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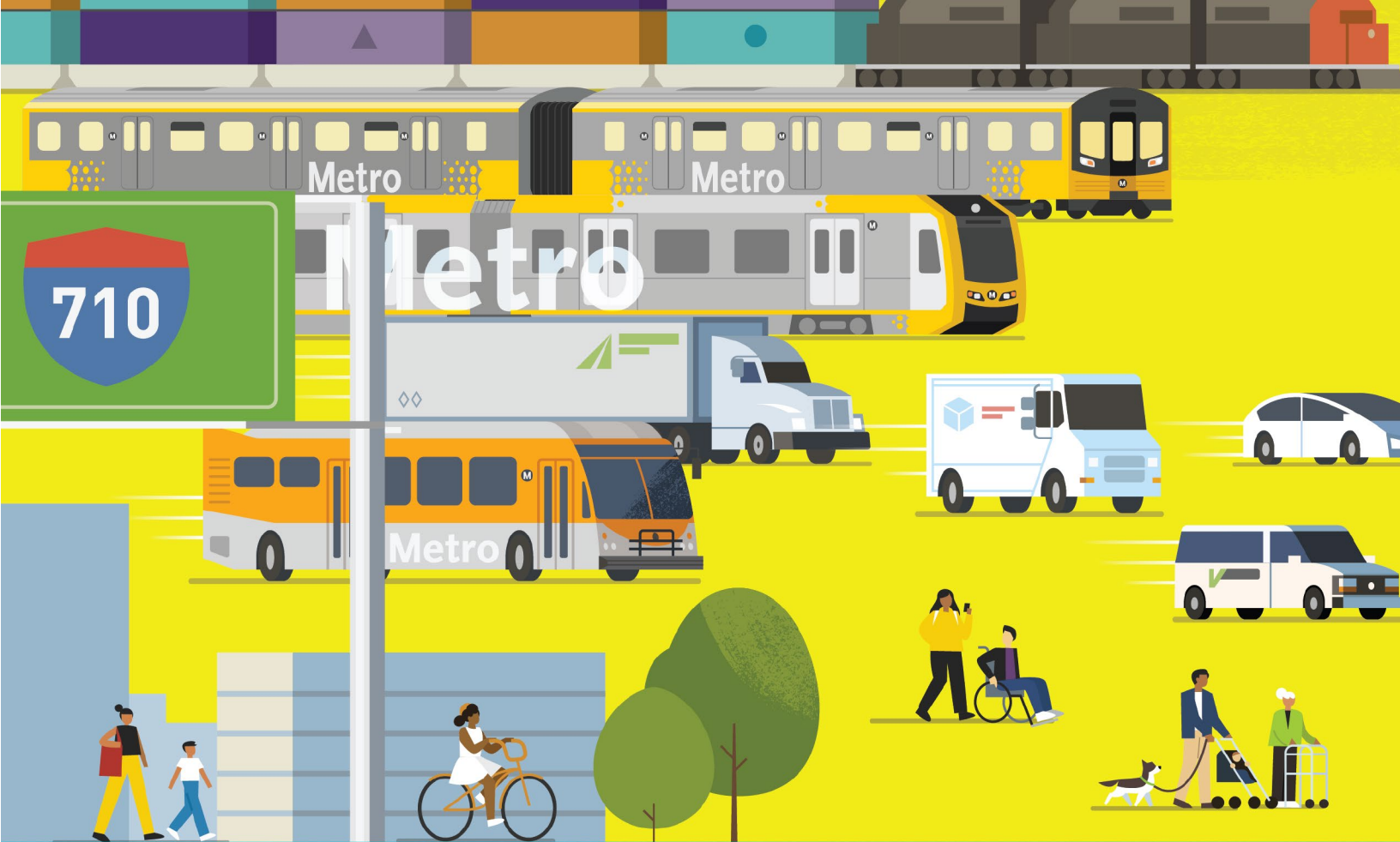

**Introduction**

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) and California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 7 initiated the I-710 South Corridor Task Force (710 Task Force) to develop a community-supported, regionally significant, multimodal approach to addressing major mobility, safety, air quality, and equity needs for moving people and goods through the I-710 South Corridor between the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach and State Route 60. The 710 Task Force will review and assess the purpose and need for investment in the I-710 corridor, develop multimodal improvement strategies, identify programs and projects to advance these strategies, create an investment and implementation plan, and provide recommendations to the Metro Board in 2023.

The 710 Task Force Meeting #14 was a special hybrid meeting that met on Monday, November 21, 2022, at South Gate Park Auditorium located at 4900 Southern Ave, South Gate, CA 90280 and transmitted live on Zoom. The intent objectives of this meeting were to:

- (1) Confirmation of New Community Leadership Committee Members
- (2) Receive Multimodal Strategies, Projects, & Programs presentations from CEHAJ and Goods Movement representatives
- (3) Provide feedback on Multimodal Strategies, Projects, and Program recommendations

A graphic illustrator visually captured key themes and meeting highlights (**Appendix A**). Simultaneous interpretation in Spanish, Tagalog, and Khmer was provided. Prior to the meeting, the 710 Task Force members received the agenda (**Appendix B**), presentation (**Appendix C**), and meeting materials (**Appendix D**).

