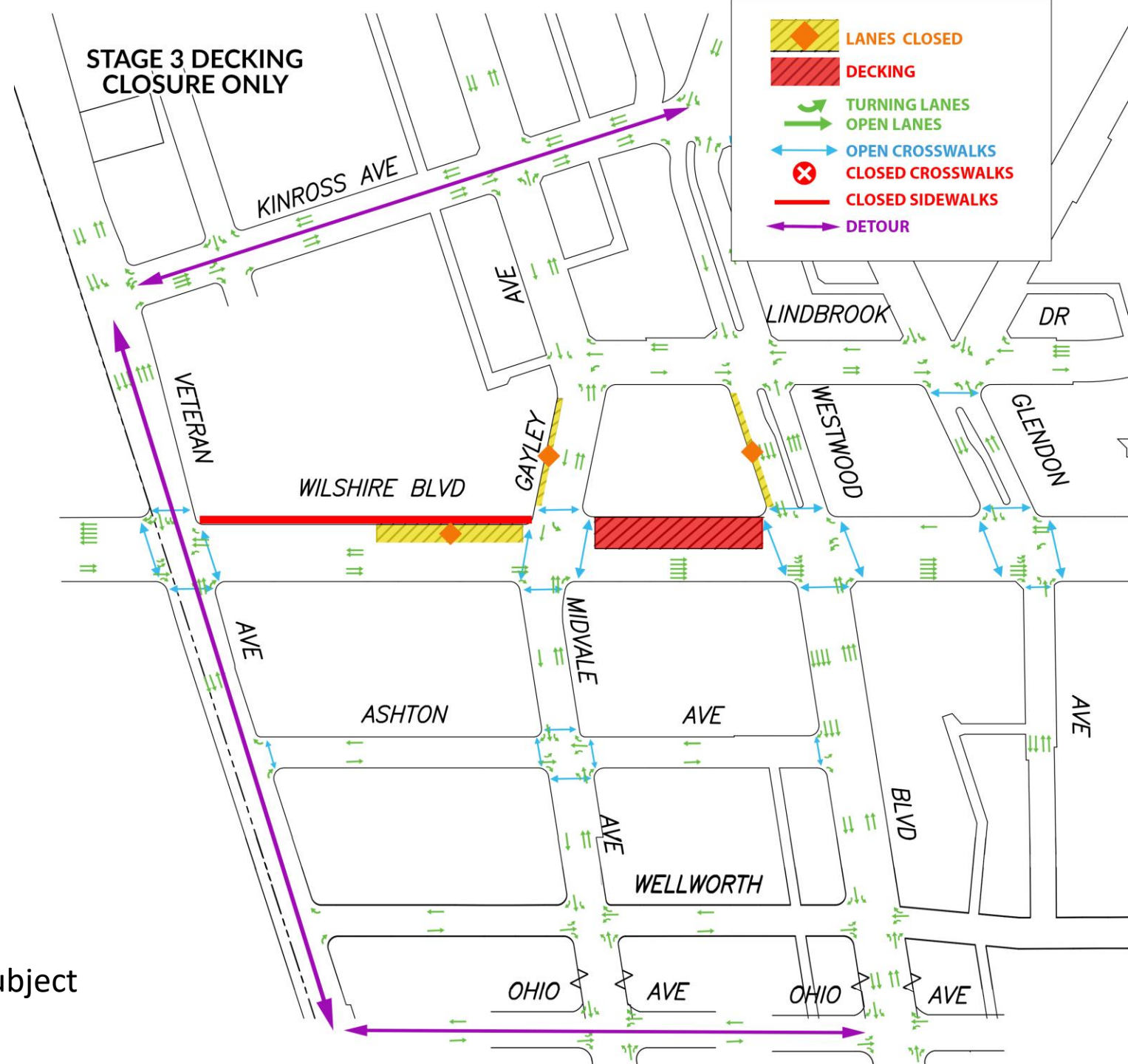

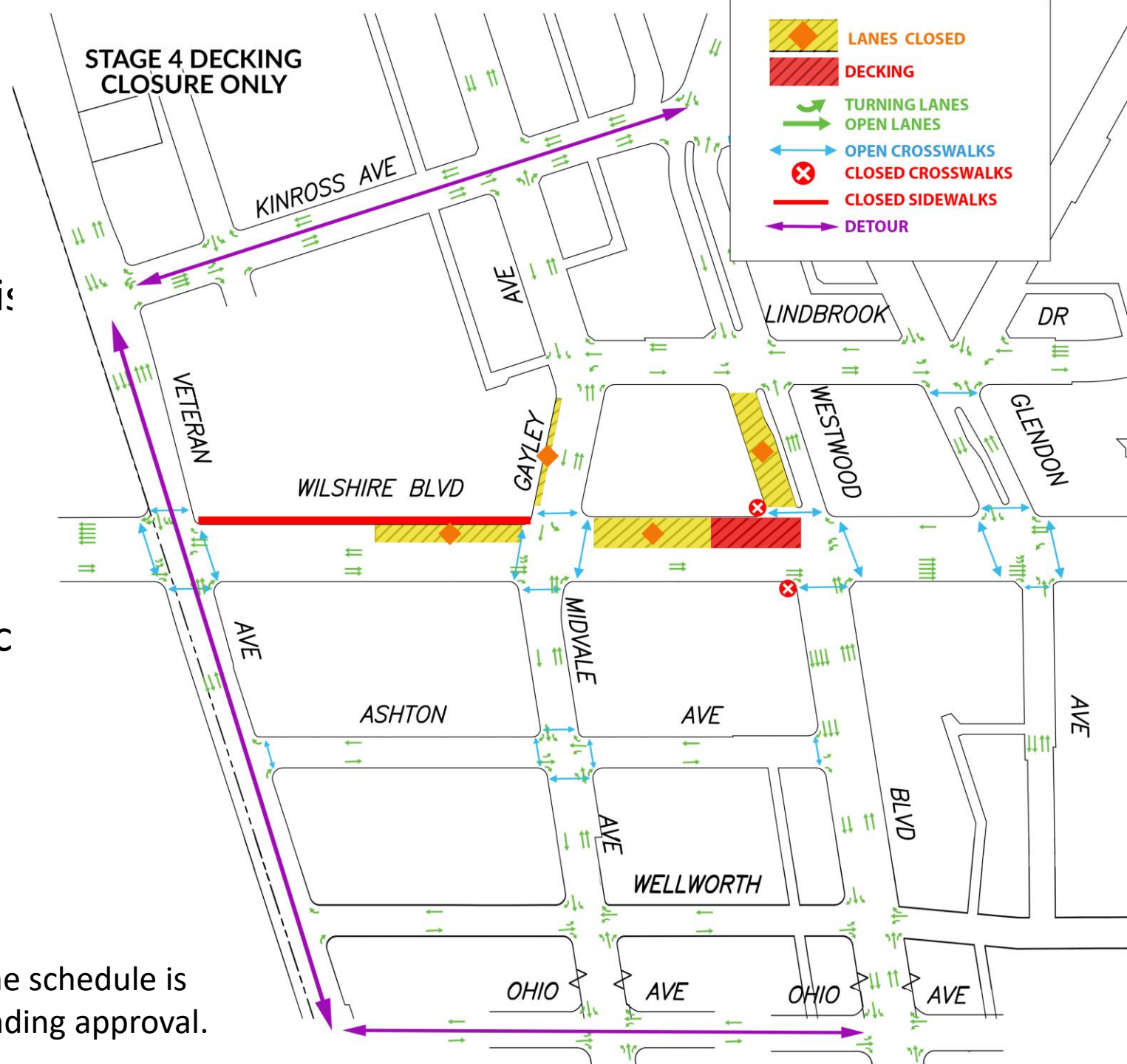

- Westbound traffic detoured at Westwood either to Kinross Av or Ohio Av.

