## 1. INTRODUCTION

In September 2022, Metro entered the third phase of the Long Beach-East Los Angeles Corridor Mobility Investment Plan (LB-ELA CMIP), which involves the identification of the multi-modal strategies, projects, and programs to be evaluated for inclusion in the CMIP. Metro established the Long Beach-East Los Angeles Corridor Plan Task Force (Task Force) to obtain stakeholder input into the Investment Plan. Within this third phase of study, the work plan's purpose was to engage the public, local stakeholders, and community-based organizations to identify multi-modal strategies, projects, and programs (MSPP). To ensure the LB-ELA CMIP reflects the values and needs of all the stakeholders along the Long Beach-East Los Angeles Corridor (LB-ELA Corridor), it is imperative Metro obtains input from a variety of stakeholders from the Corridor's communities.

The project team developed and implemented a *Community Based Organization (CBO) Partnering and Public Engagement Plan* with the objective to build awareness and receive feedback on recommended projects and programs. This work effort was undertaken to ensure the input received is reflective of the values and needs of the diverse demographics of the communities along the LB-ELA Corridor. The project team sought out partnerships with CBOs represented on the Task Force as well as other CBOs who are based and work with the communities along the LB-ELA Corridor. This public engagement effort provides community input, ideas, and recommendations to develop a community-centered transportation Investment Plan to invest the \$750 million in local sales-tax funds into the Investment Plan and to potentially leverage additional state and federal grant funding for the Plan. The role of the CBOs was to help gather one-on-one input from stakeholders and residents within their networks through a Social Pinpoint survey and mapping tool, community workshops, and event pop-ups.

## 2. SOCIAL PINPOINT SURVEY AND MAPPING TOOL

Social Pinpoint is an interactive tool that was developed to receive public feedback for recommended CMIP strategies, projects, and programs. Individuals were able to access the tool via the program's interactive information hub found online, at in-person events using computer tablets and printable paper versions, as well as at virtual meetings through the Zoom chat feature. By taking the survey and/or leaving a comment on the survey interactive mapping tool, communities were able to provide their feedback on what projects, programs, and other improvement strategies they would like to see in their community and along the LB-ELA Corridor.

The survey and interactive mapping tool were originally open from August 2, 2022, through September 8, 2022, and was extended twice: to October 15, 2022, and once more to November 14, 2022, to accommodate more time for public feedback from community members. The extension was required as the engagement efforts continued through early November. The extension also allowed the Task Force and Community Leadership Committee (CLC) members to provide additional input using the Social Pinpoint online tool. A total of 1,920 surveys and 985 mapping comments were obtained from the public during this phase. See the graphic depictions below including further details of the public feedback that was received.





Figure 2. Social Pinpoint Feedback Map

Figure 1 below illustrates the breakdown of feedback from stakeholders including demographics, mapping comments, and the types of improvements they would like to see implemented along the LB-ELA Corridor. Figure 2 below is the LB-ELA Corridor map and pinpoints as to where stakeholders provided their feedback and suggestions on projects or programs and improvements.

Figure 1. Social Pinpoint Feedback

### 3. STAKEHOLDER OUTREACH

The Metro Project Team asked for recommendations for the most effective ways to share information and engage with communities through the LB-ELA Corridor Plan Task Force process, including Task Force, Working Group and CLC meetings. At every opportunity, the community's input has been captured and is part of the ongoing public engagement efforts included at each study phase that will continue to be at the core of all future engagement plans and activities. Below are the steps the public outreach team took to receive community feedback:

#### I. Information Sharing

- Provided updates of the Task Force process in project eblasts to the membership of the Task Force, Working Groups and CLC.

- Provided social media toolkits that were targeted to each virtual or in-person CBO or community event.
- Shared project flyers about the in-person public engagement events as well as distributing fact sheets with stakeholders at community events and gathering places, including, but not limited to, large community meetings, community events, farmer's markets, festivals, and pop-up events frequented by targeted communities.
- Utilized school district communications outreach tools to share project information with parents and students along the corridor.
- Identified targeted CBOs, businesses, community gathering spaces to distribute project collateral and project information.

## **II. Community Engagement**

- Met community members at their convenience- held joint CBO meetings, made direct phone calls, attended community forums, held pop-up events.
- Engaged the youth with focused events on college campuses.
- Held in-person and virtual meetings.
- Ensured accessibility throughout the engagement process by publicizing meeting times in advance of the events and in multiple languages.
- Consider work and school schedules when planning meeting times.

## **III. Process Development**

The CMIP development process included the following activities:

- Graphically outlined the process in a simple and understandable manner, making it clear when final decisions will be made.
- Ensured valuable input was collected from communities along the LB-ELA corridor. As the process continues, key decisions shall incorporate the community feedback received.

## **4. COMMUNITY WORKSHOPS AND MEETING PRESENTATIONS**

A series of community workshops and meeting presentations were conducted along the corridor to gather input from community members, public, and other local stakeholders. Some of the workshops were coordinated directly with CBOs and local government agencies. As part of an equitable approach, the project team offered multilingual support at all community workshops and meetings by providing interpretation services and drafting collateral material in multiple languages: Spanish, Tagalog, and Khmer. The workshops included a presentation of the project followed by an activity that utilized the Social Pinpoint survey and mapping tool. The in-person workshops included staff support who assisted attendees utilizing computer tablets to access the online tool while also providing paper copies of the online survey in multiple languages for accessibility, particularly for events with seniors and communities with a “digital divide”. The virtual workshops included staff support to gather comments in a Q&A log, which is an excel sheet with detailed comments noted. Those comments were later entered into the Social Pinpoint survey and mapping tool that was also shared as a hyperlink for attendees to provide online input and review other stakeholders’ postings. A detailed list of the community workshops can be found in **Appendix A**.

