What is the MSPP Framework?

The MSPP Framework is a system by which we have grouped similar projects together for our discussion, but also to get them ready for evaluation in the next phase of our study.

How does the MSPP Framework incorporate the adopted Task Force Goals?

The MSPP Framework incorporates all Task Force goals, and there may projects or programs that will satisfy more than one goal, which is why we also view things on a systemic basis. Taken together, the projects and programs form a multimodal set.

How are the projects organized?

The projects are organized by “improvement category” that represent different modes of travel, including: active transportation, arterial roadways, goods movement, transit, freeway and community programs.

What are examples of strategies to reduce travel demand?

Travel Demand Management, or TDM, is the application of strategies and policies to reduce travel demand.

What are examples of Travel Demand Management Strategies?

Some examples of Travel Demand Management Strategies are commute trip reduction (vanpool, carpool, telecommuting programs), transit passes to students or workers, charging for parking.
