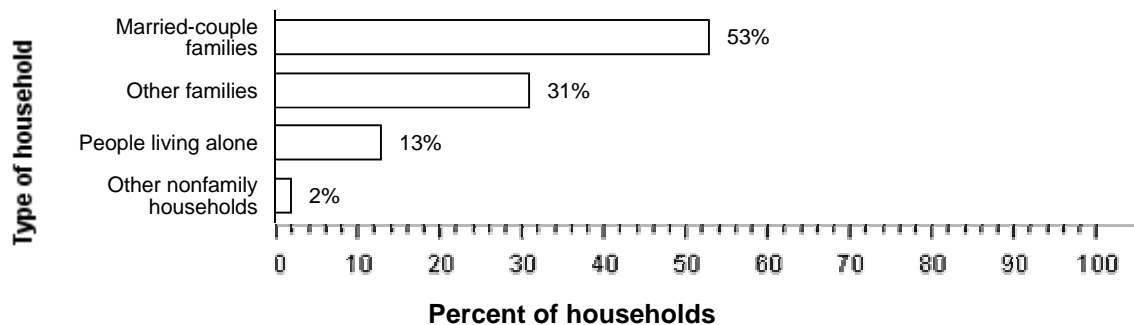

**HOUSEHOLDS AND FAMILIES:** In 2007-2009 there were 15,000 households in Lynwood city. The average household size was 4.3 people.

Families made up 85 percent of the households in Lynwood city. This figure includes both married-couple families (53 percent) and other families (31 percent). Nonfamily households made up 15 percent of all households in Lynwood city. Most of the nonfamily households were people living alone, but some were composed of people living in households in which no one was related to the householder.

**The Types of Households in Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**

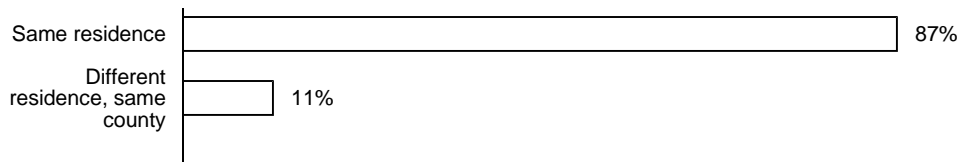


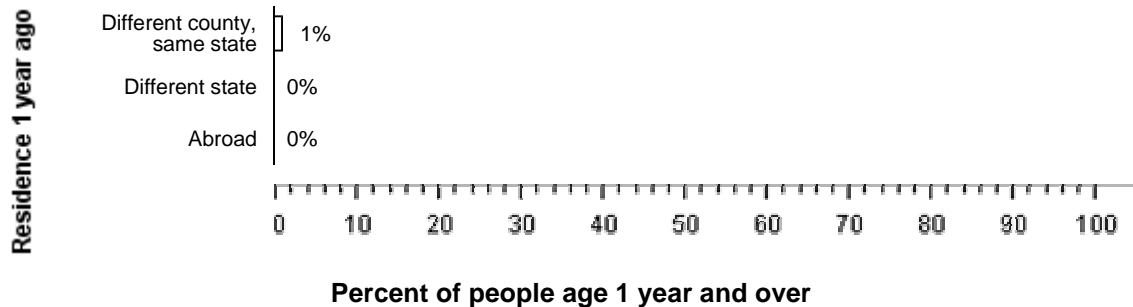

**NATIVITY AND LANGUAGE:** Data for this section cannot be displayed because the number of sample cases is too small. Displaying the data would risk disclosing information for individuals.

**GEOGRAPHIC MOBILITY:** In 2007-2009, 87 percent of the people at least one year old living in Lynwood city were living in the same residence one year earlier; 11 percent had moved during the past year from another residence in the same county, 1 percent from another county in the same state, less than 0.5 percent from another state, and less than 0.5 percent from abroad.

