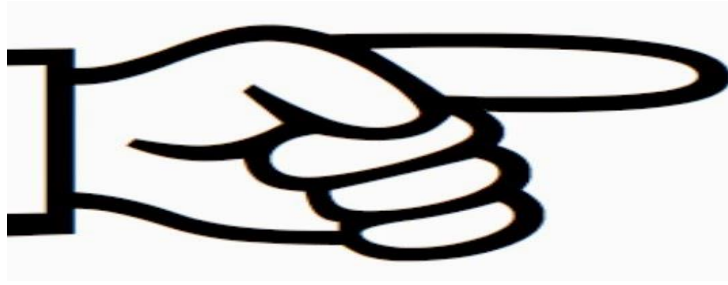

1. Cycle 10 Project Application/Proposals are due 11:59PM, November 2nd 2020
2. Tracking of LRSP delivery: (i) Ensure that LRSP Plan is done within 3 years from the date that appears in your allocation letter; and (ii) close the project within the following 6 months; (iii) if the LRSP was delayed for some reasons, contact D07 safety coordinator Vijay a few months ahead of the 3-yr due date, and he would work with you and HQ implementation to find a solution
3. Requirement for Cycle 11 project proposals: (i) the SSARP, LRSP, or an equivalent LRSP such as Toward Zero Death Plan is needed for identifying the proposed project scope/work; (ii) other requirements (not for planning documents) if any would be announced in the title LINK around May 2022 plus or minus one month
4. All safety projects need to beat the two RFA submission deadline, one for PE-RFA, and the other for Con-RFA