The following topics represent the most frequent comments heard and noted from the community workshops:

- Restore safety and infrastructure at bus and rail stops.
- Install more dedicated bus and bike lanes.
- Plant more trees for more shade.
- Implement EV charging stations.
- Increase road and sidewalk maintenance procedures.

## 5. CBO PARTNERING STRATEGY

The public outreach team coordinated with Metro staff to execute Metro’s adopted [CBO Partnering Strategy](#) that deploys a clear, consistent, and equitable approach to partnering with CBOs on community services. ## **Strategy & Implementation**

The CBOs mentioned above were targeted as key stakeholders because not only do they represent the corridor across diverse backgrounds but may also benefit or be impacted by the potential developments of the Investment Plan projects.

Demographics were considered based on input received to date, including meetings, surveys, social media campaigns, events, and one-on-one briefings to ensure this input was reflective of the diverse demographics of the corridor. Based on an early assessment of demographics being reached during this study phase, the project team made recommendations to adjust the remaining outreach efforts to address gaps in specific demographic target groups that had not provided feedback to date.

Targeted communities included older adults, students, communities of color, persons with disabilities, people with low-income or other marginalized individuals, transit riders, local small or micro business owners, employees, and others. The Project Team identified high-priority locations, events, and venues for in-person engagement, as well as other community events throughout the study area.

A social media campaign targeting specific zip codes expanded engagement for stakeholders across the corridor. The targeted approach included communities from various backgrounds such as those who speak different languages (Khmer, Tagalog, and Spanish), age (youth, older adults), and gender (women). In addition, project flyer distributions were made to target the historically underserved communities within the corridor.

## **6. NOTIFICATION**

With the intent of expanding project awareness in a comprehensive, dynamic manner, several key notification approaches were utilized throughout the community engagement program. Through these strategies stakeholders were informed of the draft Investment Plan and could provide feedback on projects and programs, receive updates on meetings, and interact directly with Metro and project team members, among other benefits. Each form of notification served an individual purpose while also working in tandem to achieve the goal of greater community awareness and engagement.

### **6.1 Print Notification**

During the MSPP phase, a multilingual (English, Spanish, Tagalog, and Khmer) targeted digital and print notification campaign was organized to raise awareness and increase engagement for the LB-ELA CP. This effort was focused on increasing stakeholder awareness, promoting community workshops, and sharing the Social Pinpoint engagement activities.

### **6.2 Flyer Distribution**

The flyer was distributed to 166 locations across the corridor to promote the public meetings and online Social Pinpoint Tool. 5,060 copies were distributed through the extended engagement efforts (via CBO partners, businesses, dropping copies off at city halls and libraries) and in specialized targeted communities including:

- Schools and universities along the corridor
- Tagalog speaking communities
- Khmer speaking communities
- Women Groups and Clubs
- Youth Centers
- Faith Based Organizations

### 6.4 Extended Engagement

Based on the demographics, extended engagement efforts were made by partnering with CBOs at community meetings and outreach events in specific languages such as Khmer and Tagalog. In addition, printed collateral material were provided at these events in their specific language to further the engagement efforts. The public outreach team also conducted extended engagement through phone calls to a variety of local agencies and school districts across the corridor.

### 6.5 Pop Ups

With the support from local CBOs, the public outreach team hosted eighteen (18) events along the corridor including pop ups to support the notification and engagement efforts to gather input from different communities. 
### 7. SURVEY RESULTS OF ENGAGEMENT EFFORTS

## 9. CONCLUSION

After the project team’s evaluation of the workshop attendance and execution of the public engagement plan, the team has the following takeaways, lessons learned, and recommendations to consider for future public meetings:

- CBO Partnering and engagement worked best when utilized to target specific underserved communities; thus, complementing the corridor-wide strategic public engagement plan.
- Extending the project timeline within this phase was critical to implementing a more effective engagement effort with more involvement from CBOs.
- Streamline the structure of the communications toolkit for CBOs so they can utilize it more effectively.
- Incorporate more notification efforts that include radio ads, social media ad campaigns, and local newspaper ads in different languages.
- The workshops coordinated with CBOs were a success because stakeholders had the opportunity to provide input in more than one language as well as having both digital and print options available.
- Virtual workshop attendance was greater as opposed to the in-person meeting attendance for this round of engagement, likely due to the COVID-19 health directives.

This will need to be reevaluated once the county opens more freely without restrictions or safety protocols.

- Incorporating detailed directions on the printed paper surveys yielded higher completion rates.
- With the timeframe given, collaboration with more CBOs to implement an extended flyer distribution would be more effective because CBOs are more familiar with the neighborhoods impacted by the corridor and key gathering places for better reach within the communities.
- Multi-lingual collateral material was beneficial to increase engagement and accessibility to the corridor's diverse community demographics.
- Simultaneous interpretation was heavily utilized and appreciated by stakeholders attending the workshops.
- Providing video demonstrations on how to use Social Pinpoint tool allowed for more engagement and completion of the surveys and mapping comments.
- Expanding the internal database to reflect targeted demographics allowed broadening of the inclusion of communities within the LB-ELA Corridor communities.
