PSAC meetings occur monthly in person over a two-year term, with the potential for additional outreach and engagement as deemed necessary.

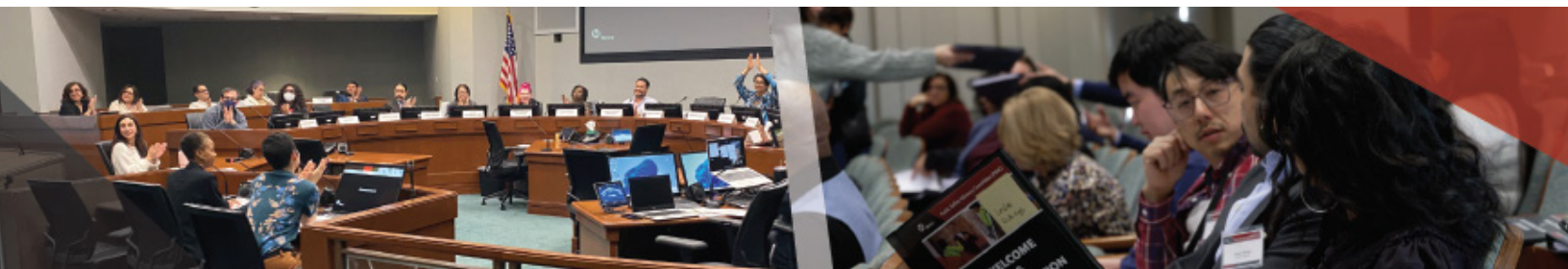