**Geographic Mobility of Residents of Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**



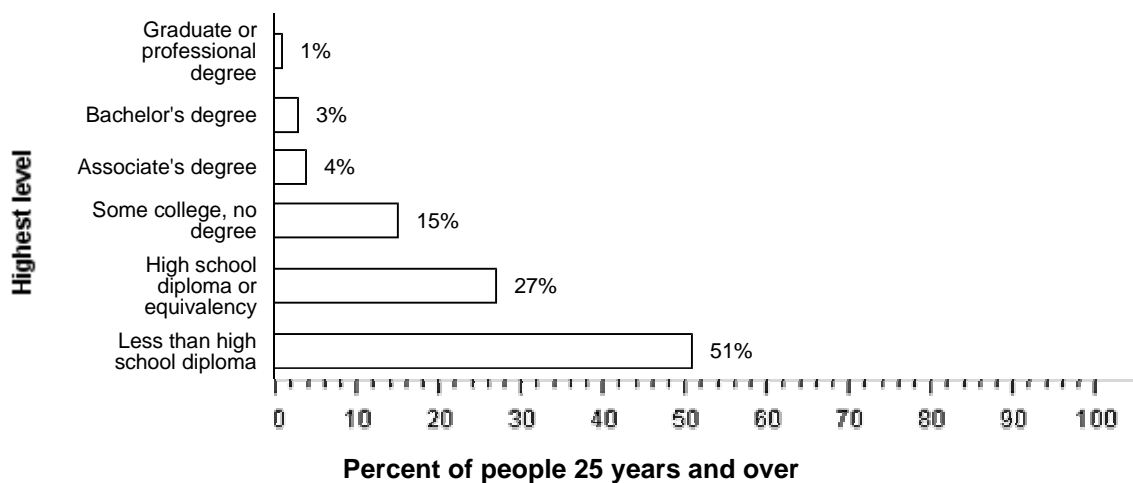

**EDUCATION:** In 2007-2009, 49 percent of people 25 years and over had at least graduated from high school and 4 percent had a bachelor's degree or higher. Fifty-one percent were dropouts; they were not enrolled in school and had not graduated from high school.

The total school enrollment in Lynwood city was 22,000 in 2007-2009. Nursery school and kindergarten enrollment was 2,600 and elementary or high school enrollment was 16,000 children. College or graduate school enrollment was 3,300.

