## Important Updates

### Task Force and Community Leadership Committee members to meet in-person in July, August, and September

Metro recently presented a new Project Timeline and Schedule [here](#), including meetings, office hours, and public engagement that will allow us to present a draft Investment Plan to the Metro Board of Directors by November 2023.

These meetings will give the Task Force and CLC members the opportunity to collaborate, interact face-to-face, hear different perspectives, and learn from each other as we move toward the final Investment Plan.

In July, the first set of findings from the project evaluation phase will be reviewed at two combined Task Force and CLC Meetings. The first **Combined Task Force and CLC meeting – Part 1 will be held on Monday, July 10 from 5-8pm**. This meeting will be held in person but there will also be a virtual attendance option. It will be followed by a virtual **Combined Task Force and CLC Meeting – Part 2 on Thursday, July 20 from 5-7pm** and will take an in-depth look at the evaluation findings.
