Thank you for joining us!

We want to listen to your questions and comments. To provide a safe and equitable process during the Neighborhood Walk, we are asking for your help. During this Neighborhood Walk, please:

- > Respect the format of the event and allow everyone an opportunity to speak with Supervisor Mitchell staff, Metro staff and project planners.
- > Respect the neighbors and neighborhood, and use sidewalks when traveling on the walk route. Do not walk on the freight tracks or rail corridor (Metro right-of-way). The streets will not be closed during the walk.
- > Listen respectfully, allow others to speak and do not interrupt them.
- > Treat fellow community members, LA County representatives, and others with respect both during and after the event.
- > Maintain a conversational tone and a respectful distance between yourself and others.
- > Address all comments to LA County representatives and consultants—not to other attendees.
- > Do not block the view of other participants.
- > Do not display large signs with sticks attached or banners or other promotional materials; signs must be no larger than 8½" x 11".
- > Do not use speakers, bullhorns, or devices with sound amplification.

We encourage you to participate in the Neighborhood Walk and visit the walk stops. Supervisor Mitchell's staff are available to listen to your comments and Metro technical staff are available at stops to answer questions.