**710 Task Force #14 Special Hybrid Meeting**

**1. Welcome, Introductions, Agenda Review, Meeting Objectives, and Attendance**

- > Ms. Morales reviewed the meeting objectives and agenda. In-person, there were 13 Task Force members, 1 ex-officio member, 14 CLC members, and 7 members of the public present. Virtually, there were 25 Task Force members, 2 ex-officio members, 7 CLC members, and 33 members of the public accounted for on Zoom.

- > The motion was passed unanimously.

## **3. Agenda Item #2: Multimodal Strategies, Projects, and Programs**

- > KeAndra Cylear Dodds, Executive Officer of Equity and Race, Metro, introduced Laura Cortez, Sylvia Betancourt, and Dilia Ortega who provided a presentation on behalf of the Coalition for Environmental Health and Justice (CEHAJ).
- > Highlights from this presentation include the following:
  - Background and overview of CEHAJ
  - Specific recommendations to the Task Force
  - Federal and State funding measures for communities impacted by goods movement
- > Presenters from CEHAJ provided a next steps plan that included the following:
  - Prioritizing funding for people/community-centered benefits
  - Asking Metro to target investment plans to replace current policies
  - Health and illness prevention strategies
- > Highlights of comments from Task Force, CLC, and members of the Public included:
  - Concerns about improving community health
  - Having more representation within unincorporated cities within the corridor
  - Addressing issues of safety in disadvantaged communities

- > Michael Cano, Executive Officer of Countywide Planning & Development, Metro, introduced Sharon Weissman, Chris Wilson, and Eric Lopez who provided a presentation on behalf of the Goods Movement.
- > Highlights from this presentation include the following:
  - Overview of how trade supports the Gateway City communities
  - Specific infrastructure and multi-modal improvement projects within the corridor
  - Recommendations a more equitable future for stakeholders that live along the I-710
- > Presenters from the Goods Movement provided a next-steps plan that included the following:
  - The goal of fully implementing the Zero Emissions Clean Truck Program
  - Partnering with community health organizations and increasing community engagement with stakeholders
  - Working with Metro to provide technical support for disadvantaged cities within the corridor to apply for grant funding
- > Highlights of comments from Task Force, CLC, and Members of the Public include:
  - Improving quality of life and health for all stakeholders
  - Increasing community engagement in all cities along the corridor
  - Strengthening safety when using public transit

