## LA BREA AV BUS PRIORITY LANES PROJECT

### Tips to Safely Use the New Bus Priority Lanes

Metro and the City of LA are partnering to improve the speed, frequency and reliability of buses during peak travel times along La Brea Av by installing the second phase of bus priority lanes between Olympic Bl and Coliseum St. The new bus priority lanes will operate on weekdays in both directions from 7–10am and 3–7pm.

#### What is a bus priority lane?

A bus priority lane gives buses dedicated space to travel separately from vehicles. A separate lane allows buses to get riders to their destinations faster and more reliably. The bus priority lanes on La Brea Av will allow buses to run every seven to eight minutes and will improve travel time by up to 15%.

#### Who is allowed to use the lanes?

Bus priority lanes are for use by buses only during the stated hours of operation. Emergency vehicles, vehicles making right turns and bicycles can use bus priority lanes when needed.

#### Will parking and loading/unloading\* be allowed?

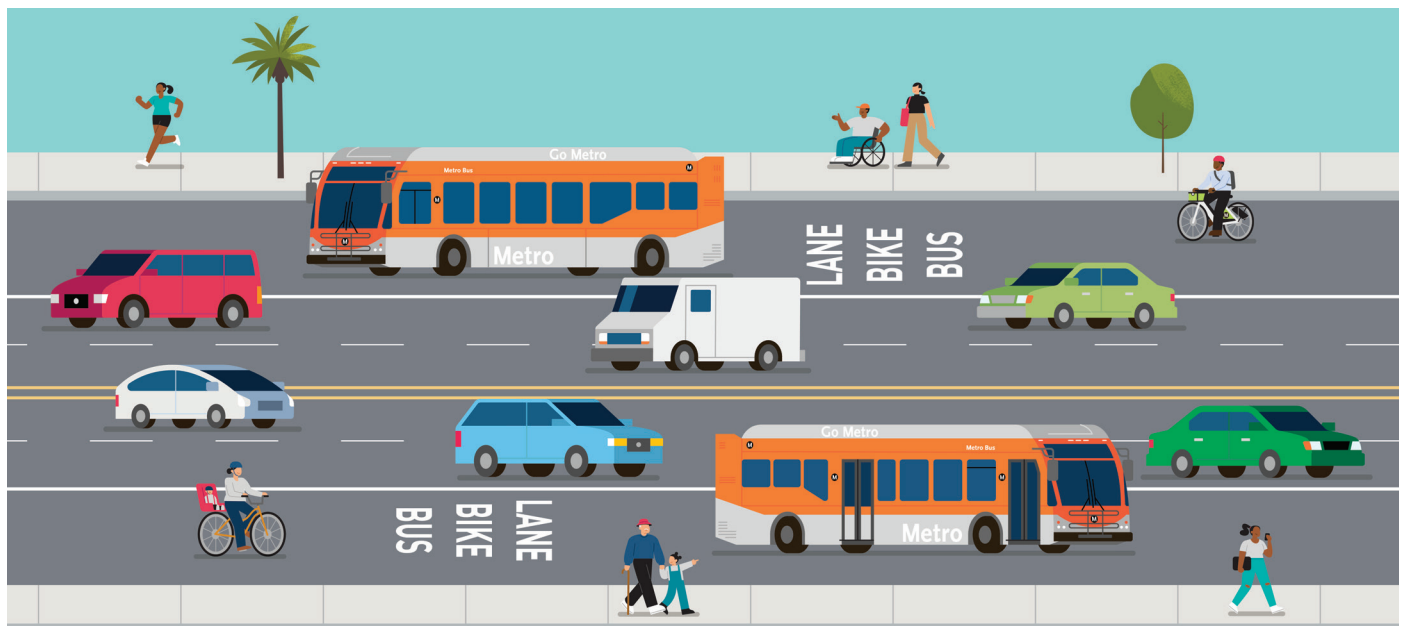
Similar to how La Brea operates today, do not park, load, unload or drop off/pick up passengers in the bus priority lanes during the stated hours of operation (between 7–9am and 4–7pm from Sunset Bl to Olympic Bl). \*Refer to signage for restrictions.

#### Can I make right turns?

Vehicles are permitted to enter the bus priority lanes to make legal right turns at intersections and driveways.

#### Are there any changes to the sidewalks?

No, when crossing the street, obey all laws and look for oncoming traffic in the new bus priority lanes.