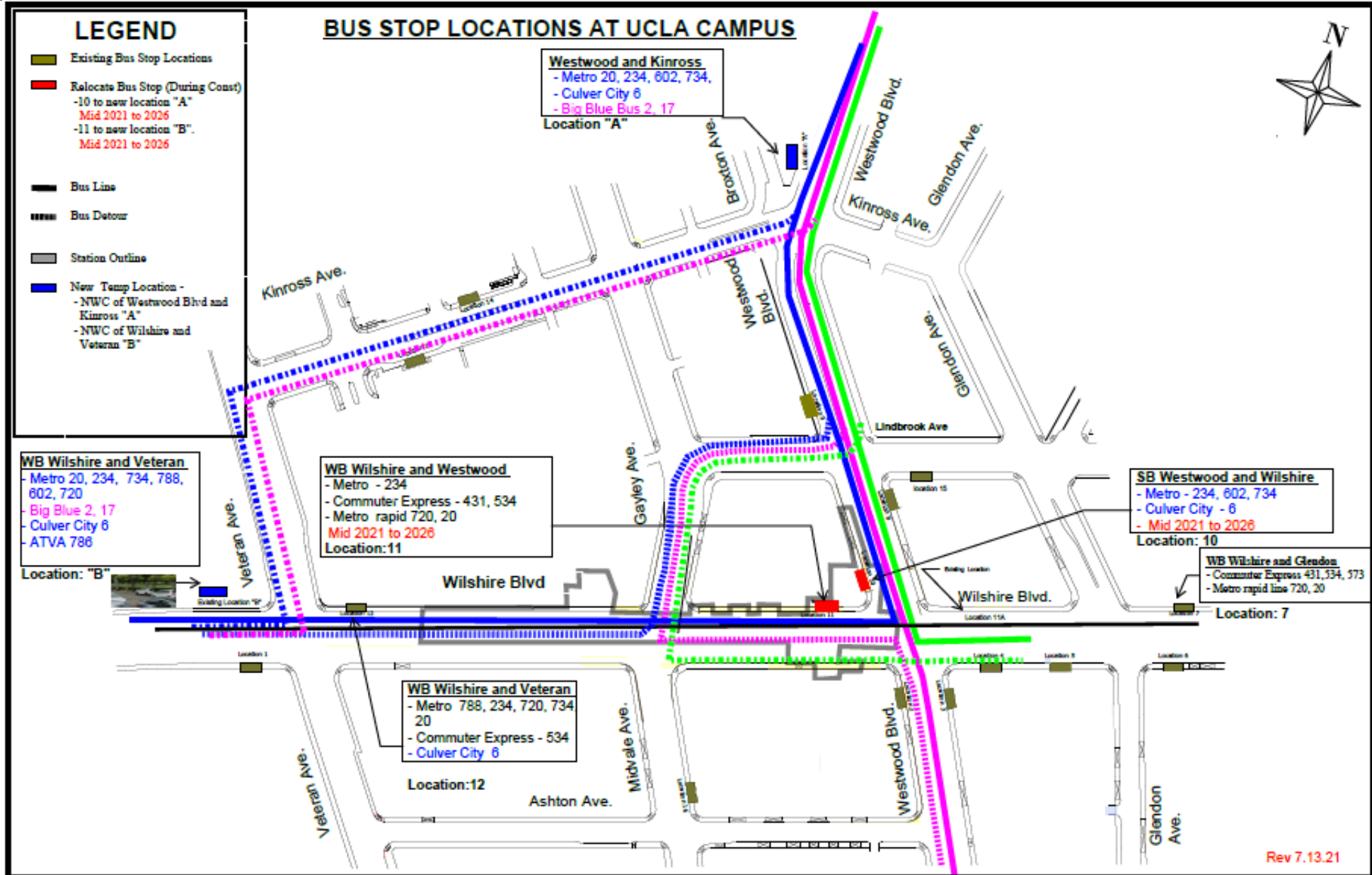

Construction Mitigation

- > Traffic enforcement by LAPD
- > Traffic control officers from LADOT
- > Coordinated adjusted signal timing
- > Pedestrian access is maintained
- > Crosswalk detours around active construction areas
- > Education and outreach to adjacent properties
- > Coordination with other developers and nearby projects
