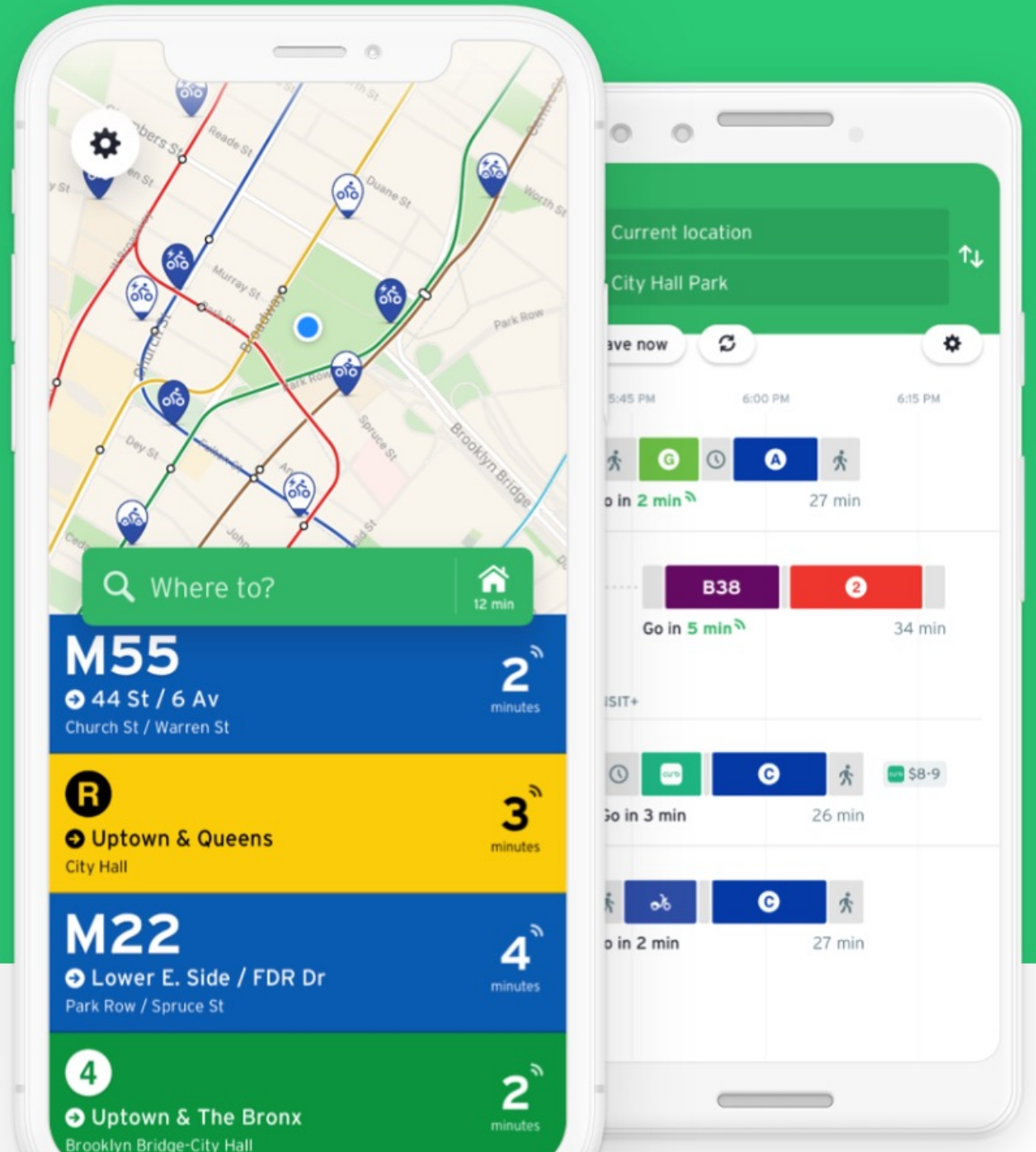

- > **Duration:** approximately 2 months

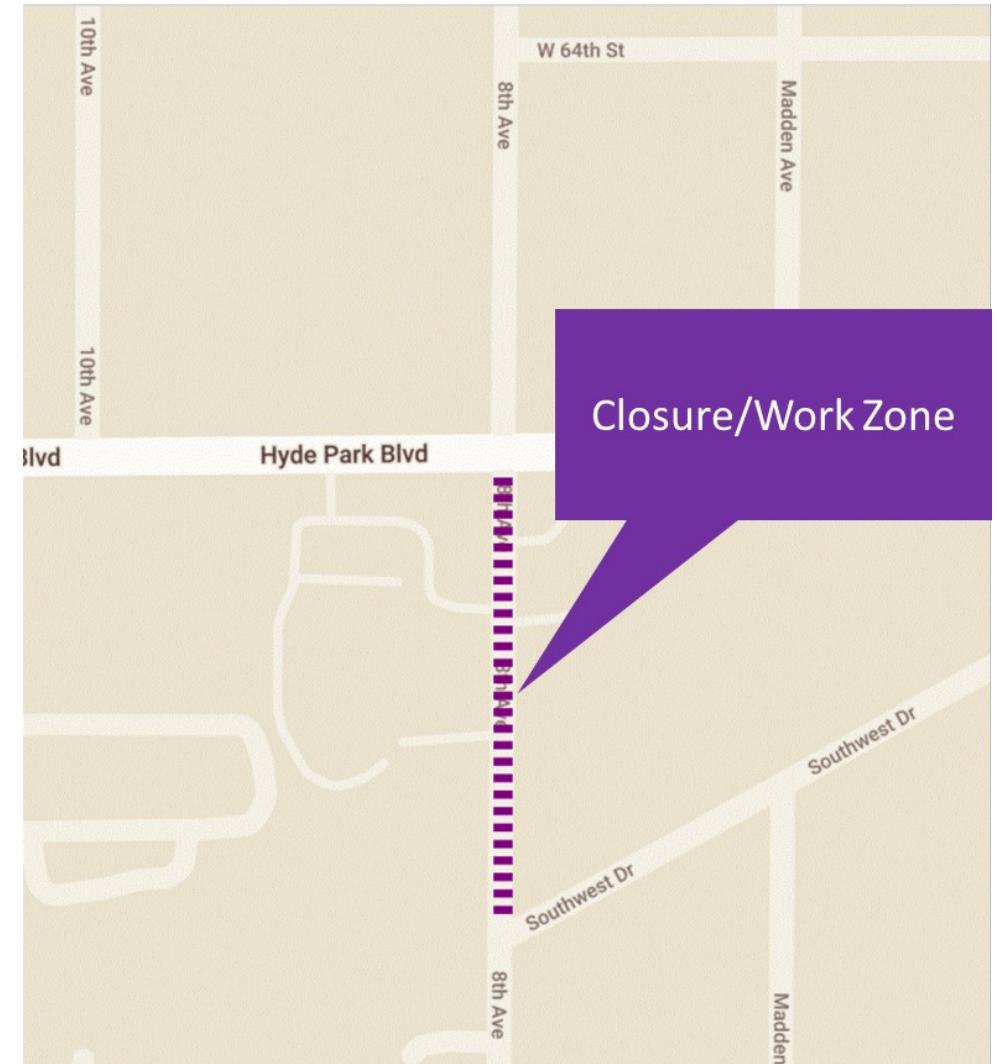
What to Expect

Stage 2 closure of northbound 8th Ave between Southwest Dr and Hyde Park Blvd.