**The Educational Attainment of People in Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**

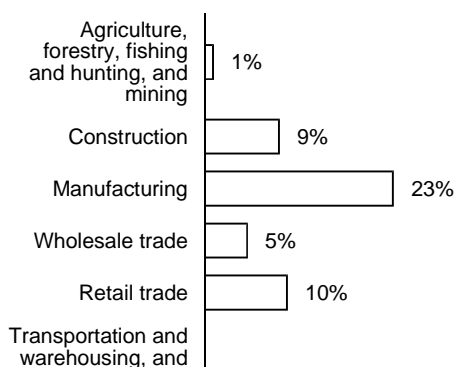


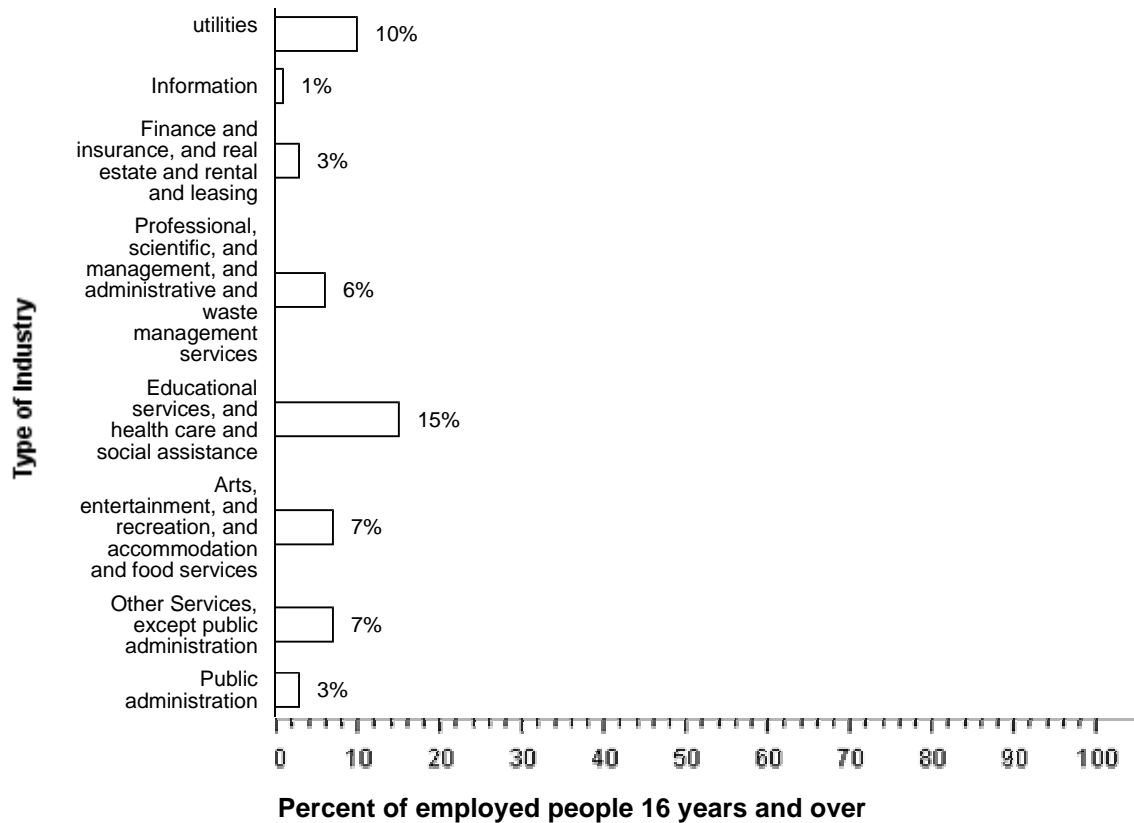

**DISABILITY:** In Lynwood city, among people at least five years old in 2007-2009, percent reported a disability. The likelihood of having a disability varied by age - from percent of people 5 to 15 years old, to percent of people 16 to 64 years old, and to percent of those 65 and older.

**INDUSTRIES:** In 2007-2009, for the employed population 16 years and older, the leading industries in Lynwood city were Manufacturing, 23 percent, and Educational services, and health care, and social assistance, 15 percent.

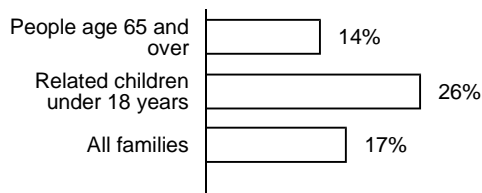
**OCCUPATIONS AND TYPE OF EMPLOYER:** Among the most common occupations were: Production, transportation, and material moving occupations, 33 percent; Sales and office occupations, 25 percent; Service occupations, 17 percent; Construction, extraction, maintenance, and repair occupations, 14 percent; and Management, professional, and related occupations, 10 percent. Eighty-four percent of the people employed were Private wage and salary workers; 10 percent was Federal, state, or local government workers; and 6 percent was Self-employed in own not incorporated business workers.

**TRAVEL TO WORK:** Seventy-two percent of Lynwood city workers drove to work alone in 2007-2009, 15 percent carpooled, 6 percent took public transportation, and 5 percent used other means. The remaining 2 percent worked at home. Among those who commuted to work, it took them on average 27.1 minutes to get to work.

**INCOME:** The median income of households in Lynwood city was \$41,941. Ninety percent of the households received earnings and 7 percent received retirement income other than Social Security. Sixteen percent of the households received Social Security. The average income from Social Security was \$12,809. These income sources are not mutually exclusive; that is, some households received income from more than one source.

**POVERTY AND PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT PROGRAMS:** In 2007-2009, 18 percent of people were in poverty. Twenty-six percent of related children under 18 were below the poverty level, compared with 14 percent of people 65 years old and over. Seventeen percent of all families and 35 percent of families with a female householder and no husband present had incomes below the poverty level.