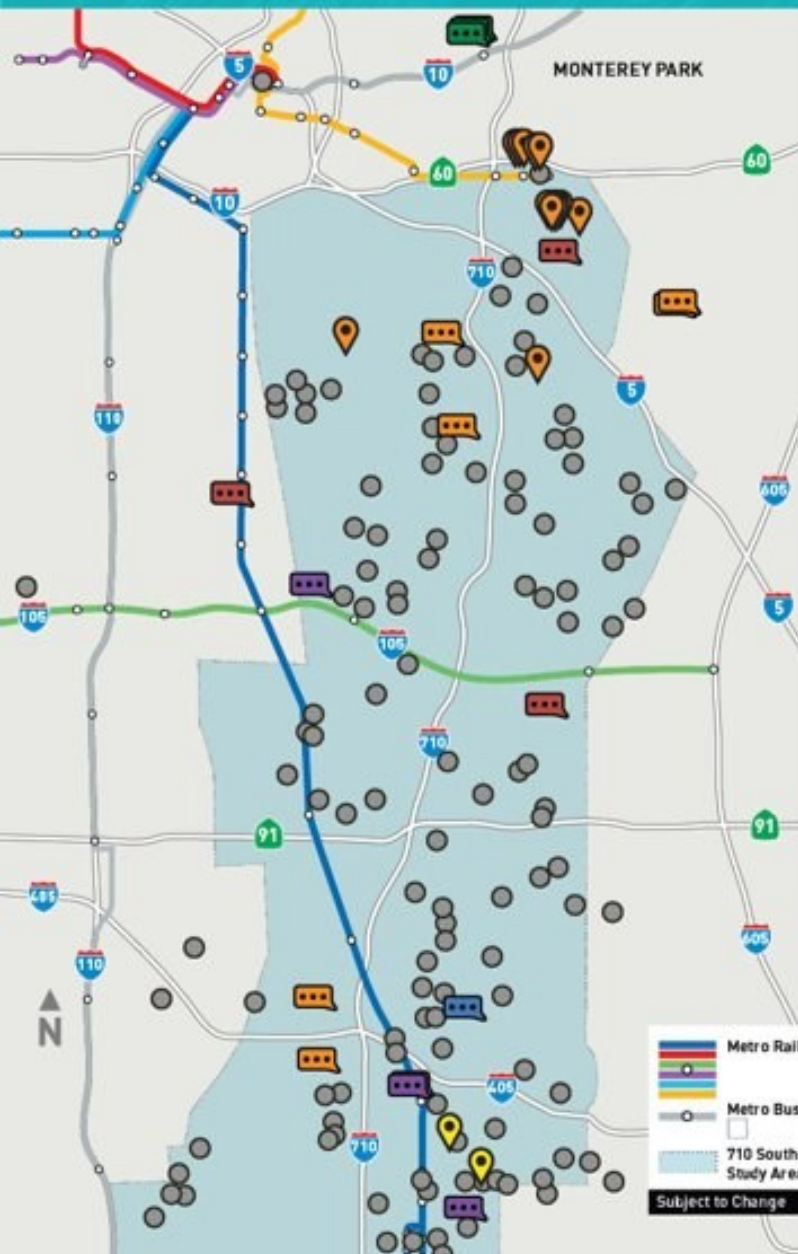

- The comparative score is significantly higher than other candidates.
- Potential bottleneck relief and congestion reduction are the most significant factors.
- As an EAP, it is likely the most competitive 710 segment for grant funds, like TCEP.
- The segment arguably provides the best value, even if down-scoping is required by funding limitations.

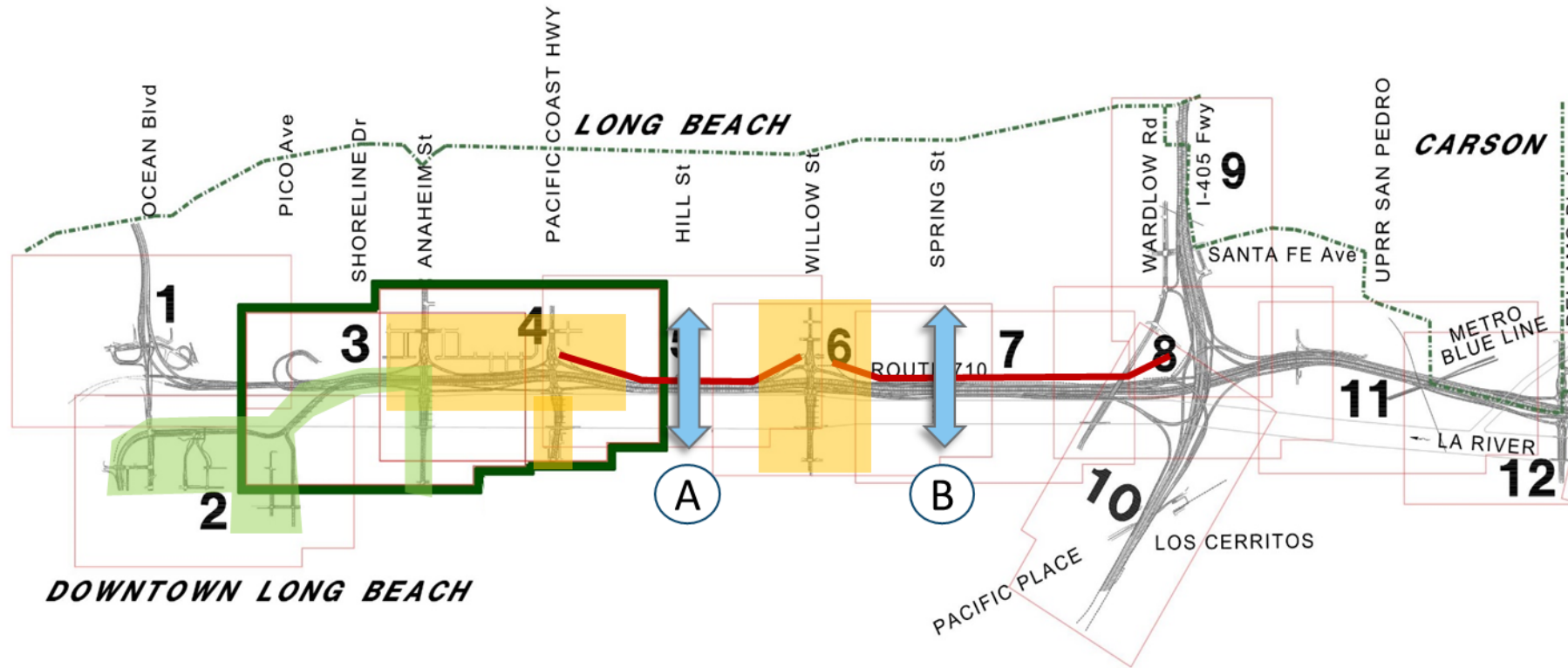