On the Horizon | Intersection Improvement

Contractor will begin the intersection improvement work

- > **When:** Anticipated December 2022
- > **Where:** 4th Ave between Southwest Dr and Hyde Park Blvd and Hyde Park Blvd between 5th Ave and 4th Ave
- > **Duration:** approximately 2 months

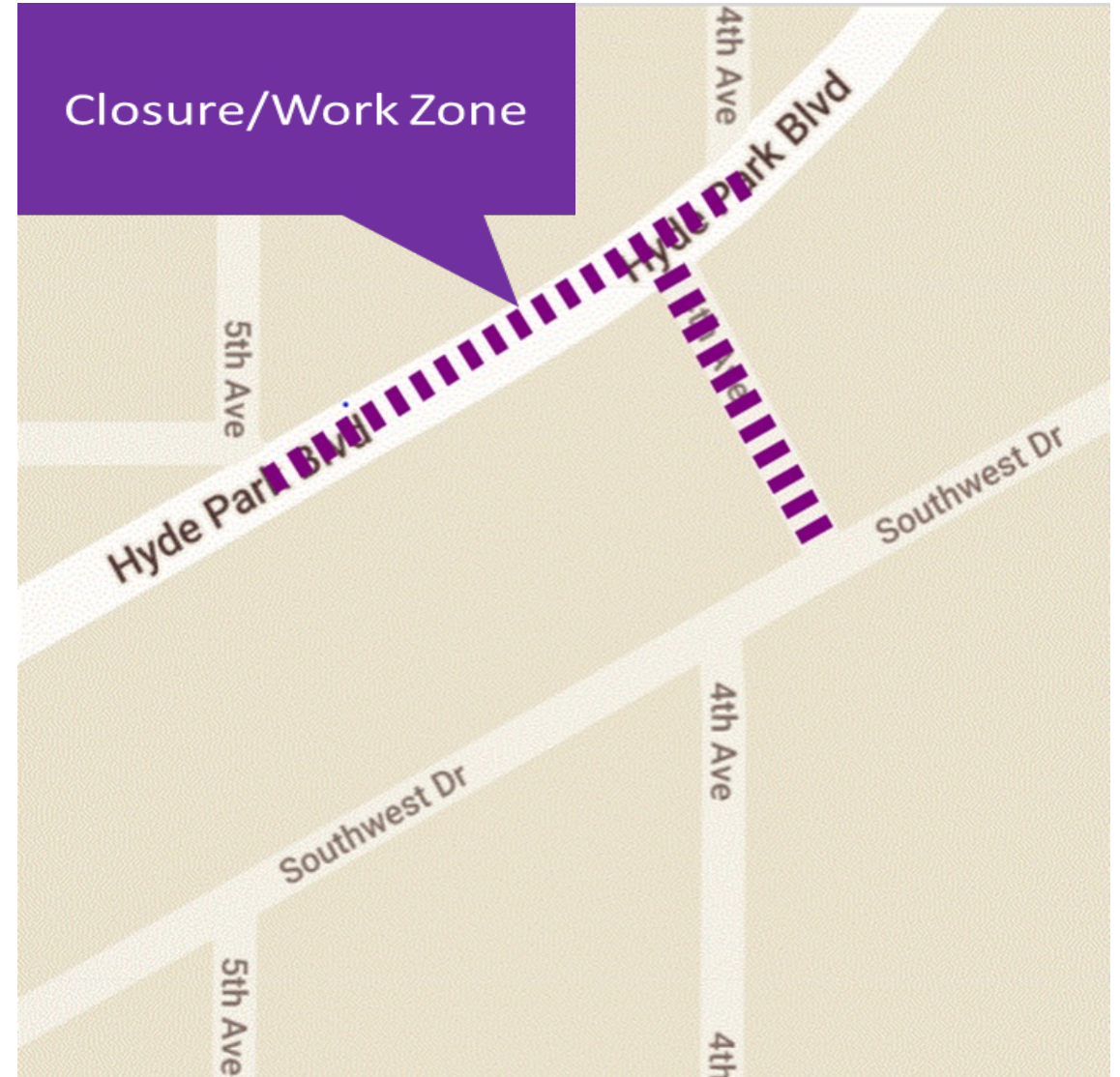
What to Expect

Stage 1 closure of northbound 4th Ave between Southwest Dr and Hyde Park Blvd and eastbound Hyde Park Blvd.

Stage 2 closure of eastbound Hyde Park Blvd from 5th Ave to 4th Ave, and southbound 4th Ave between Hyde Park Blvd and Southwest Dr.
