



We're Making Changes for the Better: Westlake/MacArthur Park Station Plaza Improvements

Metro is making improvements to our Westlake/MacArthur Park Station Plaza to address public safety issues, improve customer experience and support a new “Markets at Metro” pilot street vendor program. Our goal is to create a safe community space where local street vendors can succeed.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Improvements will take place this summer at the Station Plaza. Access to the plaza will be limited while we make these improvements.

During these improvements, you can expect:

- Metro B/D Line trains will remain in service.
- The station entrance, plaza elevators and Throne restroom will remain open.
- Sidewalks will remain open on Alvarado St.

- The parking lot at 671 S. Westlake Ave. will be closed.
- Parking will be available at 680 S. Westlake Ave.
- Walkways in the plaza will be open to pedestrian traffic only.
- The DHS Mobile Health Clinic will be located at 7th St., west of Alvarado St. every Thursday.
