## Metro Board Votes to Adopt the LB-ELA Corridor Mobility Investment Plan!

At their April 25th meeting, the Metro Board voted unanimously to adopt the Long Beach-East LA Corridor Mobility Investment Plan. In discussing the Plan the Metro Board of Directors highlighted the following:

- Board Member Janice Hahn
  - The Investment Plan encompasses \$1.8 billion in investments into local streets and communities.
  - A [Motion](#) to help make the fifteen programs a reality strengthens the Plan.
- Board Member Hilda Solis
  - The adoption of the Investment Plan is not a stopping point, there is important work left to be done.
  - Members of the community are pushing for continued change.
  - We need to consider Metro Bus Priority Corridors and the access of our residents to the Olympic Games.
- Board Member Fernando Dutra
  - The Investment Plan is a significant step in building trust between Metro and the communities throughout the LB-ELA Corridor.
  - The Gateway Cities Council of Governments Ad Hoc Committee helped tremendously in developing the Plan.
  - The Zero-Emission Truck Working Group also provided valuable feedback.
  - Safety needs to remain a priority.
  - The Community Programs are an important element of the Plan.
- Board Member Gloria Roberts
  - Looks forward to further funding opportunities as the Investment Plan gets implemented.

30 members of the public provided comments with themes similar to the public comments given at the April 17th Planning and Programming Committee meeting.