**Poverty Rates in Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**

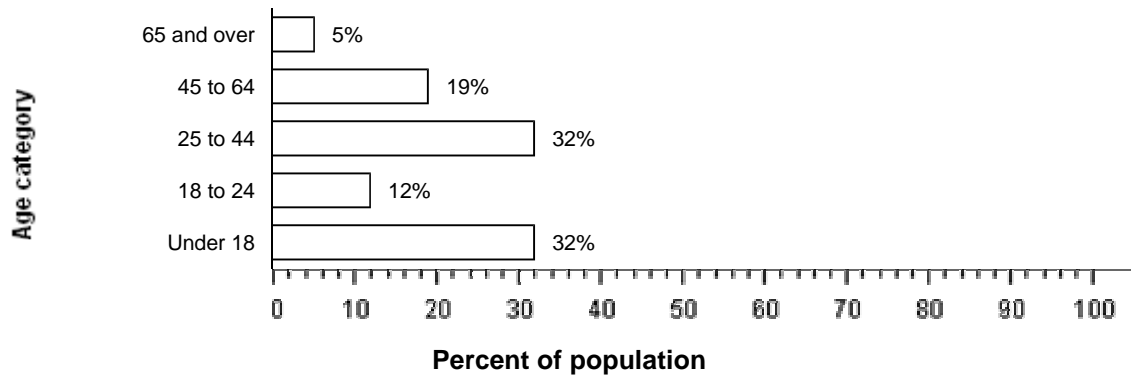

**POPULATION OF Lynwood city:** In 2007-2009, Lynwood city had a total population of 70,000 - 36,000 (52 percent) females and 33,000 (48 percent) males. The median age was 28.1 years. Thirty-two percent of the population was under 18 years and 5 percent was 65 years and older.

**The Age Distribution of People in Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**

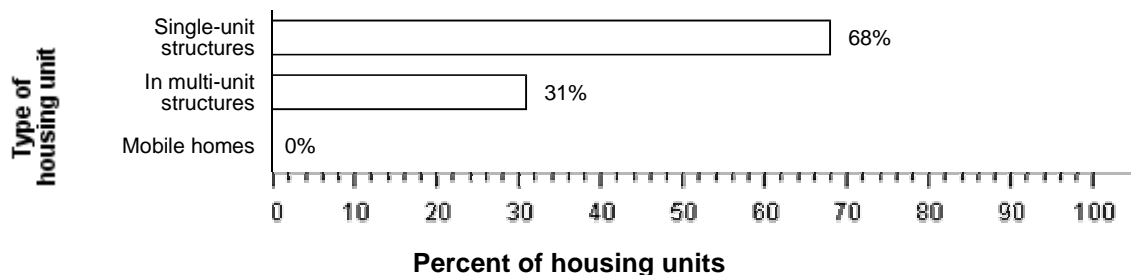

For people reporting one race alone, 33 percent was White; 11 percent was Black or African American; 1 percent was American Indian and Alaska Native; 1 percent was Asian; less than 0.5 percent was Native Hawaiian and Other Pacific Islander, and 52 percent was Some other race. Three percent reported Two or more races. Eighty-five percent of the people in Lynwood city was Hispanic. Three percent of the people in Lynwood city was White non-Hispanic. People of Hispanic origin may be of any race.

**HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS:** In 2007-2009, Lynwood city had a total of 16,000 housing units, 7 percent of which were vacant. Of the total housing units, 68 percent was in single-unit structures, 31 percent was in multi-unit structures, and less than 0.5 percent was mobile homes. Seven percent of the housing units were built since 1990.

**The Types of Housing Units in Lynwood city, California in 2007-2009**

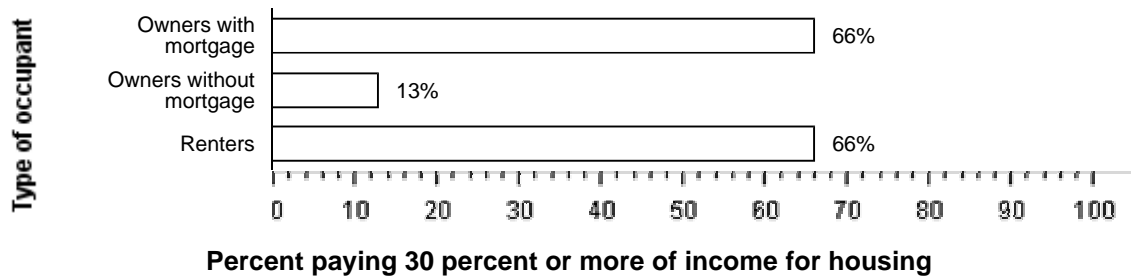

**OCCUPIED HOUSING UNIT CHARACTERISTICS:** In 2007-2009, Lynwood city had 15,000 occupied housing units - 7,000 (47 percent) owner occupied and 7,800 (53 percent) renter occupied. Three percent of the households did not have telephone service and 8 percent of the households did not have access to a car, truck, or van for private use. Multi Vehicle households were not rare. Thirty-three percent had two vehicles and another 24 percent had three or more.

**HOUSING COSTS:** The median monthly housing costs for mortgaged owners was \$1,959, nonmortgaged owners \$330, and renters \$935. Sixty-six percent of owners with mortgages, 13 percent of owners without mortgages, and 66 percent of renters in Lynwood city spent 30 percent or more of household income on housing.
